[00:01 - 01:49] Speaker 1: We- the next thing that we're going to work on are the discussion breakout sessions. Um, and so I have a couple of rules and and how we want these to work. You've all, we put you all into different groups. Those, again are identified on your badges. In your conference packet, you have that wonderful map of this floor that should help you identify, based on your group number, what your room is. Um, we are going to, and you also have the list of the starter questions. Those were just things that we came up with, with regards to these topical areas, as ways to start thinking and start the discussion. Um, we have a moderator for each discussion, and we also have somebody else who's going to be working to take notes, kind of capture the big themes, capture the big things that emerge from the discussions. So a couple of different things. Um, respect other people's rights and time to talk so that they'll respect your own. Don't talk over each other. Give the scribe time to capture things. That's going to take a little bit of time, and they may ask you to pause for a second or do something like that. Um, we want the discussions to go on for about 55 minutes or so. We are asking that the moderators break about five minutes before the hour. Um, the moderator and the scribe are going to look at the notes, and they're going to decide the three big things that will bring back to the wrap up. We're going to be capturing all of the notes, getting them transcribed. So all of this will be packaged together and put into, um, probably we're going to put it into our digital repository as proceedings of the day, and we'll let everybody know when all of this material is ready.

But in order to keep things moving along, we just asked that for each group, they bring back their kind of three big things that we think are important. Um, I think that's about it. Um, again, if you need to grab some more
