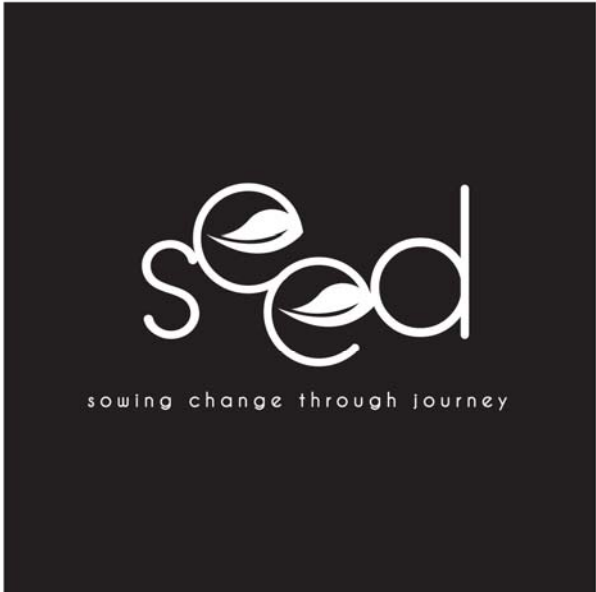
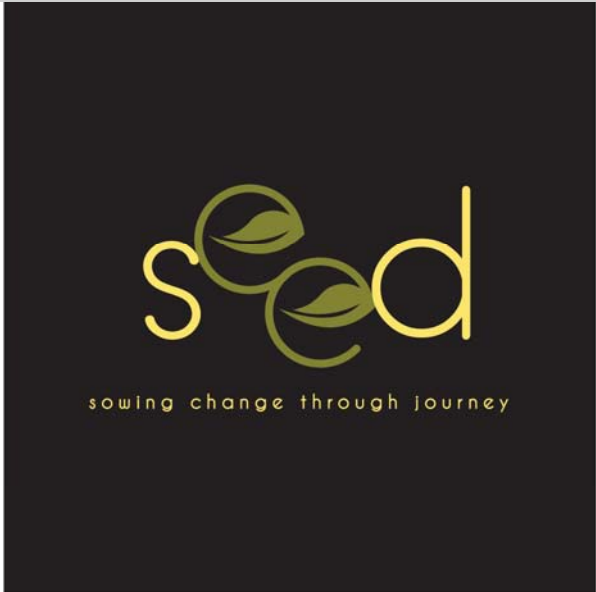


Figure 1: Seed Wordmark.

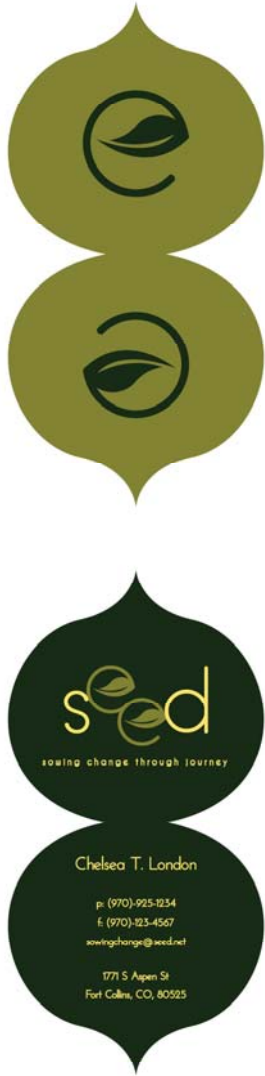
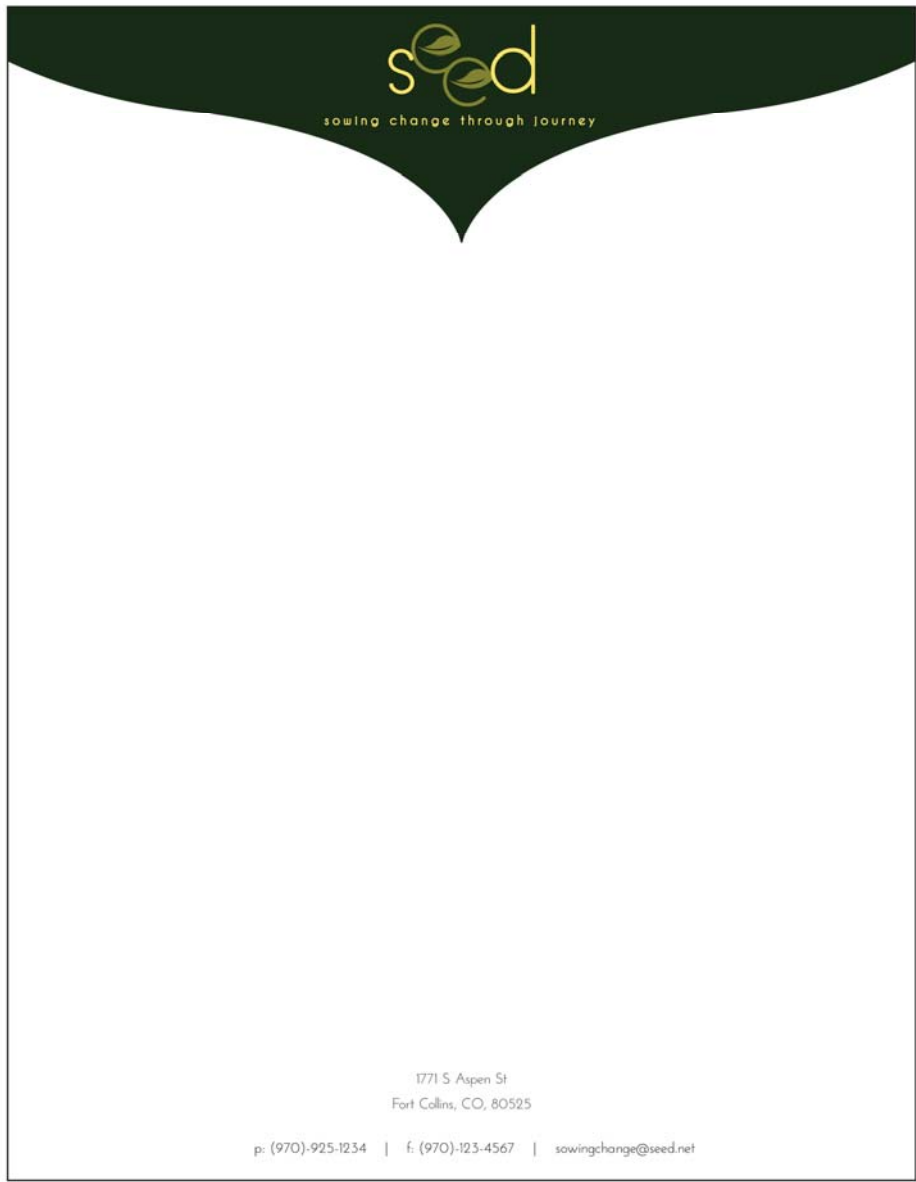


Figure 2: Seed Letterhead Combine.

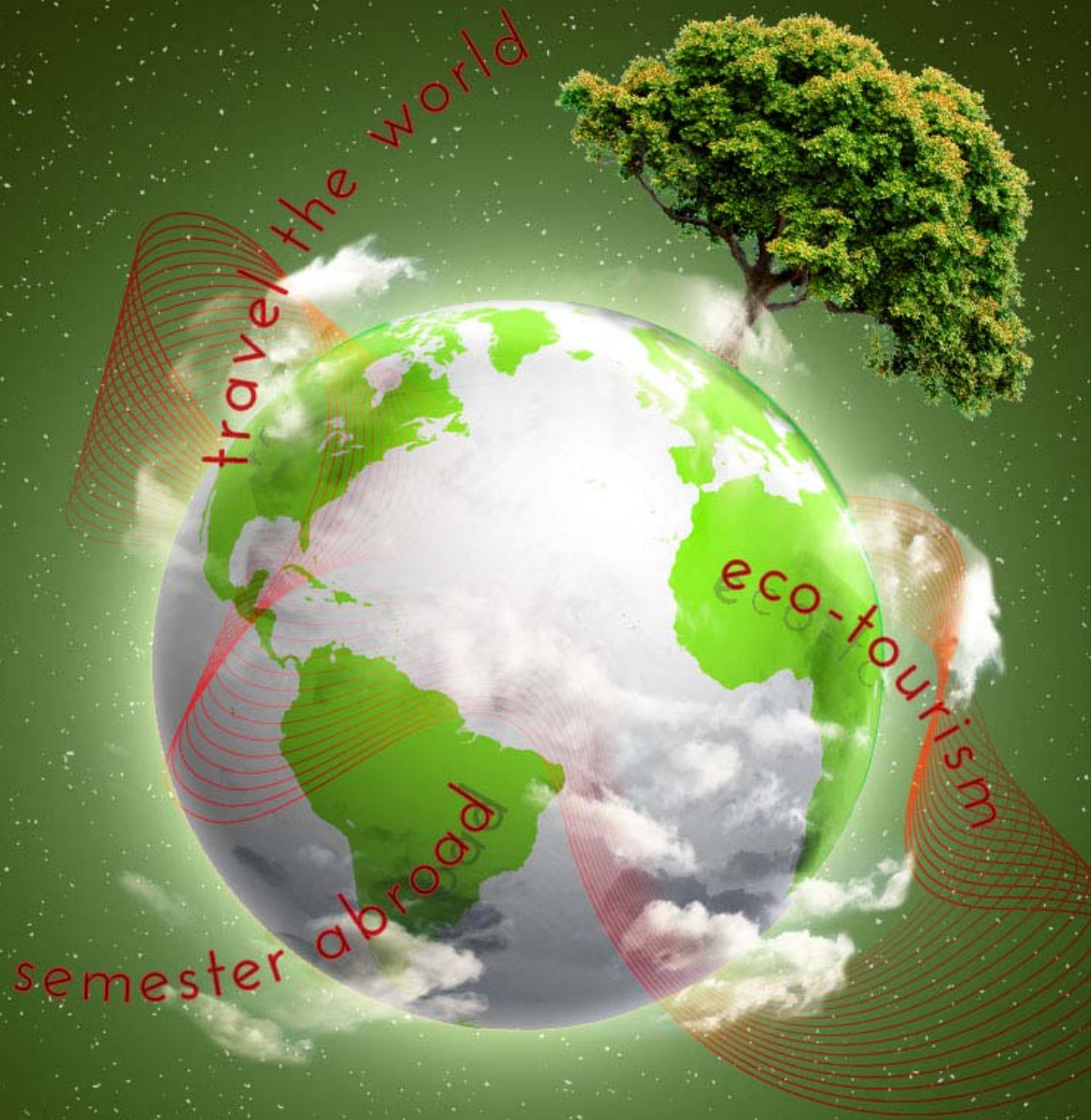

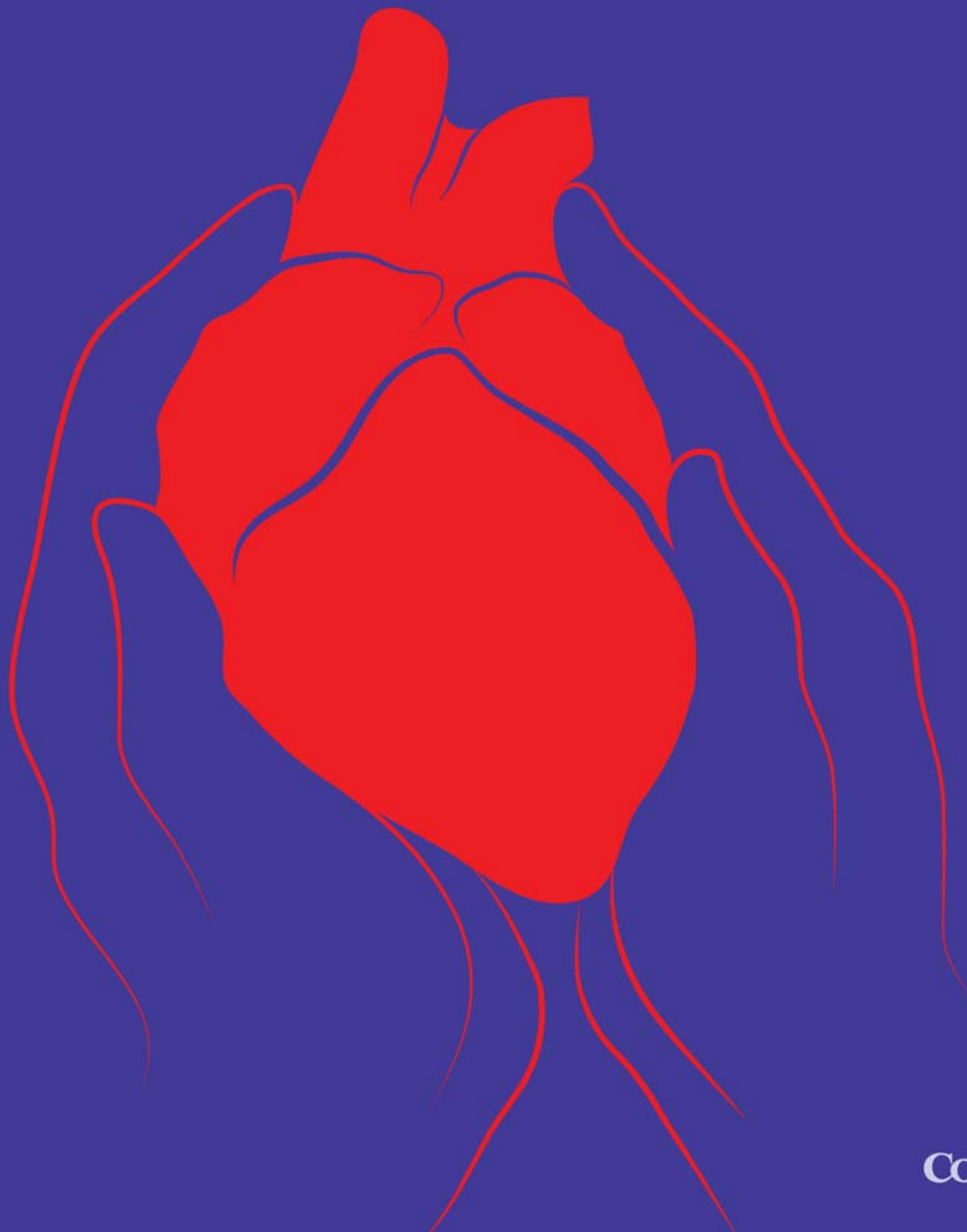

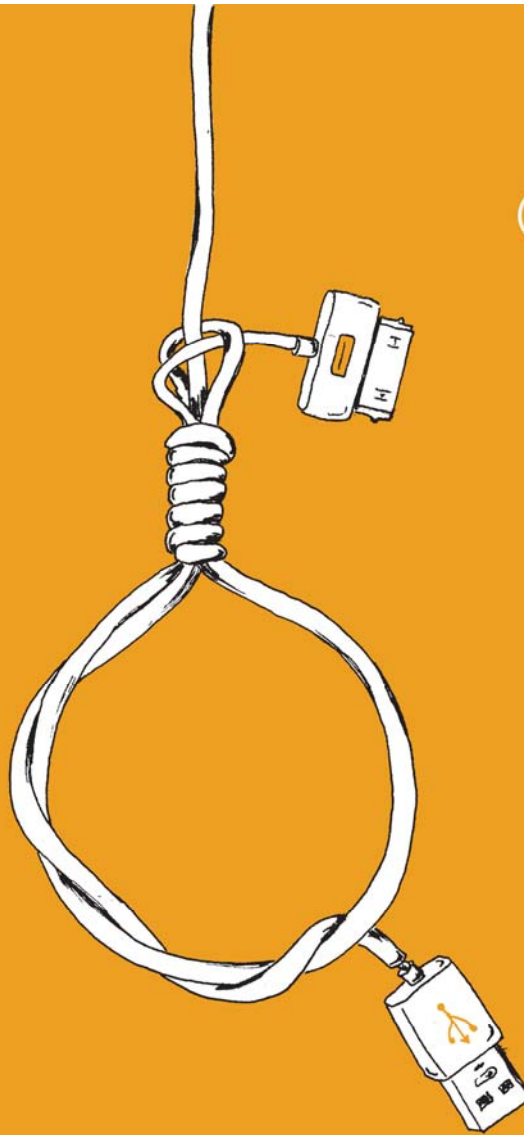
Figure 6: Colloquium Poster.





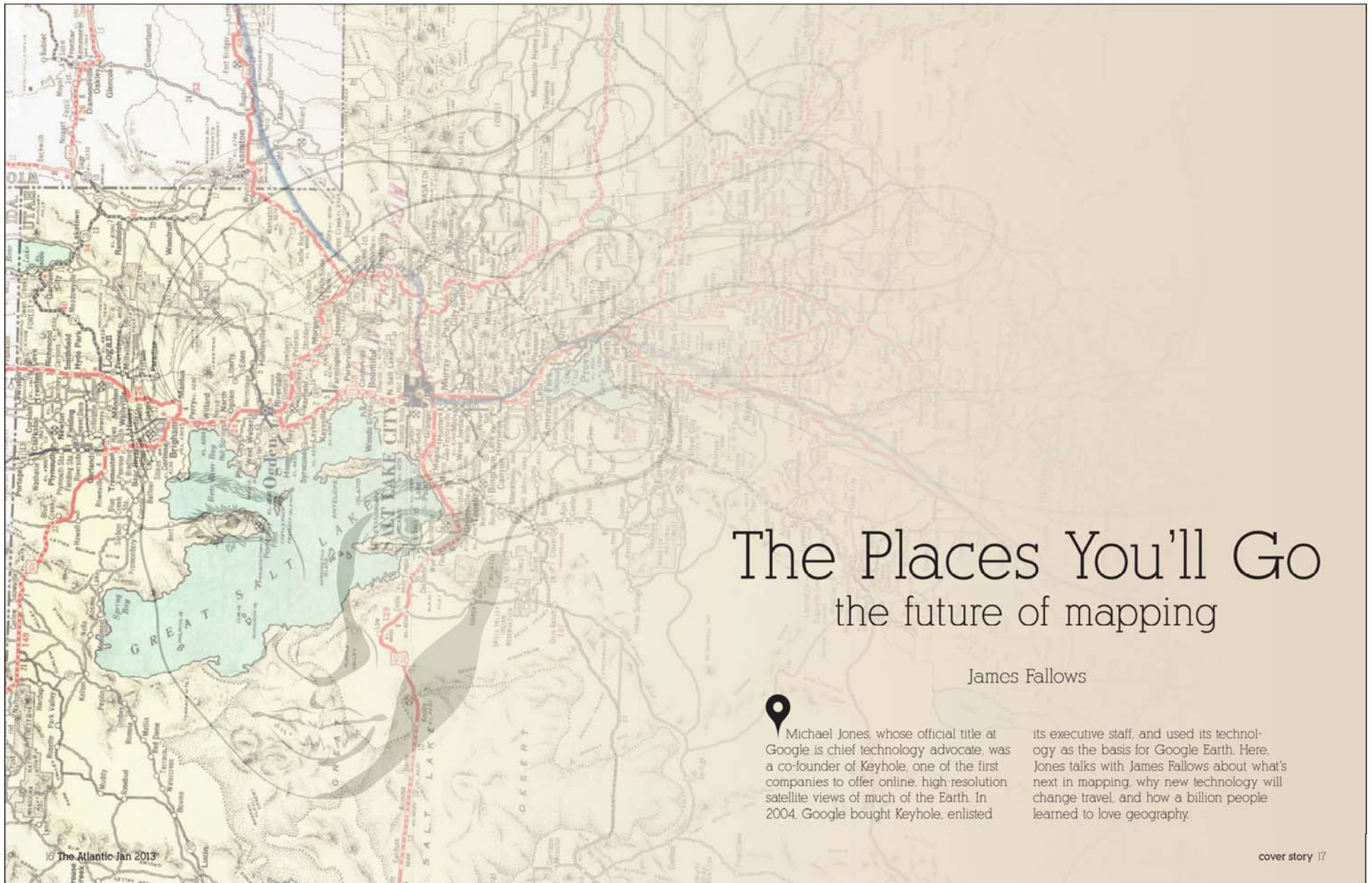

Michael Jones, whose official title at Google is chief technology advocate, was a co-founder of Keyhole, one of the first companies to offer online, high-resolution satellite views of much of the Earth. In 2004, Google bought Keyhole, enlisted

its executive staff, and used its technology as the basis for Google Earth. Here, Jones talks with James Fallows about what's next in mapping, why new technology will change travel, and how a billion people learned to love geography.

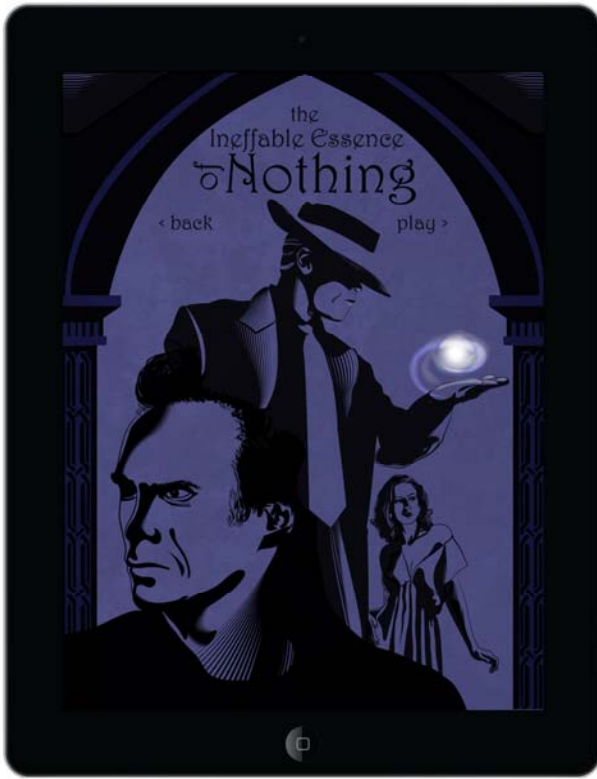


Figure 12: Essence Ipad Art.

Arcturian Fizz

Ingredients:

- 100 flexible plastic straws
- 3 envelopes unflavored gelatin
- 3 cups boiling water
- 3/4 cup whipping cream
- 12 to 15 drops green food coloring
- 1 package (6 ounces) raspberry or grape flavor gelatin
- an empty, cleaned 1-quart milk or orange juice carton

Recipe:

1. Combine gelatins in a bowl with boiling water; stir until dissolved. Chill until lukewarm.
2. Extend straws to full length; place in tall container. Wrap together with a loose rubber band.
3. Mix cream and food coloring with gelatin mixture. Pour into container, filling straws.
4. Cover & chill until gelatin is firm, at least 8 hours.
5. Pull straws from container & pull apart. Run hot tap water for about 2 seconds over 3 to 4 straws at a time. Starting at the empty ends, push worms from straws. Place on plate & chill for 1 hour. Serve when ready.

Ingredients:

- 1 carton of Raspberries
- 1 carton of Blueberries
- 1 carton of Blackberries
- 2 Jell-O cups
- Vanilla Ice cream
- Sprite

Recipe:

1. Cut Jell-O into bite-sized cubes. Place in a tall glass.
2. Put a pinch-full of each of the berries into the glass.
3. Scoop in vanilla ice cream.
4. Pour Sprite over the concoction. Eat with a spoon or sip out of a straw.
