
Dear Mr. Stevenson:


Dear Cindy:

Dear Harold:

Your request for Stewardship Incentives cost-sharing for your forest management plan was approved in the amount of \$300.00, instead of the \$313.00 originally requested. This is because the program ran out of money; yours was the last request funded.

Based on your estimate of 55.0 acres, the plan will cost \$467.50, of which \$300.00 will be reimbursed, leaving you with a net cost of \$167.50.

I have not yet checked the actual acreage from the maps you sent; that will be a real challenge. The final price will be pro-rated up or down, based on acreage.

I will proceed with the plan as time allows; we are about to enter the planting season; seedlings will be delivered on Thursday. I may not get done until mid-May.
