BIOGRAPHIES



Session Brass is a brass quintet whose membership includes a rotation of brass players, teachers, and friends who get together throughout the year for a "session" to play concerts and give masterclasses. For this "session" the quintet is playing recitals and giving masterclasses at universities throughout Colorado including; Adams State University, University of Denver, Colorado State University, and Metropolitan State University. Members of the quintet include: Brian Walker, Kurt Bonnett, Angela Winter, Bill Haugeberg, and Noel Wallace.

Dr. BRIAN WALKER, trumpet, is the associate professor of trumpet at Tarleton State University. Brian has a nationally ranked trumpet studio and maintains an active performing career in DFW. He was recently elected to the Board of Directors for the International Trumpet Guild.

Dr. KURT BONNETT, trumpet, is a freelance trumpet player and teacher in DFW. Kurt serves as the trumpet teacher and Director of Athletic bands at Texas Wesleyan University as well as maintaining a private studio Frisco and Allen Independent School Districts.

Hornist, **Dr. ANGELA WINTER**, is Director of Bands and professor of brass at Adams State University in Alamosa, Colorado. Angela, is an active performer all through the southwest.

Dr. NOEL WALLACE, bass trombone, is the adjunct instructor of low brass at Tarleton State University and maintains a large private studio in the Hebron cluster of the Lewisville Independent School District. Noel balances his teaching schedule with a variety of orchestral, chamber, solo, and jazz performances.

Dr. BILL HAUGEBERG, trombone, is the assistant professor of low brass at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley. Bill has performed with internationally award-winning chamber groups and is currently presenting solo performances throughout Texas.
