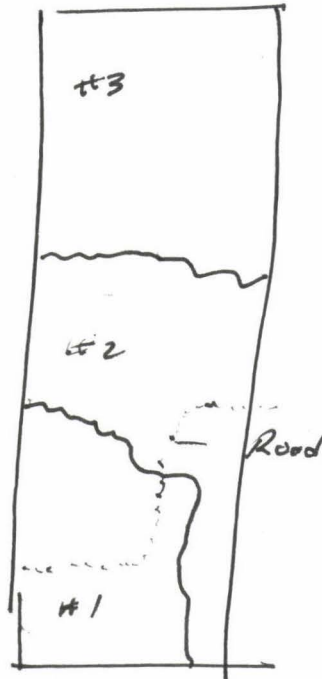

Dear Forest Landowner:

Last year, I wrote that the Forest Land Enhancement Program (FLEP) was not going to be funded. At the beginning of the year, I had heard that, through the diligent efforts of forest landowners (incl. Tree Farmers) and some in Washington D.C., the FLEP program was going to be revived.

Last month, the Fort Collins District received a small allocation to be distributed to forest landowners in Larimer County. Due to these limited funds, some applications may not be approved or partially funded. It is a 50/50 cost share reimbursement program.

Enclosed is an application for this FLEP cost share and must be returned by **June 20, 2005**. The forestry practice must include a forest health improvement and/or wildfire risk reduction component.

Once again, I encourage landowners in the Forest Ag Tax Program who have not been able to get much done these last few years to apply. You can use this opportunity and this cost-share to hire a contractor to do some thinning on your property.
