

"The significance of the symphony can never be diminished, said conductor Wes Kenney. "There are many ways to look at the meaning of this inspired opus...we can hardly imagine what the enigmatic composer was living through..." Ottorino Respighi's colorful *Trittico Botticelliano* (1927), and Malcolm Arnold's *Trumpet Concerto Op. 125* are also on the program.
