[00:00 - 00:45] Horse trainer: This mare displays a moderate to severe behavior score. When palpating the cranial cervical region in these horses, I hold the halter for more control and to avoid getting bitten. The mare shows for circulation and mild to moderate avoidance behavior to palpation along the length of the brachiocephalicus muscle. There is a mild response to palpation of the subclavius muscle, as she turns her head and neck away. There is minimal response of the trapezius muscle to palpation. However, more aggressive behavior is initiated at the thoracolumbar region and continues to escalate as palpation travels cuddly through the lumbar region into the metal gluteal to the caudal sacrum, the mare becomes completely resistant to any palpation, and she becomes more and more difficult and dangerous to handle.
