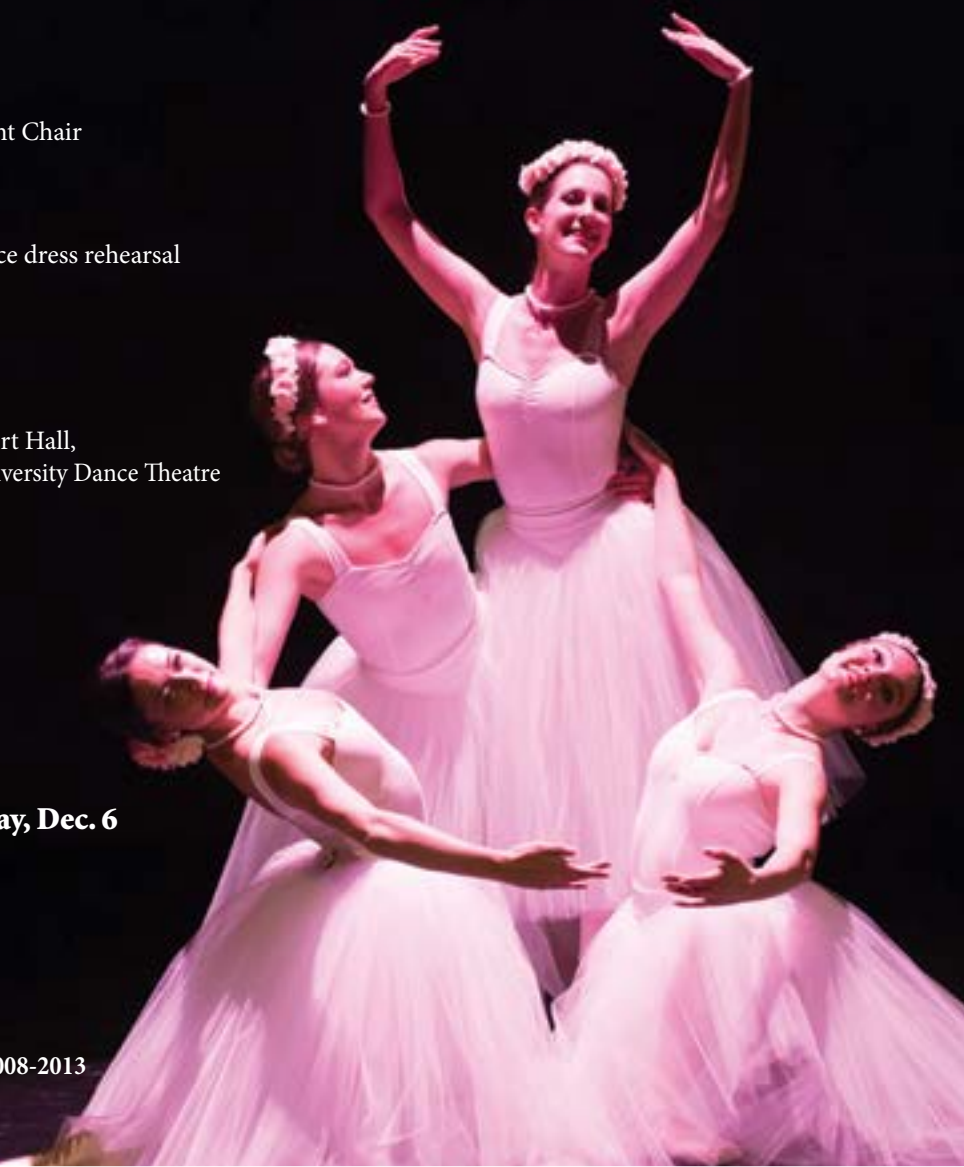

### PROGRAM NOTES

#### *Mass in G Major*

Franz Schubert (1797-1828)

Schubert wrote his now famous *Mass in G Major* in 1815, despite being only eighteen years old. This year of 1815 proved especially prolific for the young composer. He not only started and completed composition of this masterwork, but he also produced some of his most well-loved Lieder — including “Gretchen am Spinnrade,” “Heideroslein” and “Erlkönig.” *The Mass in G Major* had its first performance in Schubert’s own home church on the outskirts of Vienna. This work, and indeed Schubert’s own life, serves as a bridge from the ordered structure of the Classical Era to the expressive freedom of the Romantic Period. While many aspects of Classical compositional technique abound, certain hints of romanticism creep out of the framework. Schubert’s painting with romantic strokes proves especially true at times when he brings out particular sections of text in order to express theological meaning. Curiously, some of the text of the Credo, or Creed section, is left out. This sort of omission, however, was not wholly uncommon for composers of Schubert’s day, and the Catholic Church remained relatively lax about such artistic licenses. Additionally, the Church standardized a unified pronunciation of Latin text in the Mass throughout Europe, so it is highly likely that the first performance of this *Mass in G Major* was performed with a Germanized Latin. In keeping with that spirit, the Concert Choir will also sing adhering to the same pronunciation.
