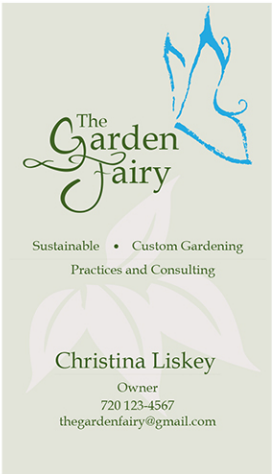
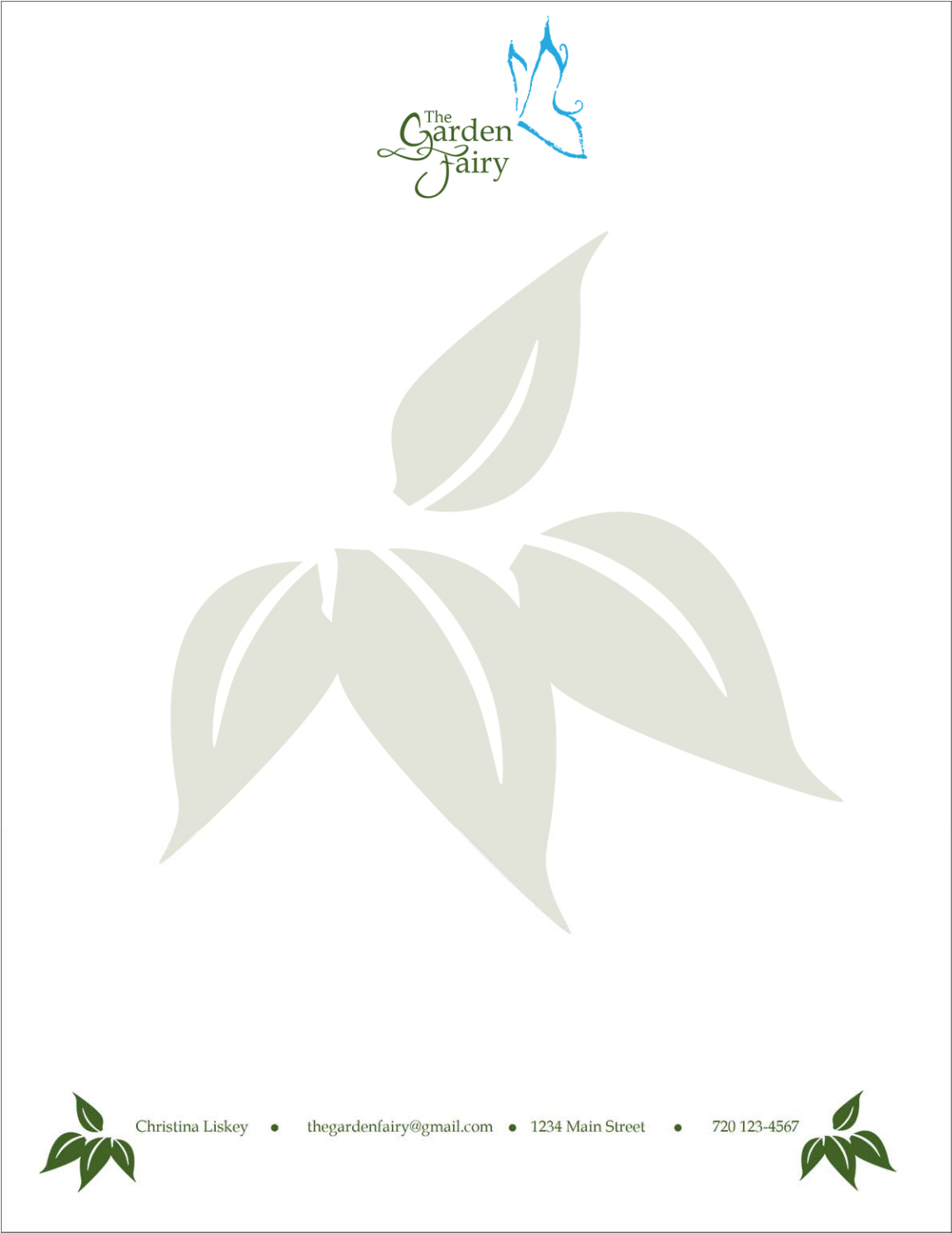


Figure 6: Garden Fairy Apps.

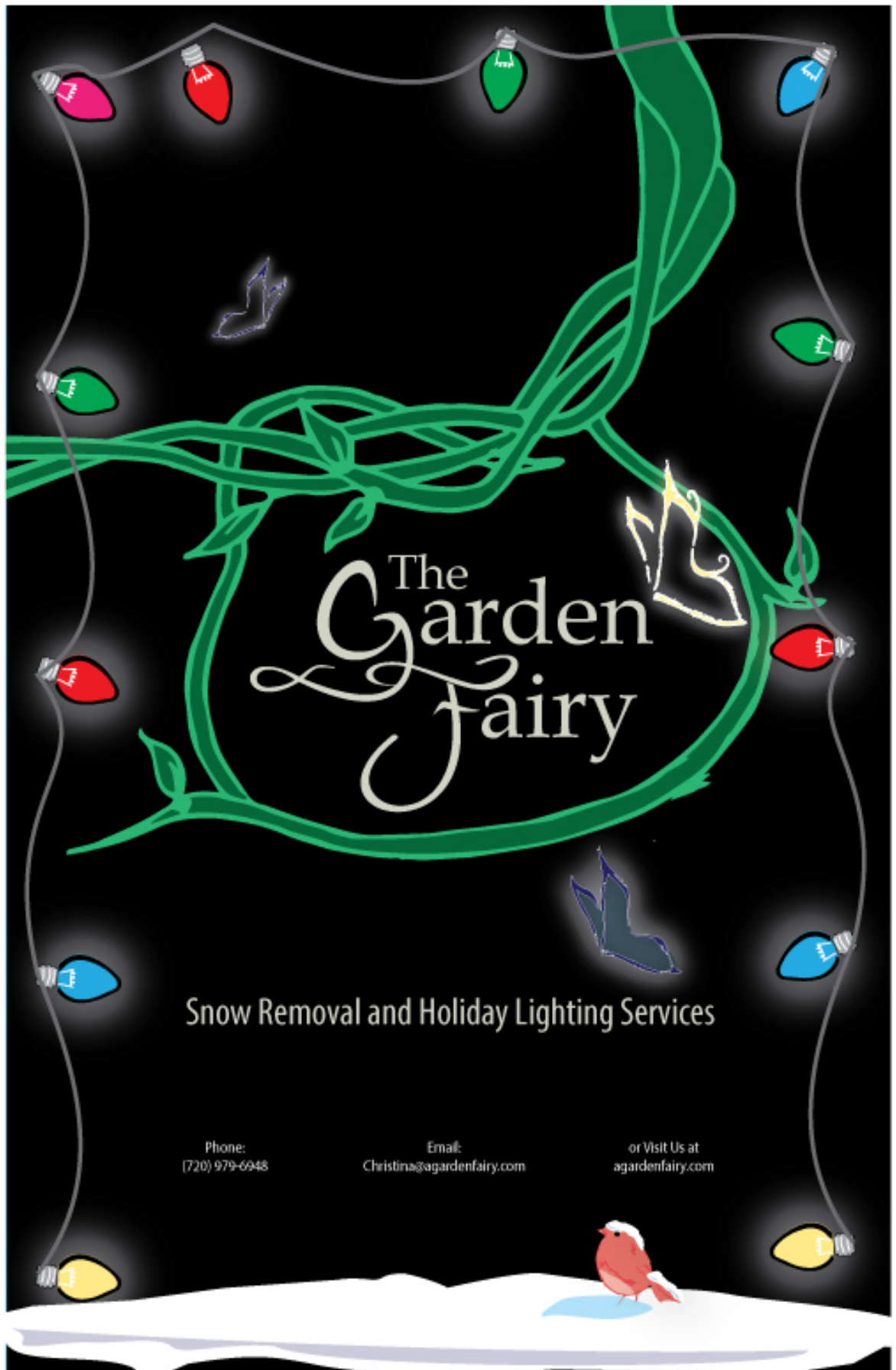


Figure 9: Poster 2.
