Workshop Description:

This workshop will result in a new interpretation of the original master patterns of Mr. Blackwell, fashion arbiter and designer. These patterns along with the original designs are part of the Historic Costume and Textiles Collection at Colorado State University. Workshop participants will manipulate the original designs using Lectra Systems, Modaris pattern drafting program. Each participant will be supplied materials and work with a patron, to create an original garment, using couture techniques. The finished garments will be modeled in a gala event for Mr. Blackwell in fall 2000. Participants will have the opportunity to explore Mr. Blackwell's contributions to the world of fashion through original designs, patterns, and extensive memorabilia.
