-Nutrition for the Elderly Scheduled-

A one day workshop sponsored by the Dairy Council, Inc., the Department of Home Economics and the Gerontology Programs at the University of Northern Colorado is scheduled this Thursday, June 17th, at Michener Library on the U.N.C. campus. The workshop will feature one of Americas foremost experts in the field of nutrition for older people, Dr. Anthony A. Albanese, Director of Nutrition and Metabolic Research of the Burke Rehabilitation Center at White Plains, New York. Dr. Albanese also holds a position with the Geriatric Nutrition Laboratory of the Miriam Osborn Memorial Home in Rye, New York.

Dr. Albanese has published over 250 papers in the field of human nutrition research and methods including such topics as nutritional requirements of elderly men and women, and of stroke patients, and the effects of fats, cholesterol, and other factors in heart disease.

The program is scheduled to begin at 9 am, with registration starting at 8 am in the Lindow Auditorium, located in the Michener Library on the U.N.C. campus. Registration is \$5.00 which includes lunch and refreshment breaks.
