South 42degrees 45'23" West 171.62 feet

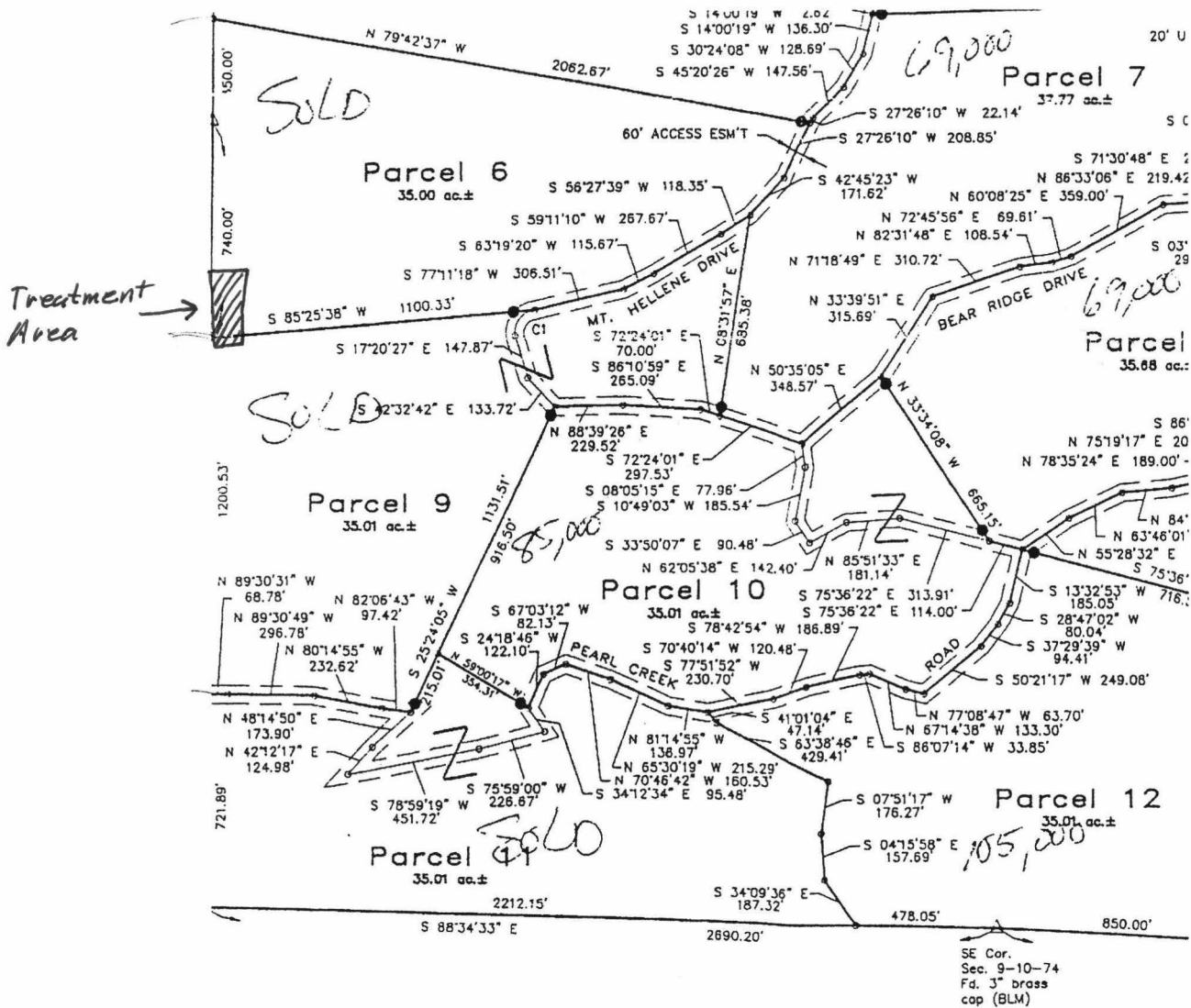
South 56 degrees 27'39" West 118.35 feet
