<p>This project is part of the implementation of the City of Boulder's Forest Ecosystem Management Plan (FEMP) and Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP). Both plans are focused on protecting the community of Boulder and restoring more natural and healthy conditions to the forests managed by the City of Boulder Open Space and Mountain Parks department. This project involves thinning approximately 85 acres of low elevation ponderosa pine forest on public land immediately adjacent to the City of Boulder.</p> <p>The project area is located south of the City approximately half a mile SW of Lehigh St. The area is dominated by young ponderosa pine at the forest/grassland ecotone. Thinning will focus on removing a large portion of small to medium diameter trees and creating an open stand structure. Overall, basal area will be decreased by approx. 40%. The overall goals of the project are to build on work already complete in the area and create a more fire resistant landscape immediately adjacent to the city. The project will also create a forest structure that more closely resembles historic conditions and is less susceptible to insects and disease and improves habitat for native wildlife and plant species.</p>	

Scope of Work / Project Timeline

4 This project will run from approximately July thru December and will include cutting, skidding, chipping and wood removal from the site. Work will also include tree marking, some education and outreach, and post-treatment monitoring to measure project success. All of the layout, monitoring, and outreach tasks will be done by Open Space and Mountain Parks (OSMP) permanent staff.

Grant funding will be applied to part of the cost of thinning operations. OSMP supports an annual seasonal thinning crew that completes much of the work in Boulder's forests. OSMP also has the equipment necessary to complete this type of work. Grant funding will be applied to the cost of hiring and maintaining a crew for the time necessary to complete this project. The forest crew is responsible for and will complete all aspects of the thinning operations including cutting, skidding, hauling and chipping.

Describe all planned long-term maintenance (grant funded or other).

Long-term maintenance will include monitoring and additional thinning in the future when necessary. All treatments on OSMP include pre and post-treatment overstory inventories. These inventories measure structure and composition and inform when and where management occurs. The inventory will also measure the success of the treatment and more thinning may be added to maintain desired conditions. All on-going forest work would be included in long-term OSMP workplans.

Project layout, planning, and marking will begin in early April and will likely take 3 to 4 weeks. Cutting will begin in mid to late July with project completion anticipated in December of 2010. All aspects of the project including cutting, chipping, skidding and hauling should be complete by the end of the year.

5 All of the work for this project will be completed by OSMP staff with some collaboration with the City fire department. OSMP works closely with City Fire on many forest projects and the Fire department provides staff for project implementation. Fire staff is not fully dedicated to this project but they will provide a number of work days. City employees and equipment will be used for all cutting, skidding, chipping, and hauling.

Work to be completed: This grant will cover the costs of fuels reduction on prioritized treatment around the Watertank project area. This award is based on the Emergency Supplemental Fund Grant Application. Approximately eighty-five acres or more of fuels reduction treatment will occur.

All grant funds will be used as a 100% reimbursement for work done within the identified treatment area, up to \$470/acre. City of Boulder OSMP will initially cover the cost of implementation by paying contractor(s). The CB OSMP will act as the grant award reimbursement recipient. The estimated cost for fuels reduction is set at \$950 per acre.

Milestone dates: The CB OSMP has agreed to serve as the contracting entities for this project. Initial project boundaries have been mapped using a GPS. Upon approval of this Scope of Work and award to contractor(s), implementation is planned to begin in April of 2010 and end by April of 2011. These grant funds will be available through the end of the grant period (April 15, 2011). As implementation is completed, CB OSMP will submit an "Attachment B: Grant Report/Reimbursement Request" to the local CSFS. A CSFS representative will inspect the reported acreage before reimbursement approval.

Standards and Guidelines: All project work will meet CSFS shaded fuel break/fuels reduction guidelines. CSFS will complete the initial project setup by inspecting treatment area boundaries proposed by CB OSMP. The CB OSMP Mitigation Coordinator will be responsible for communicating with affected landowners as necessary and ensuring the project is completed within the grant cycle.

Project Period: April 15, 2010 through April 15, 2011

Subaward Amount: \$39,950.00 **Minimum Cooperator Match:** \$0.00

Deliverables: Approximately eighty-five acres of shaded fuel break fuels reduction. The project will benefit the city of Boulder by contributing to efforts that aim to create landscape level fuel breaks, as well as creating forest structures that more closely resemble historic forest structure. This will also help to create forests that are less susceptible to insect and disease outbreaks, as well as improved habitats for wildlife species.

Project Types: Information/Education, and Implementation/ Treatment

All work completed under this subaward must be certified as meeting minimum Colorado State Forest Service standards prior to any reimbursement being made to the subawardee. Attachment B to the subaward entitled "Attachment B, Grant Report/Reimbursement Request, WSFM Competitive Grants" will be the document used to both request reimbursement and to certify that work has been completed to minimum standards.
