<b>Brief description of the work being asked of the student employee or describe instructional need</b>	Provide technical support for in-class technical issues arising from the interface of Echo360, Canvas, personal laptops, classroom microphones, etc. Most DVM courses are team taught (1-17 instructors per course). Courses with several instructors tend to suffer from inconsistencies in the use of technology, which can result in poor recordings/live streams (or no recordings at all). This limits remote students and the TILT Captioning team.
<b>Identify specific Course and/or Research Project</b>	All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year spring semester DVM courses (n=30)
<b>Identify any training needed for the student employee</b> (technology, seating chart instruction, etc.)	Students will be selected based on existing expertise with technology. Additional training will be provided for Zoom, Teams, and Canvas along with training in working professionally with faculty.
