

Dear Mr. Ferguson:

An Act to authorize the disposal of surplus personal property, including buildings, of the Emergency Conservation Work was approved May 29, 1935, Public No. 82, 74th Congress, (note marked statement on accompanying enclosure of the Treasury Department, Procurement Division).

If there are certain camps in the State of Colorado used for any of the various phases of emergency conservation work, we suggest you make application for such camps through your Extension Director to the Director of Emergency Conservation Work in your State. After learning the status of the property from him and itemizing it all, he will advise you on how to make your application to the Procurement Division of the Treasury Department in Washington for transfer of the same (see instructions on the enclosure).
