Program Notes

Overture and Arias from Il barbiere di siviglia

Rossini

As Classical period ideas began to take root in European musical culture, the *harmonie* ensemble, or chamber wind ensemble, emerged as an important musical force. After Emperor Joseph II established his own court harmonie in 1782, most of the courts across central Europe followed suit. As a brand new ensemble, there was not yet an established repertoire, so the leaders of each ensemble would craft both new compositions and arrangements for each concert. In addition, composers like Mozart composed some of their finest works for these small wind ensembles. The result was a flourishing of wind music around the turn of the nineteenth-centruy.

The set of four movements taken from Rossini's *Il barbiere di siviglia*, or *The Barber of Seville*, was derived from a more complete set of 22 pieces from the opera. These colorful transcriptions by Wenzel Sedlak reflect the sophisticated approach to orchestration that had developed in the two generations since the early beginnings of the harmonie ensemble.

Chants d'Auvergne Canteloube

The five series of *Chants d'Auvergne*, or Songs from the Auvergne, represent Joseph Canteloube's love of the folk music from his native France, especially the Auvergne region. Though he occasionally wrote purely symphonic works, he is best known for his colorful settings of these native songs for voice with either piano or orchestral accompaniment. In the Chants d'Auvergne, Canteloube tends to retain the original folk melody, while exploring new metric, harmonic, and timbral possibilities in the accompaniment. Tonight's setting for chamber winds further expands the possibilities of these charming songs.

Serenade for Winds in D minor, Op. 44

Dvořák

Dvořák followed in a long line of composers who composed "serenades" for winds. Mozart's three works that carry the same title, set an early benchmark for music that fused lighter dance music with serious intentions in a single work. Dvořák includes many peasant-like dance tunes in his Serenade, including a quasi-furiant in the Trio of the second movement. Yet amongst these dance elements are qualities of fine compositional craftsmanship: each of the movements begins with an ascending fourth, Dvořák's pervasive use of dotted-rhythms, and the return of the opening musical material from the first movement at the conclusion of the piece, all reflect a composer extending the wind serenade tradition at the end of the Romantic era.
