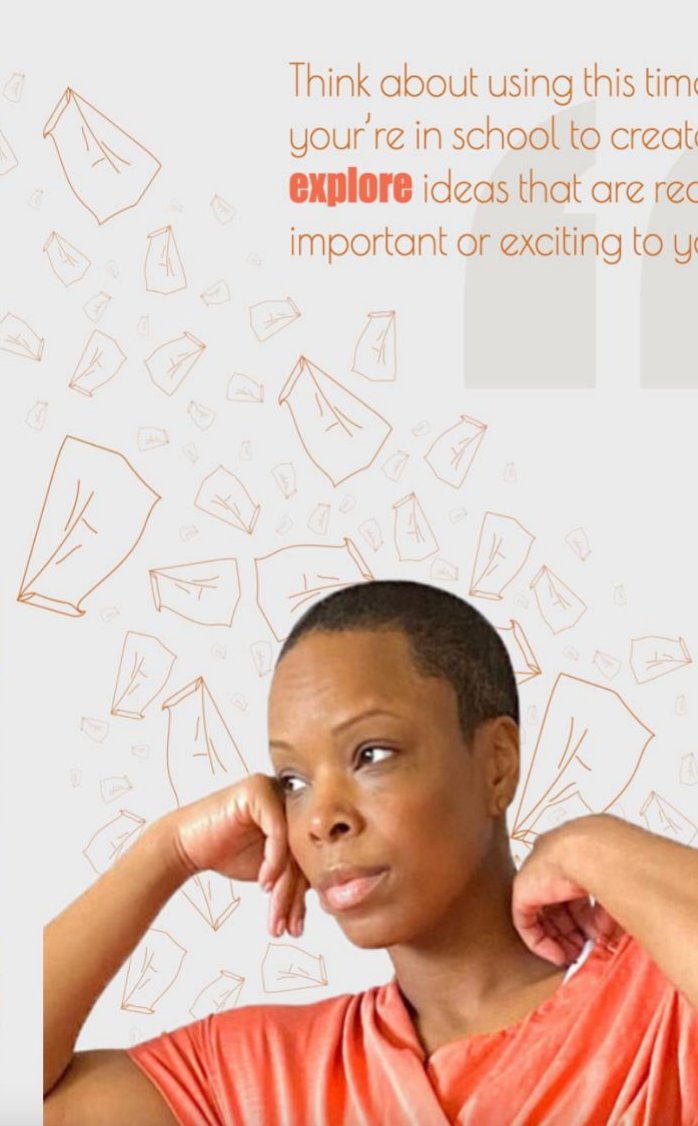

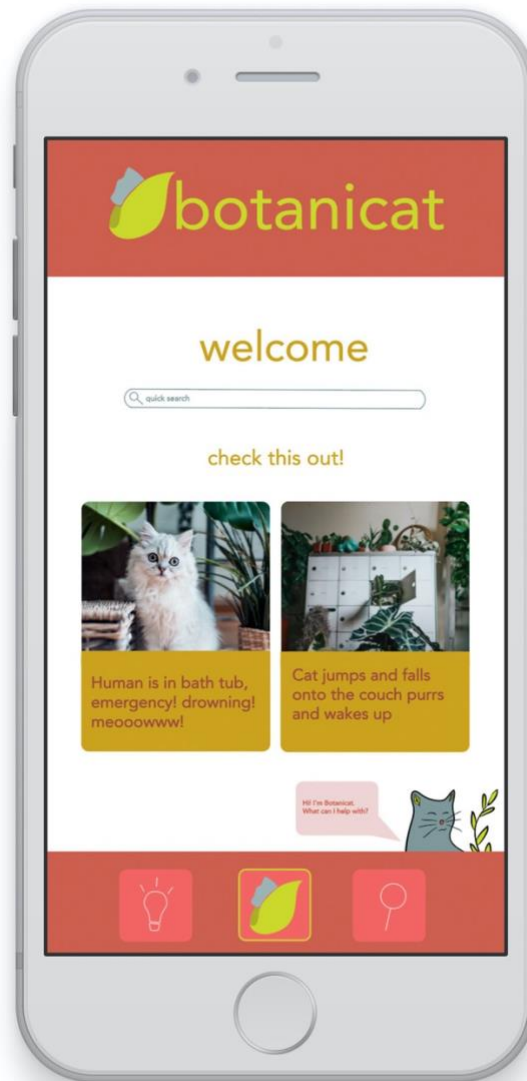


Figure 4: Botanicat: App Design

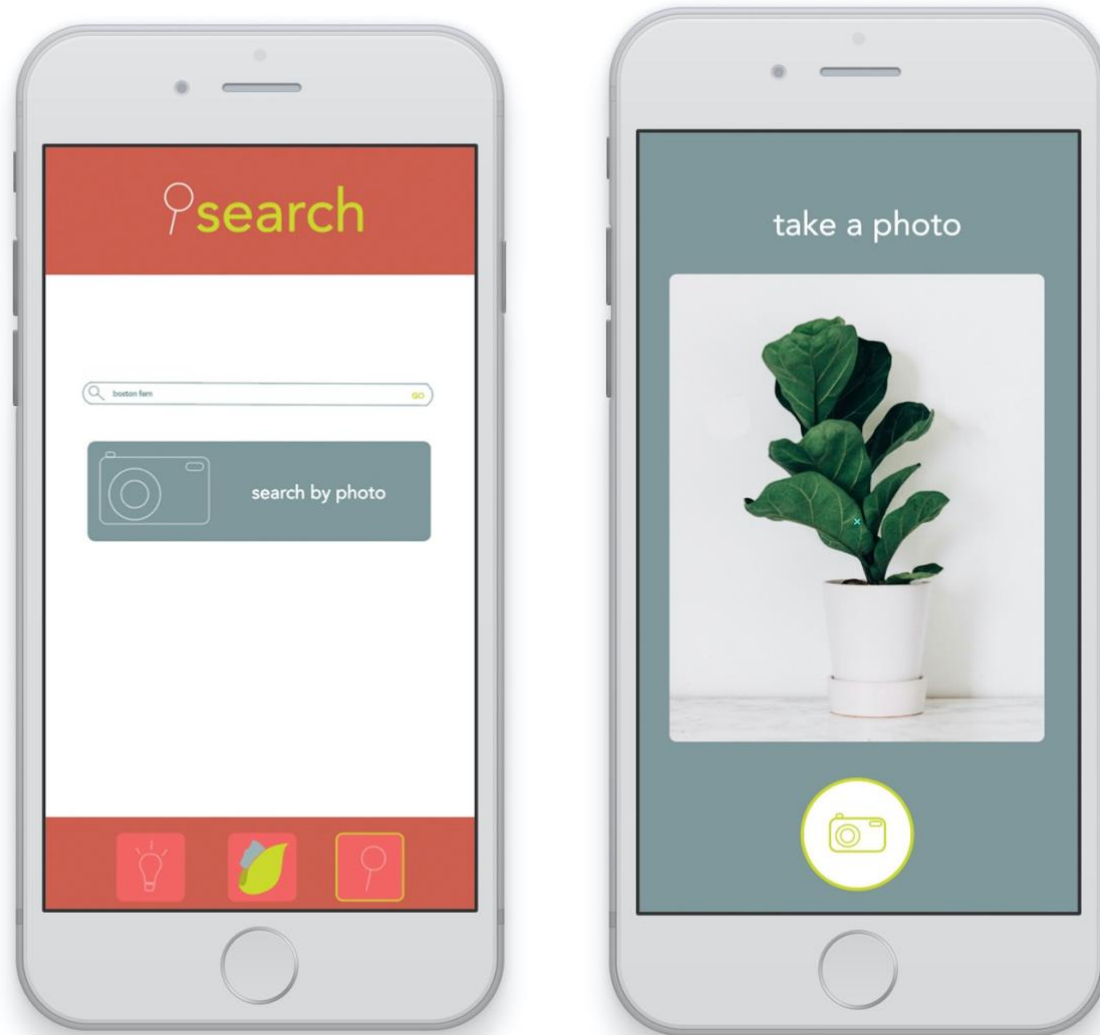


Figure 5: Botanicat: App Design



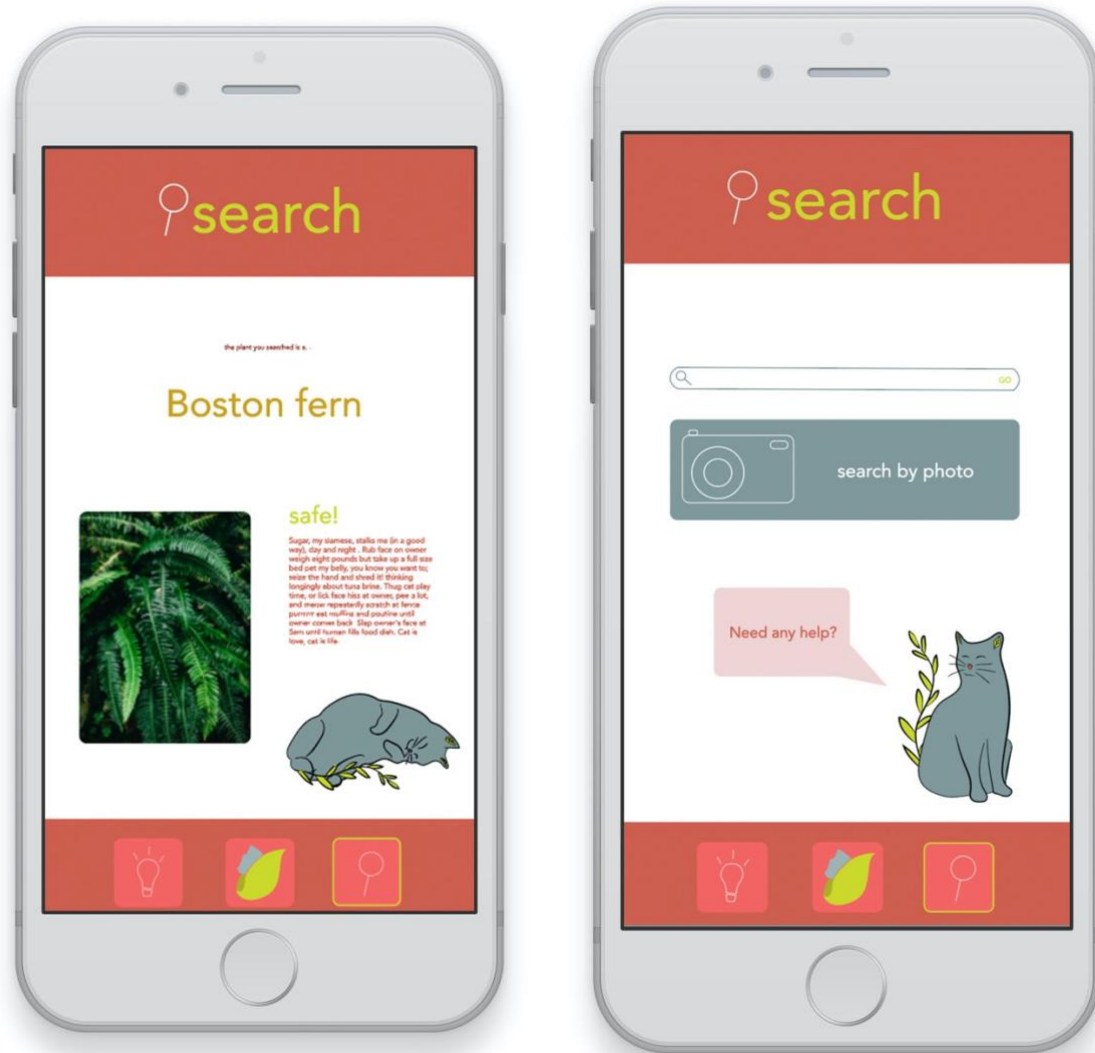


Figure 6: Botanicat App Design

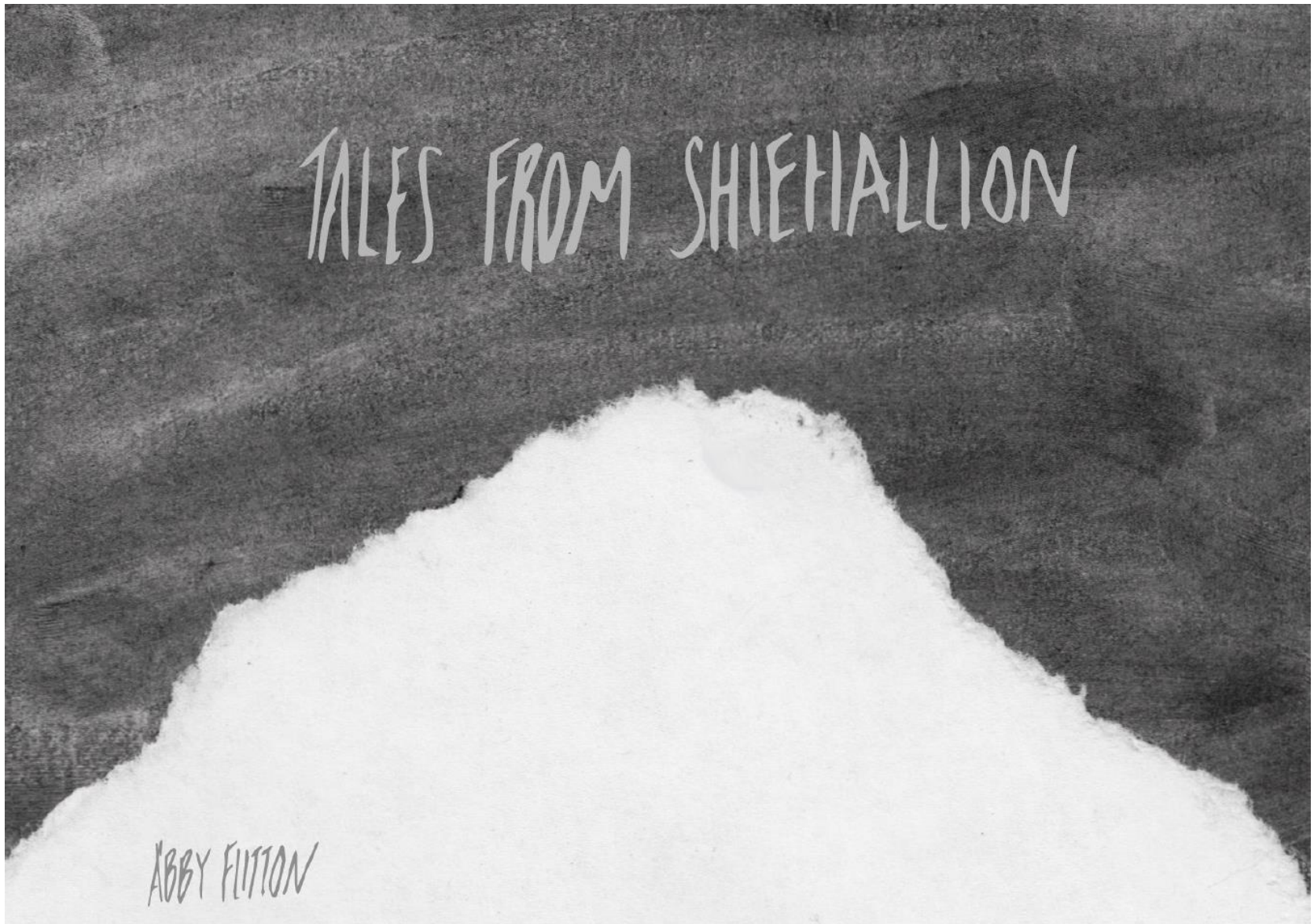


Figure 8: Tales from Shiehallion: Cover
