Artist Statement:

The goal of my work is not to be viewed as tools for science but for dialogue between what we do and do not know.




Figure 1: Behind the Shadows




Figure 4: The Little Things 3




Figure 6: Landscape of the Empty (detail)




Figure 9: Snow Fall 1
