With this slash disposal, the fire department will be able to increase the number of properties with defensible spaces and preserve healthy forests.

Property owners who have taken the time to create defensible spaces around their homes, will continue to maintain and expand their defensible spaces. The same property owners want neighbors to follow suit. This grant gives property owners an opportunity to work together to create defensible spaces through out the neighborhood with the ability to dispose of the slash conveniently and quickly. This will also help other residents to create and/or maintain defensible spaces and work towards being FireWise communities.
