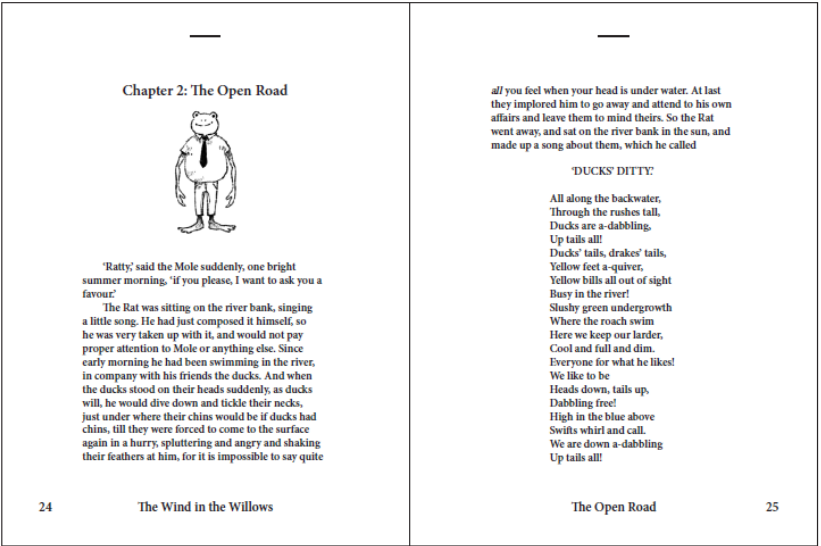
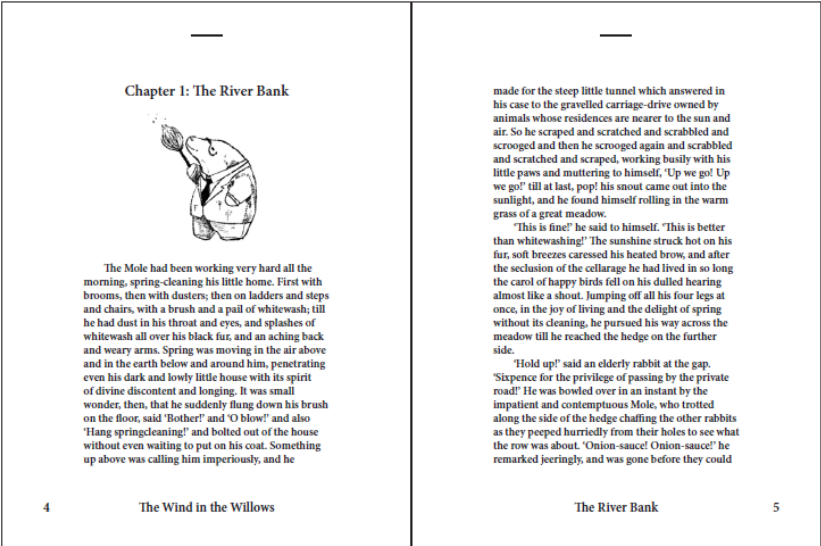


Figure 1: Wind in the Willows Illustrated Book

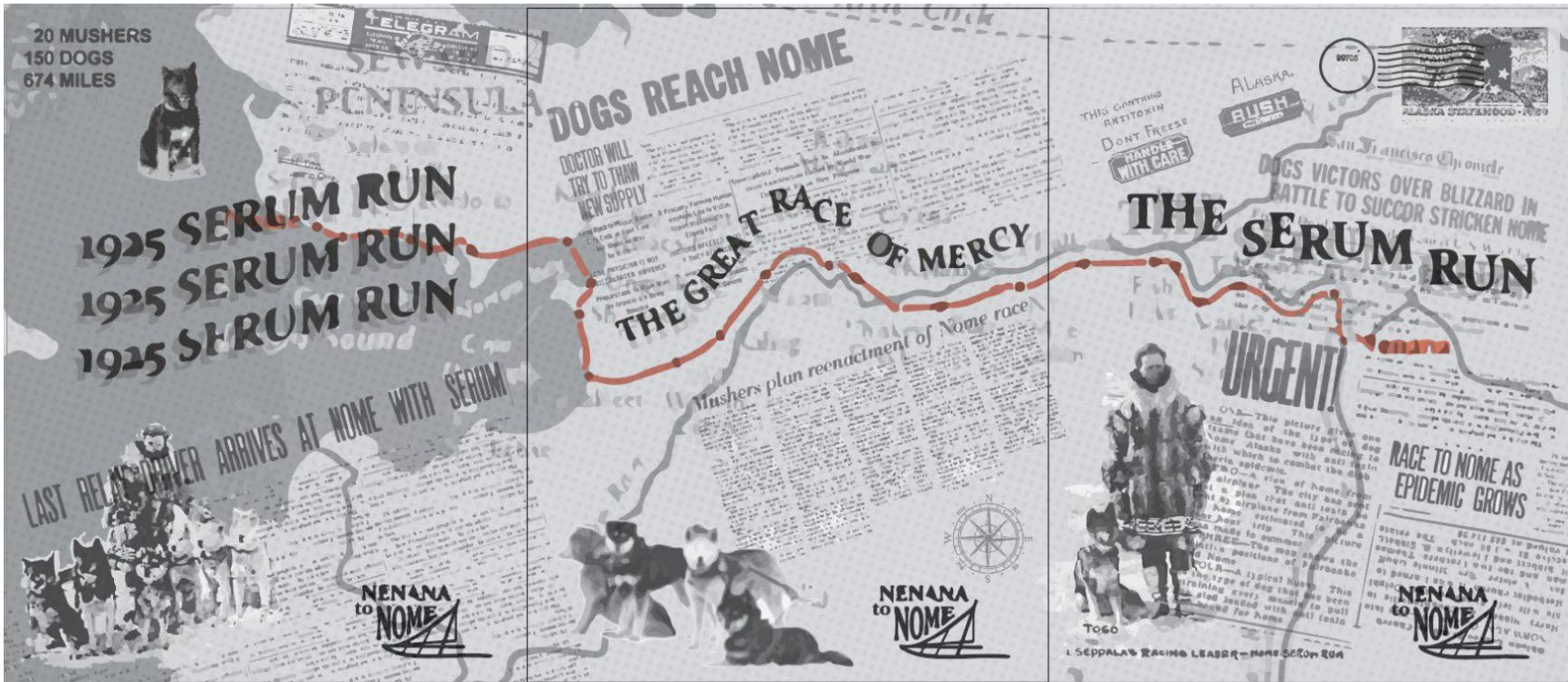
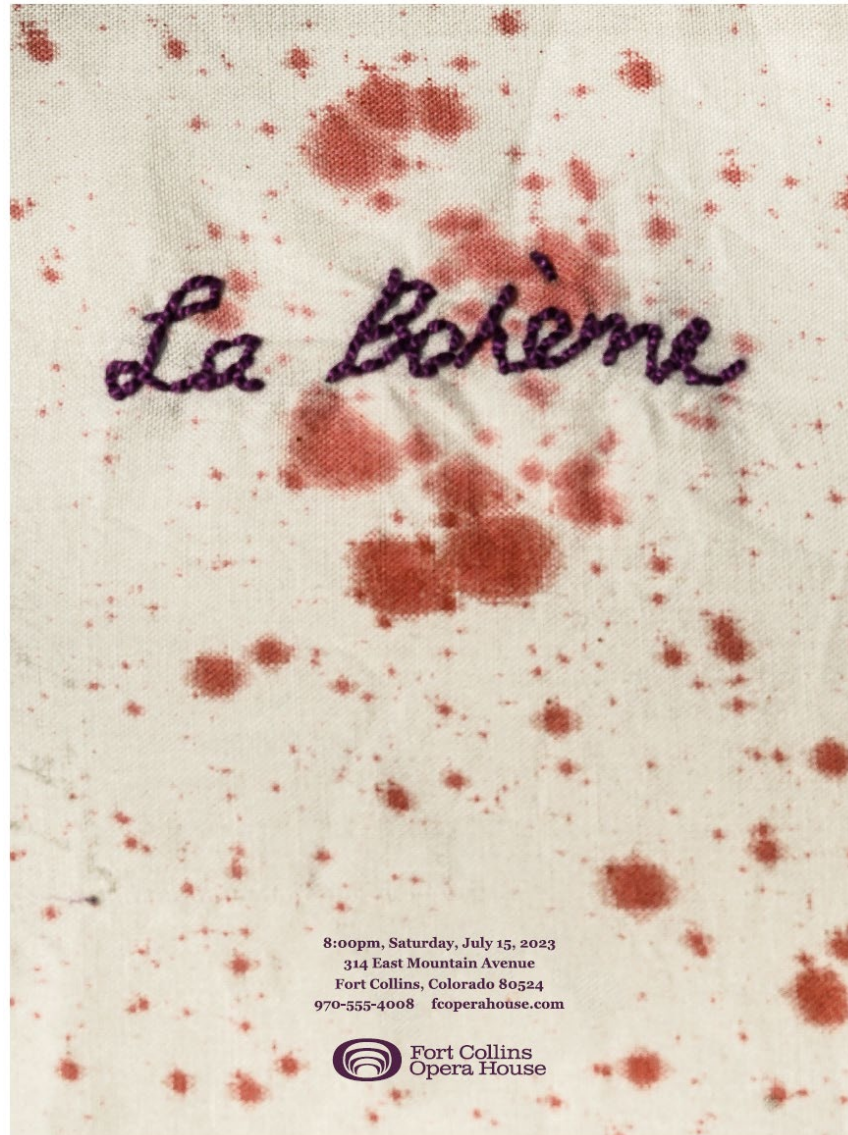


Figure 2: Nenana to Nome Poster Triptych
