Systems of Care

- Paradigm shift in social service delivery.
- Social worker is replaced with group of service providers, family & community members.
 - Develop *collectively* comprehensive plan
- Services are
 - Coordinated
 - *Community-based*
 - Culturally competent
 - Individualized



Community Resources

- Formal and informal services important to SOC
- Informal least well-known
 - No official directory
 - At community level
 - Examples: church soup kitchens, transportation services for the elderly provided by non-profits or churches, in-home daycare providers not registered with the county.





Resource Identification Mapping

Can identify overlap and gaps in service provision toward a System of Care

Participants identify resources in their community

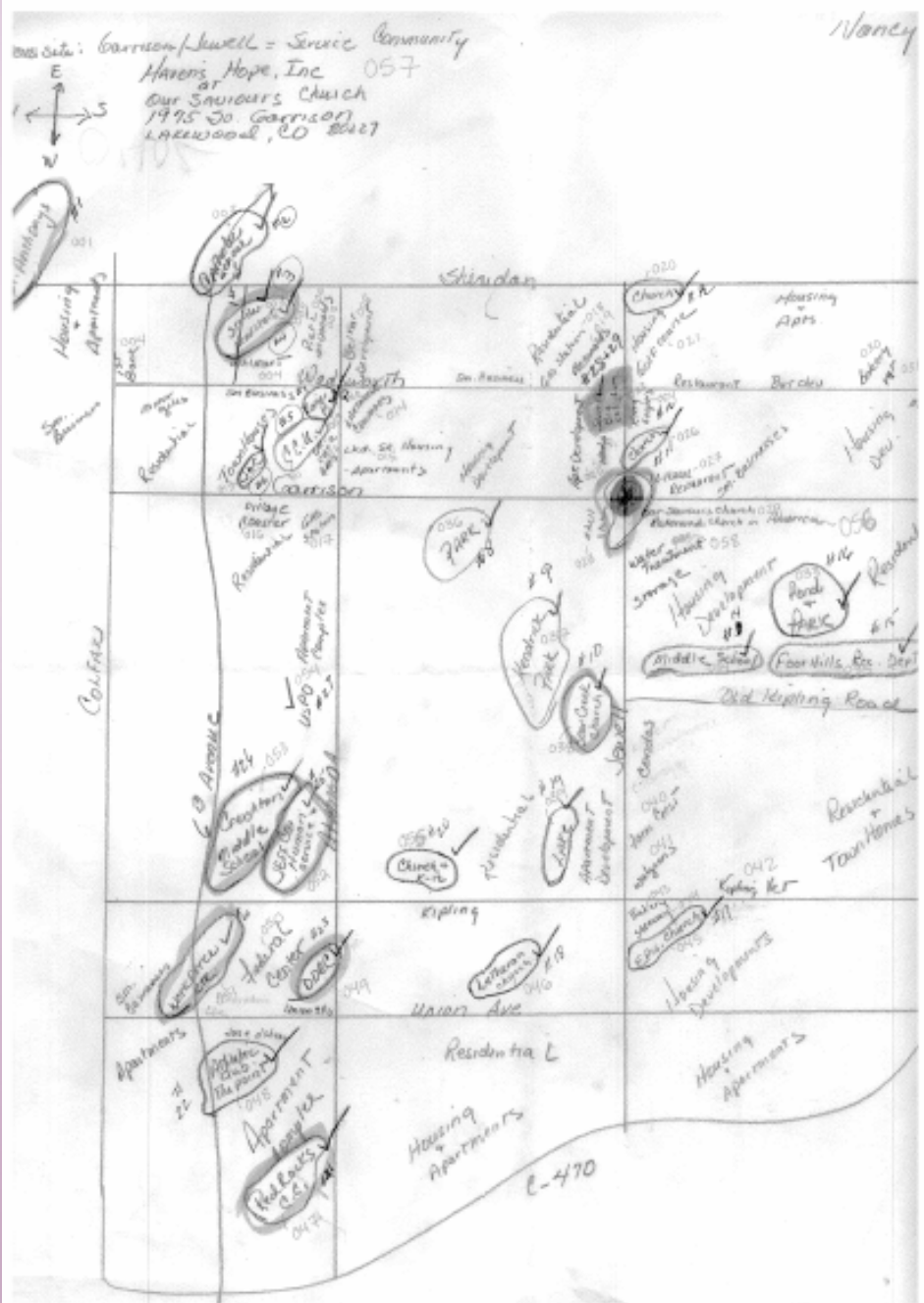
Categories of mappers:

- Providers (social service, non-profit, faith-based)
- Clients (TANF, youths, foster care providers, adoptive parents)
- Ethnic/racial enclaves (Latino, Russian, Native American, African American)

Mapping Procedure in This Study

- Participants indicate boundaries of area they know best
- Visualization exercise
- Draw in roads and other details by section of map
- Label resources of different types
- Identify resources they use and resources that others use
- Indicate strengths and weaknesses



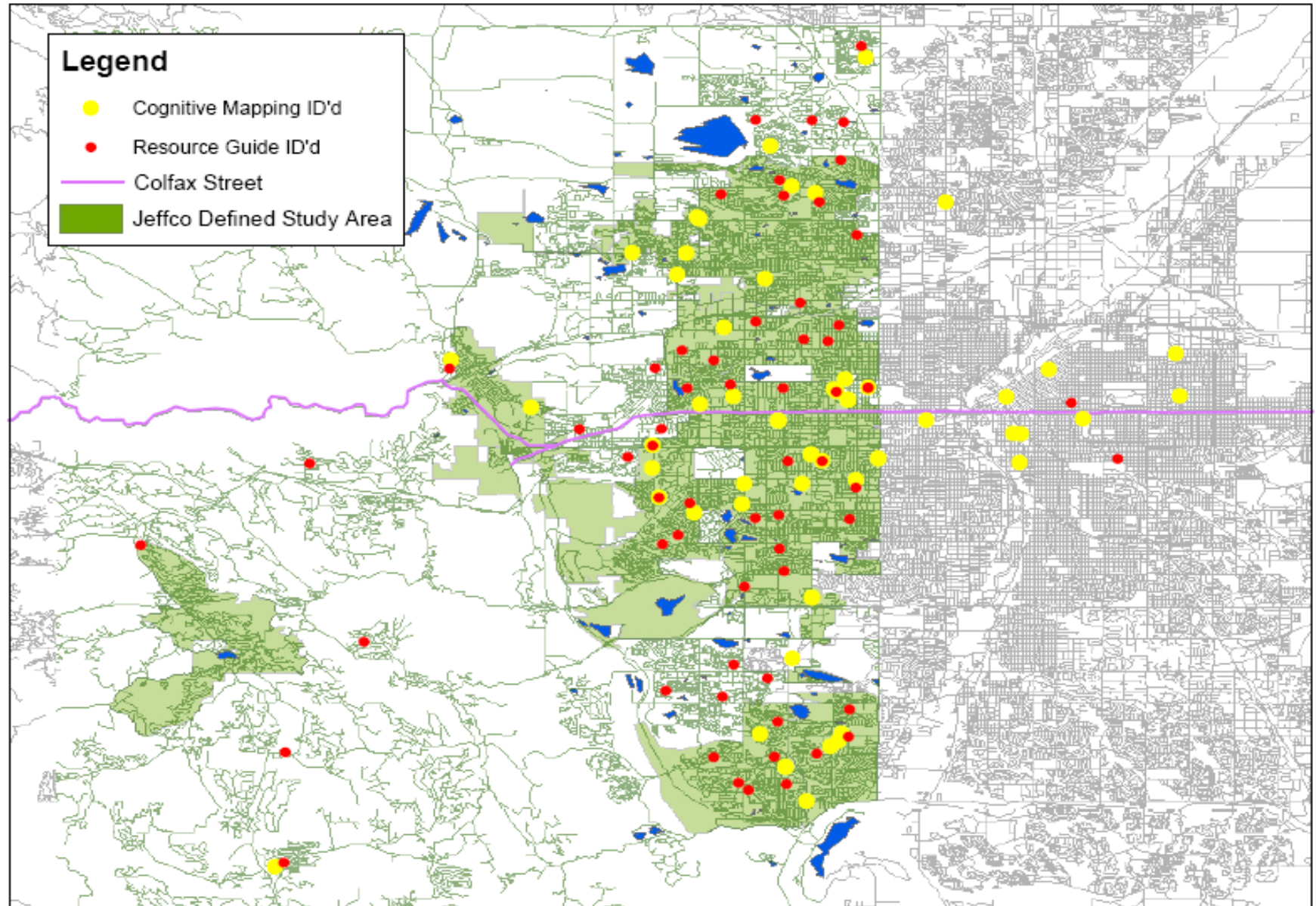


Mapping Data and GIS

- Coded using Mapquest and phone books to identify exact addresses of datapoints
- Mapping data points entered into GIS into one or more of the 24 various resource layers (i.e., childcare, education, safety/legal, transportation)
- Allows to see proximity of services to clients and to each other
- Can determine overlap and gaps overall and in specific areas or for specific populations

Education Resources: Cognitive Mapping ID'd vs Resource Guide ID'd



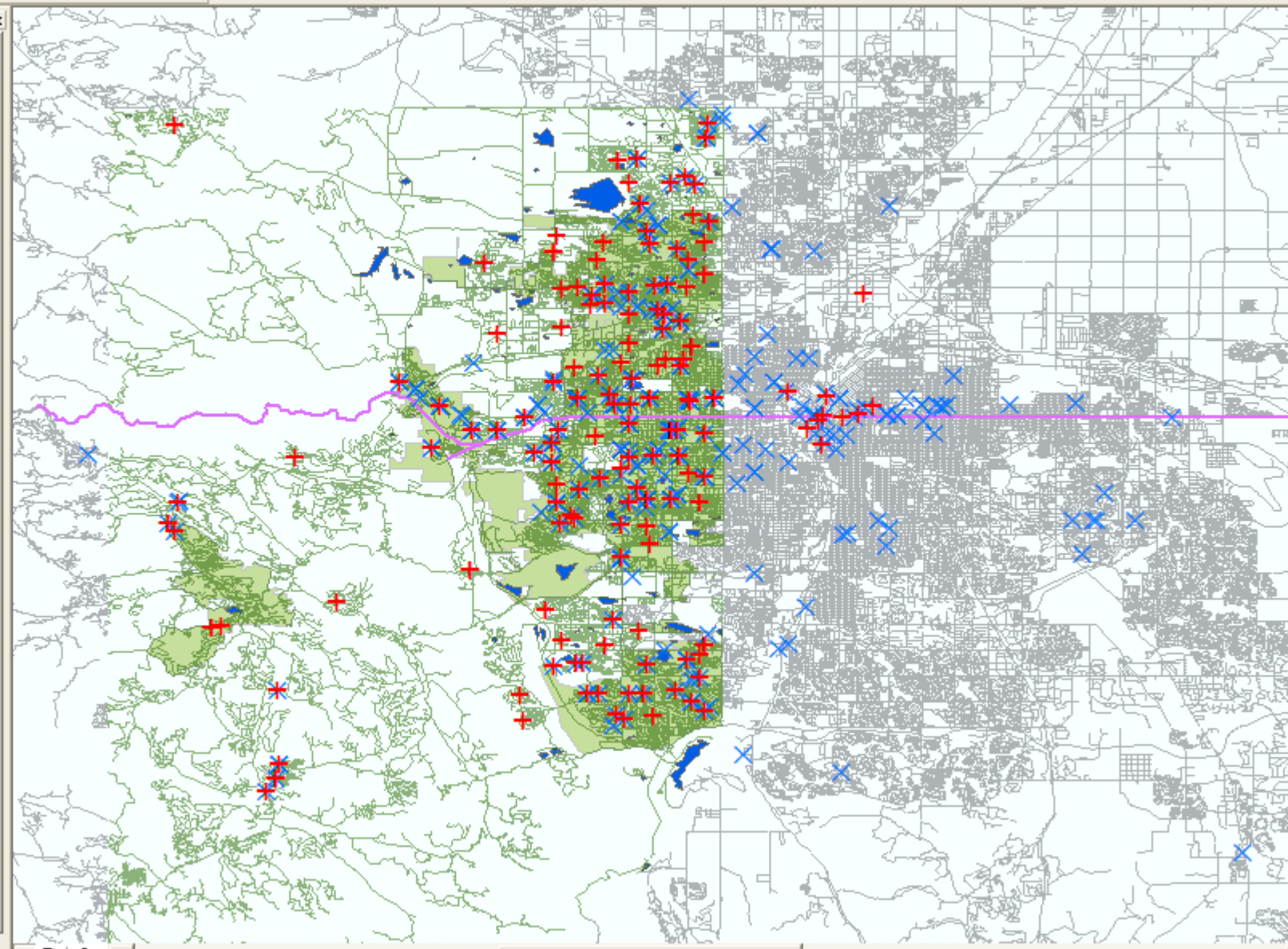

Future Trends

- Provider Resource Database
 - Searchable web-based provider resource database
 - Identification of physical and/or service areas with inadequate resources in relation to socio-economic deprivation areas
- Needs Assessment
 - conduct comprehensive, quantifiable, and defensible needs assessments for
 - Grants
 - Strategic plan



Benefits of GIS in resource identification

- A comprehensive database of existing services;
- A basis to build communication networks and cooperation among government and community providers;
- The ability to create an efficient system that avoids duplication of efforts;
- An understanding of the geographical distribution of resources;
- The identification of resources lacking in the county and specific communities; and
- Knowledge differences among diverse participant groups
