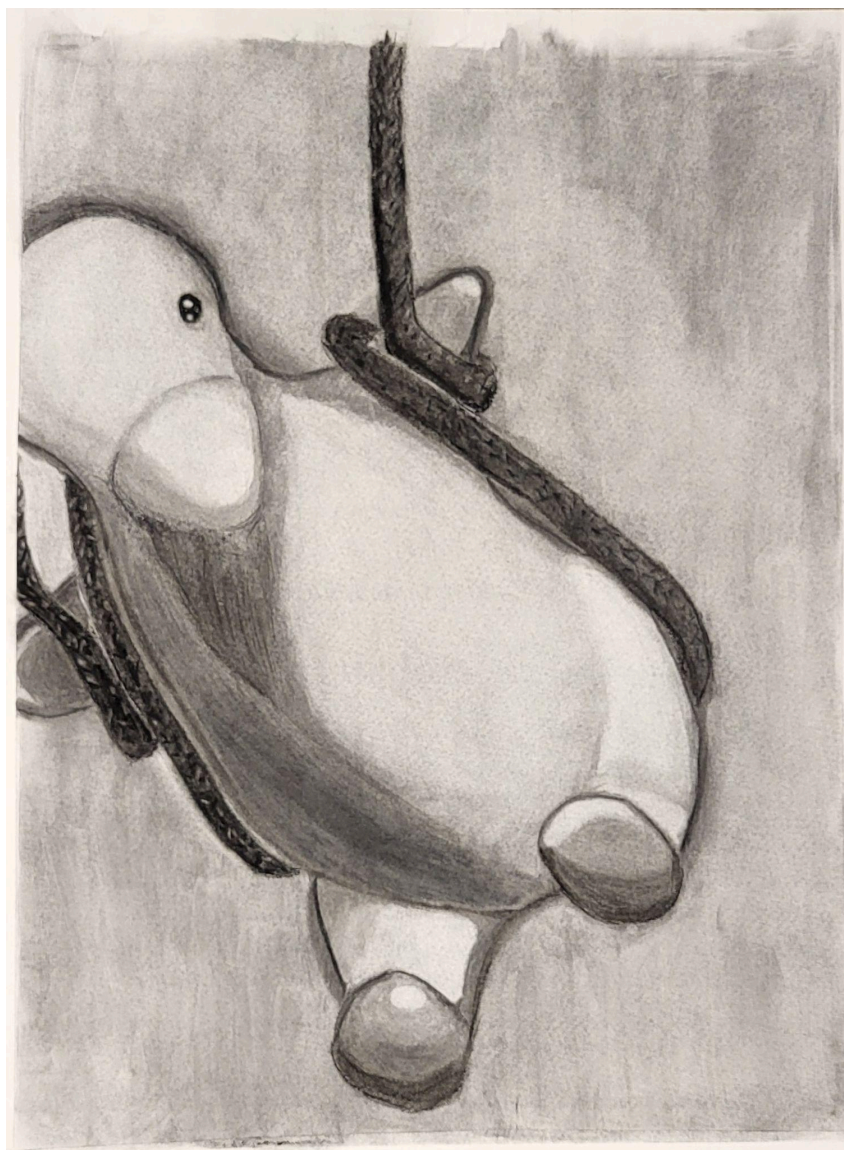


Figure 2: Perpetual Descent

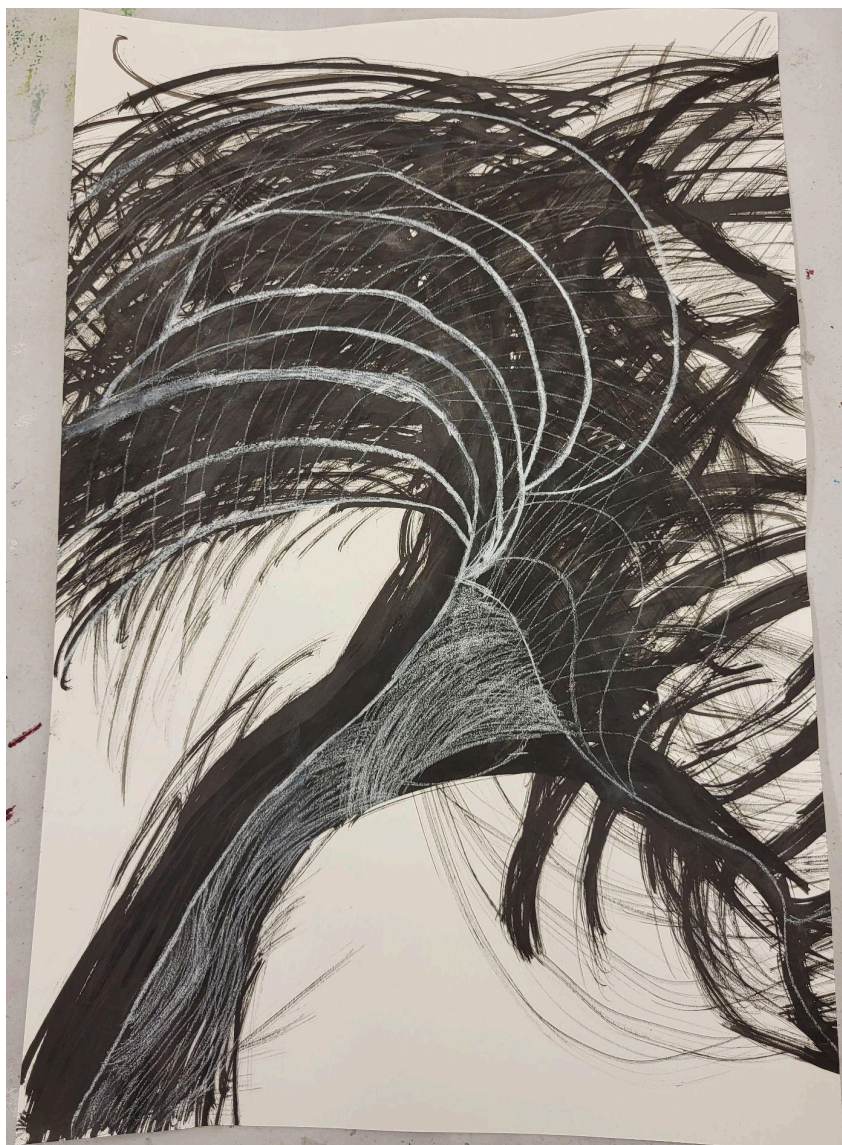


Figure 5: Spirit of Contrast

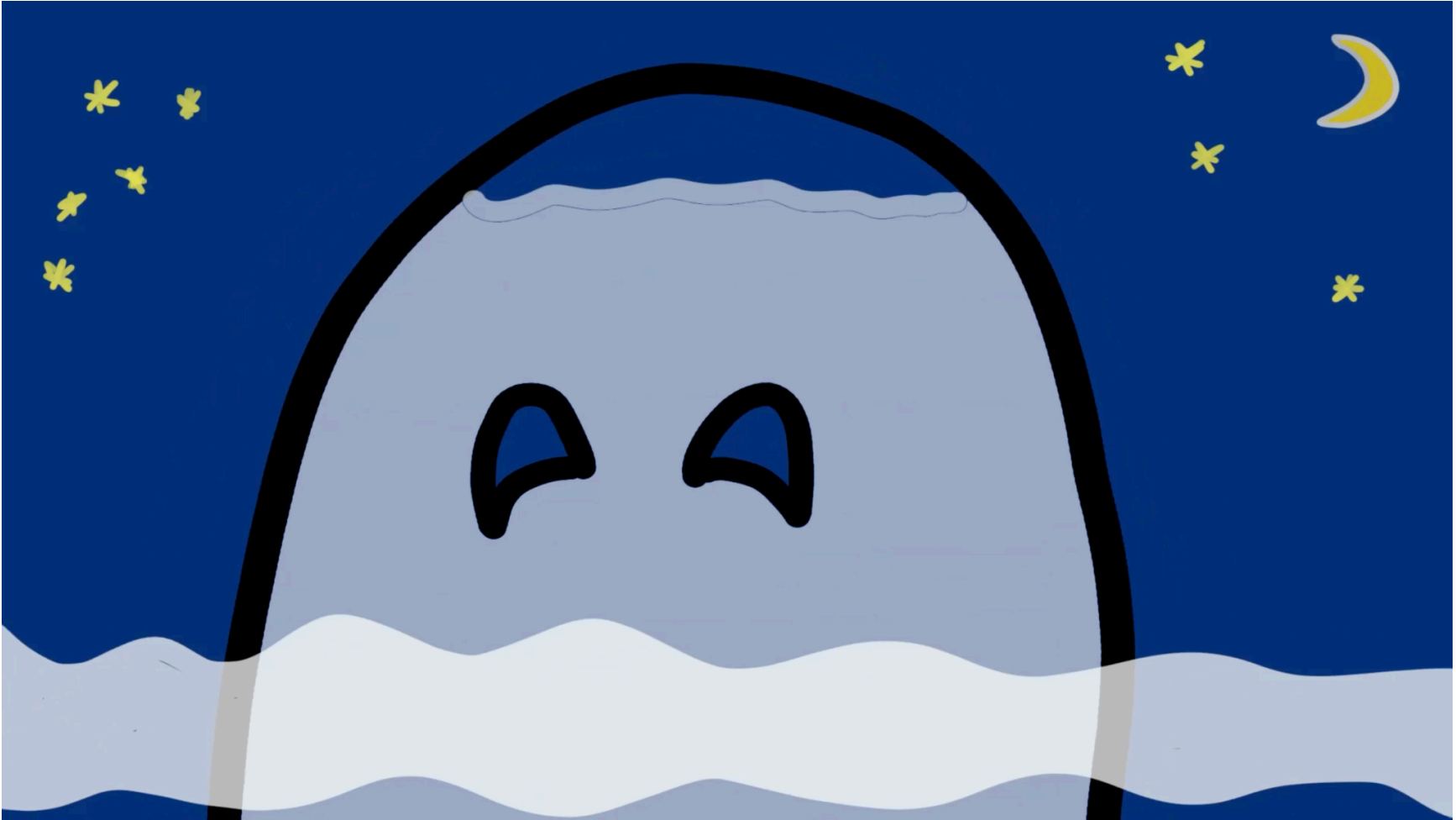


Figure 6: Redolent <https://vimeo.com/1191402622?fl=tl&fe=ec>

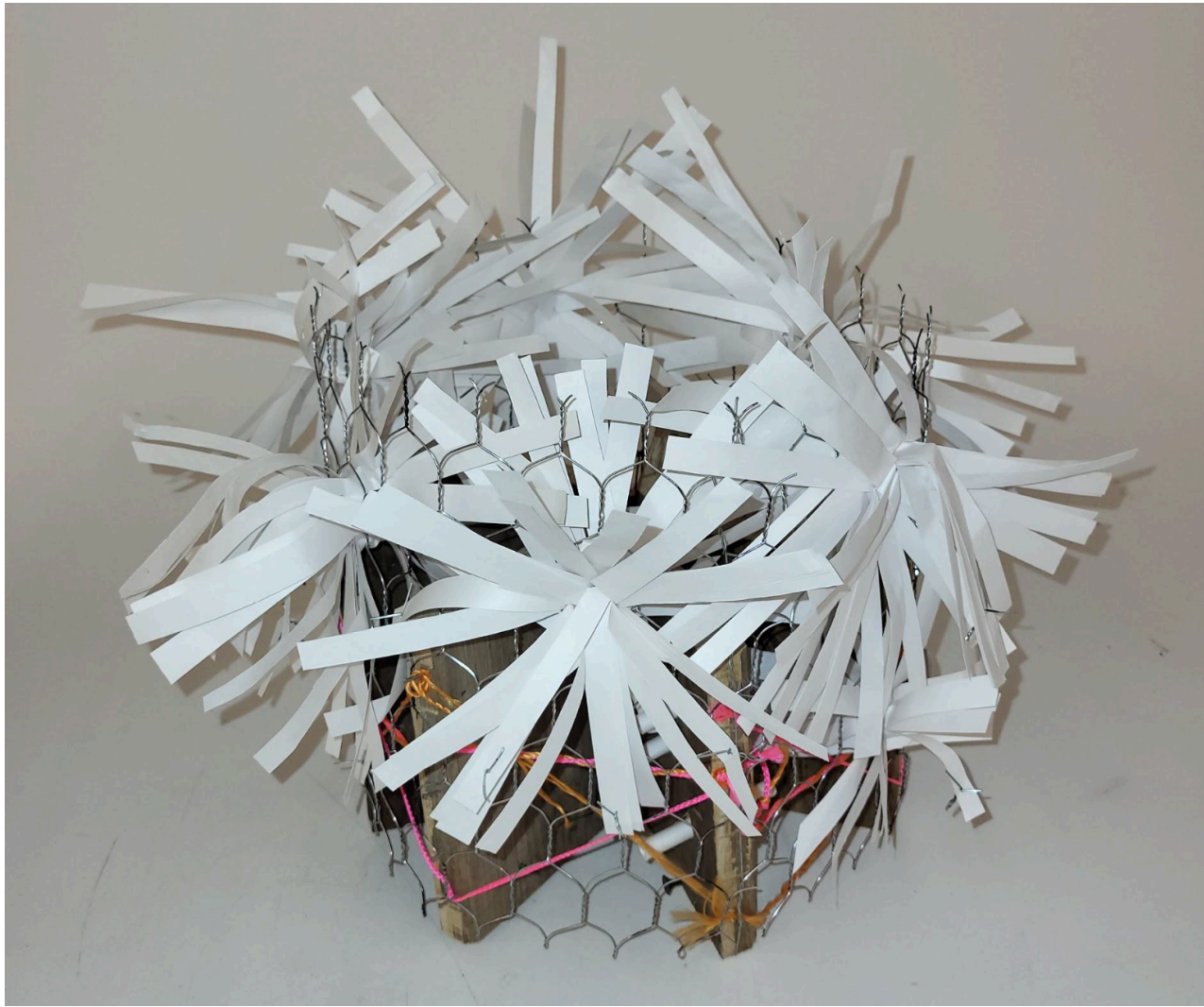
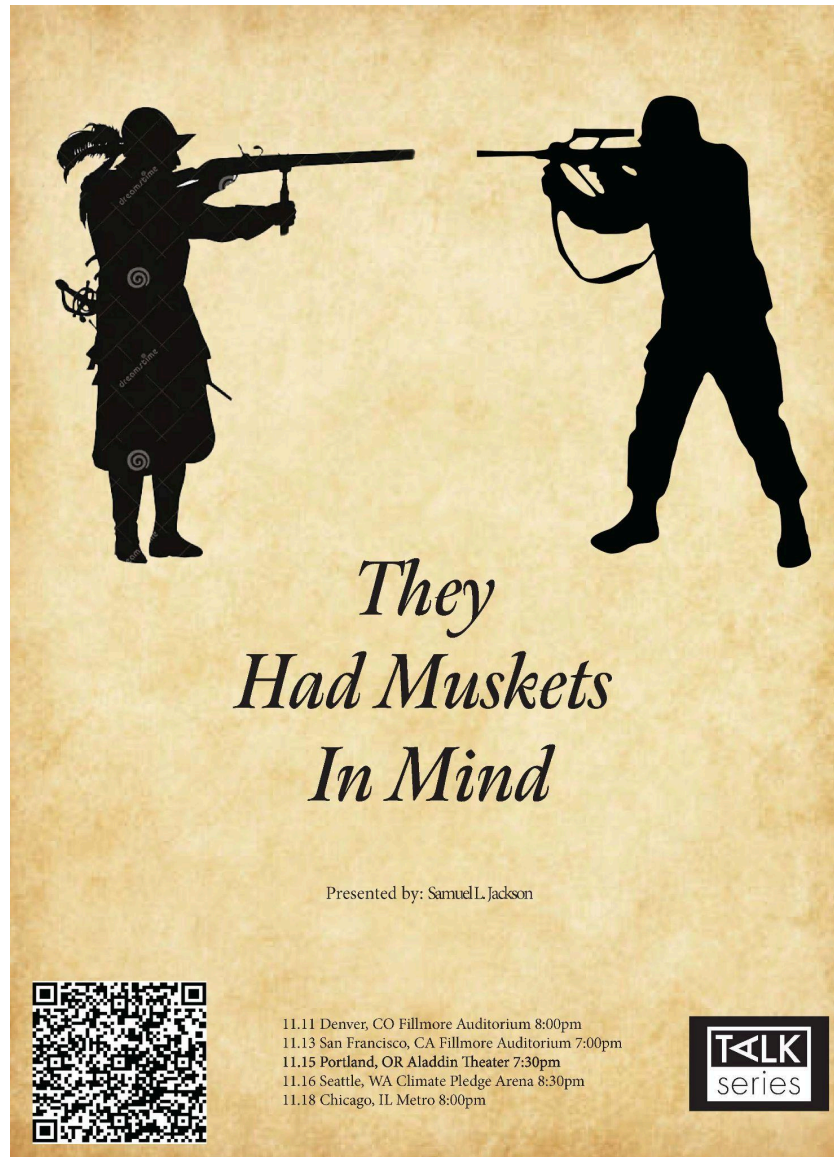


Figure 8: Firework Festival
