The overall results show that my lessons were successful in improving some of the skills of the kids such as fine motor skills and knowledge of different cultures, for example

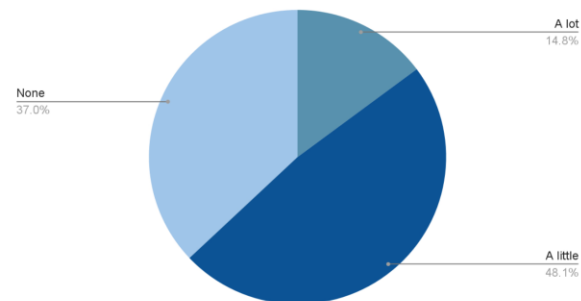
