



THESE STREAMS OF WATER will be a spectacular 400-foot high waterfall when Morrow Point Dam in western Colorado is finished and its reservoir fills. They come from the free-fall spillway outlets of the scale model being tested in the Bureau of Reclamation's Design and Research Center in Denver. Morrow Point will be the second dam in the Curecanti Unit of the \$1 Billion Colorado River Storage Project--downstream from Blue Mesa Dam, now a-building. Bid calls for construction of Morrow Point Dam will be issued in February.
