The USDA Forest Service released \$10 million (nationally) to the regions for the Forest Land Enhancement Program (FLEP). Colorado will receive \$131,203. Like last year, the funds will be used for practices promoting forest condition efforts: # 7, Forest Health and Protection and # 9, Wildfire and Catastrophic Risk Reduction. This remains consistent with the Colorado State Forest Service strategic direction and the goals established in the State Priority Plan.

We will handle District allocations as follows: Each District will submit requests. Please specify needs that you are confident will be approved and completed in a timely manner - you MAY allow up to 12 months for a performance period. Include the name of the applicant, the practice and component(s) (remember only #7 or 9), and the amount requested for each project. Allocations awarded will be based on the number and types of projects, and amounts requested. Please have your requests in to me by June 30th.

RE: 2004 FLEP Allocation

Good news! The USDA Forest Service released \$5 million to the regions for the Forest Land Enhancement Program (FLEP). The money comes from funds that were repaid by Congress after fire borrowing in the FY04 appropriations bill. Colorado will receive \$68,531. These funds will be used for practices promoting forest condition efforts (# 7 and # 9), remaining consistent with the Colorado State Forest Service strategic direction and the goals established in the State Priority Plan. If it is determined that we have adequate funding from the NFP grants for WUI incentives, we will concentrate on FLEP # 7.

We will handle District allocations as follows: Districts: please specify needs that you are confident will be approved and completed in a timely manner - you MAY allow up to 12 months for a performance period. Please submit the total dollar amount requested. If known, include the name of the applicant, the practice and component(s), and the amount requested. Allocations awarded will be based on the number and types of projects, and amounts requested. Please have your requests in to me by December 3rd.

LOA-7 Forest Health and Protection

Purpose

Establishment of practices primarily to monitor, assess, protect, improve or restore forest health; including detection and control of insects, diseases and animal damage to established stands.

Eligible Components

The list below contains each component and its respective cost-share amount. These amounts are not to exceed 50% of actual cost, with total cost-share not to exceed \$1,000 per acre.

Cost-share Requirements

- Landowner acreage and eligibility requirements are met.
- A management plan is required to be eligible for cost-share.
- Practice must be maintained for a minimum of 10 years.
- Treated area must be protected from fire and grazing when determined to be destructive to practice.
- Fencing will be eligible for cost-share where it is determined that the primary purpose of this practice will not be achieved unless it is protected by a fence or where fencing as a “stand alone” component will result in the natural regeneration of trees. Fencing not eligible for I & D work..
- Chemicals used must be Federally, State and locally registered, and be applied according to registered uses, label directions and other federal or State policies and requirements.
- Prescribed burning will be performed in accordance with State and local laws and regulations.
- To receive cost-share for 666-6 infested trees must be removed. Check with local CSFS District for timing of cutting.

Landowners should contact a Colorado State Forest Service (CSFS) representative prior to applying for LOA cost-share. CSFS can provide information about LOA practices, status of available cost-share funds and application procedures. CSFS will approve practices and certify that they have been completed in accordance of plan specifications.

Landowner Assistance Program

LOA-9 Fire and Catastrophic Risk Reduction

Purpose

Establishment of practices primarily to reduce the risk from wildfire and other catastrophic natural events. Practices should reduce the intensity of wildfire should it occur. Practices can increase the potential for defensibility of structures in the event of wildfire.

Eligible Components

The list below contains each component and its respective cost-share amount. These amounts are not to exceed 50% of actual cost, with total cost-share not to exceed \$1,000 per acre. This does not apply to the implementation of a defensible space.

¹ Removal of both horizontal and vertical fuels around a home to reduce fire hazard. CSFS standards will be used and completed projects approved by CSFS. Cost-share includes tree cutting, pruning and slash treatment.

Cost-share Requirements

- Landowner acreage and eligibility requirements are met.
- A management plan is required to be eligible for cost-share.
- Practice must be maintained for a minimum of 10 years.
- Chemicals used must be Federally, State and locally registered, and be applied according to registered uses, label directions and other federal or State policies and requirements.
- Prescribed burning will be performed in accordance with State and local laws and regulations.
- The value of wood products generated from forest improvement activities and sold by the landowner must be deducted from total project cost to determine actual landowner cost. Cost-share payments are based on 50% of actual cost.

Landowners should contact a Colorado State Forest Service (CSFS) representative prior to applying for LOA cost-share. CSFS can provide information about LOA practices, status of available cost-share funds and application procedures. CSFS will approve practices and certify that they have been completed in accordance of plan specifications.

All,

Good news! The USDA Forest Service released \$5 million to the regions for the Forest Land Enhancement Program (FLEP). The money comes from funds that were repaid by Congress after fire borrowing in the FY04 appropriations bill. Colorado will receive \$68,531. These funds will be used for practices promoting forest condition efforts (# 7 and # 9), remaining consistent with the Colorado State Forest Service strategic direction and the goals established in the State Priority Plan. If it is determined that we have adequate funding from the NFP grants for WUI incentives, we will concentrate on FLEP # 7.

We will handle District allocations as follows: Districts: please specify needs that you are confident will be approved and completed in a timely manner - you MAY allow up to 12 months for a performance period. Please submit the total dollar amount requested. If known, include the name of the applicant, the practice and component(s), and the amount requested. Allocations awarded will be based on the number and types of projects, and amounts requested. Please have your requests in to me by December 3rd.
