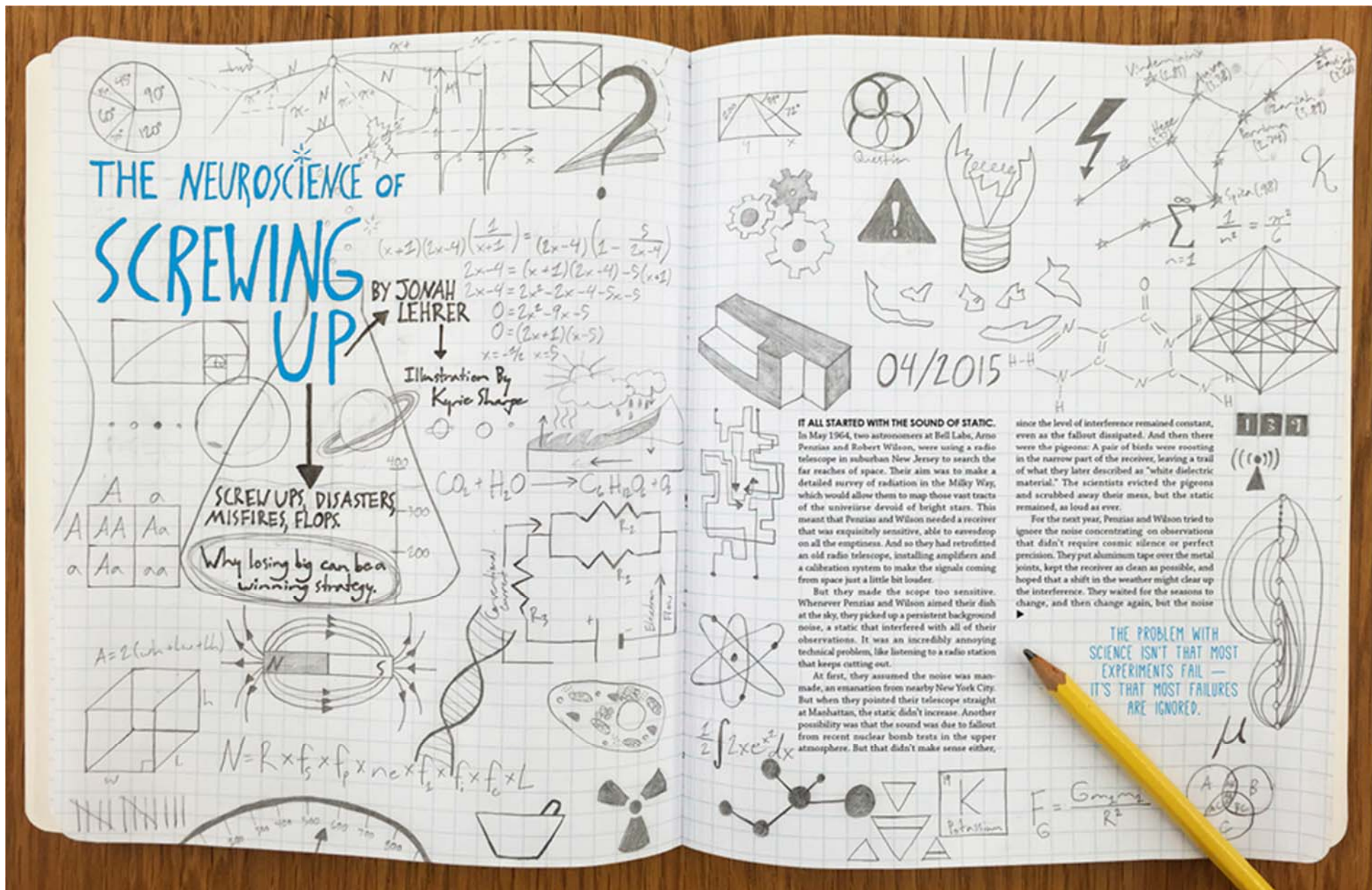


Figure 1: Wired Magazine Layout 1.

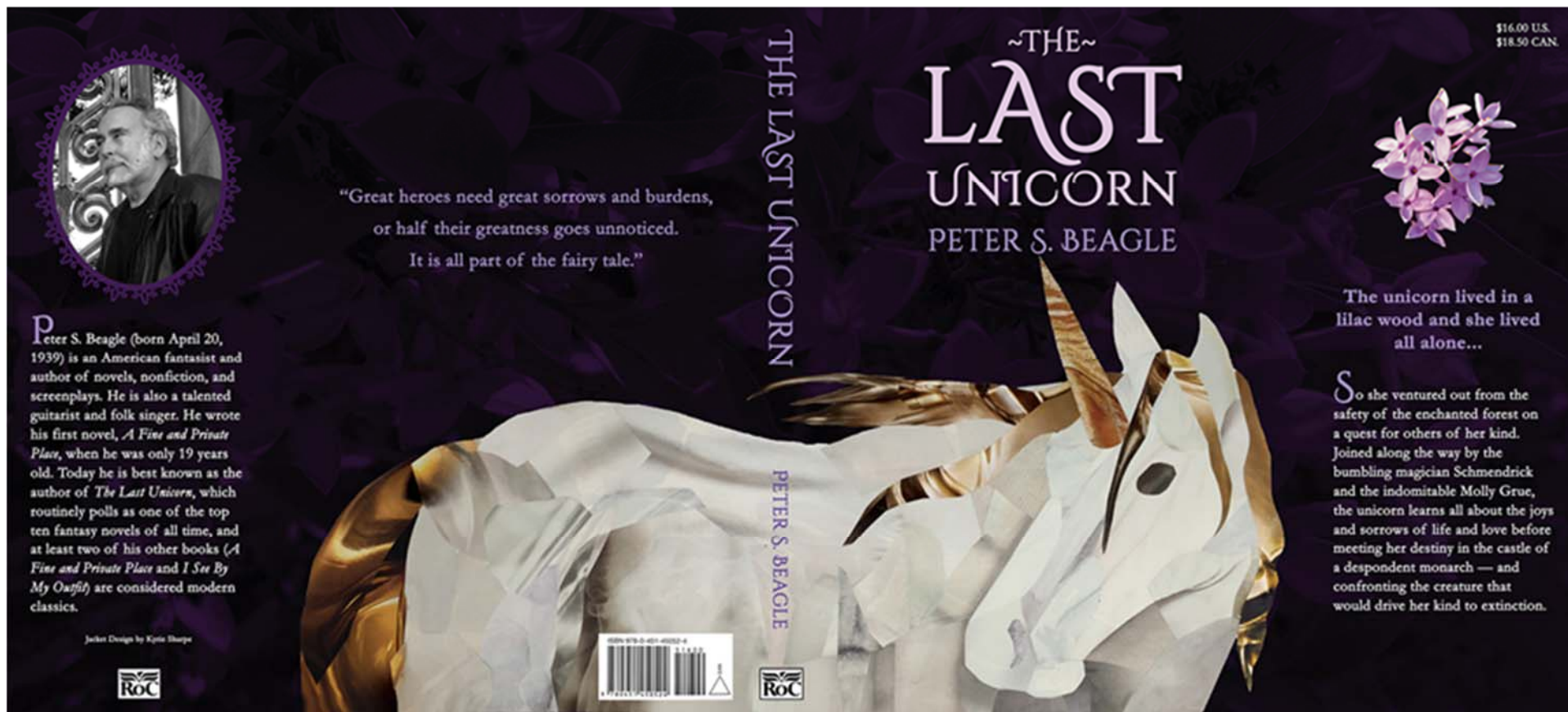


Figure 3: *The Last Unicorn* Book Jacket.

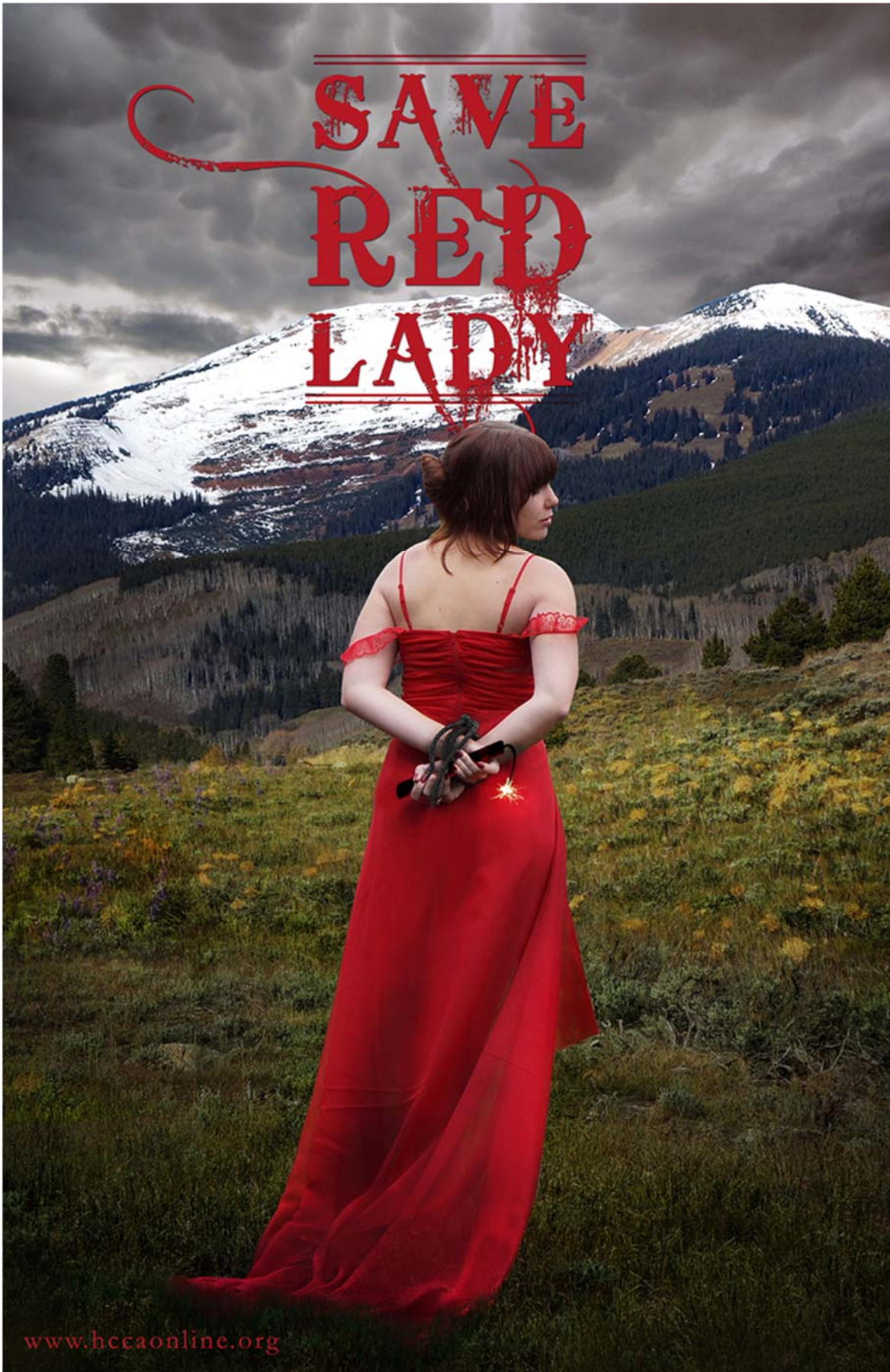


Figure 10: Save Red Lady Poster.
