



# **Train Depot 1892 - 1934**

In 1892, a small train depot opened near Old Main on the east side of the railroad tracks. Passenger trains stopped there so that people did not have to journey to and from the main station on Laporte Avenue. In 1924, students from the University of Colorado in Boulder set fire to the Victorian-style building just before the two schools met to play a football game. The station was rebuilt in a plainer style. In 1933, discussions began on removing it, and the rebuilt depot now stands in Fort Collins' City Park.
