

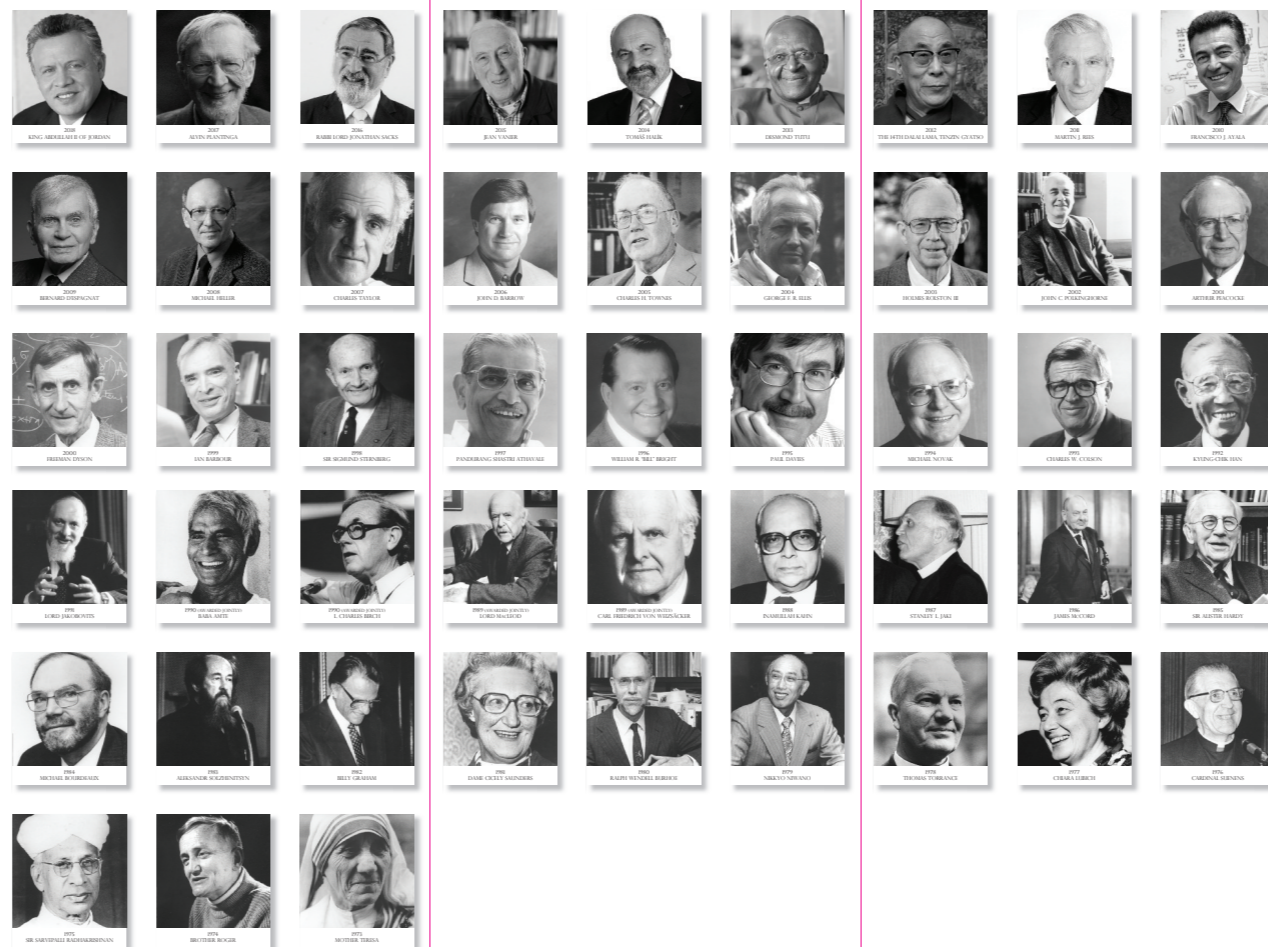
THE TEMPLETON PRIZE
