PUBLIC FUELWOOD SALE

AUGUST 17, 1987 -- The Fort Collins District of the Colorado State Forest Service has announced a public fuelwood sale near Pingree Park, approximately 50 miles from Fort Collins.

The sale consists of 12 units to be clearcut, ranging from .3 to 1.8 acres. Fuelwood is green standing lodgepole pine from 3" to 14" in diameter. Each unit will be sold based on a flat rate of \$10 per cord. Volume varies from four cords for the smallest unit to twelve cords for the largest.

The area is accessible to four-wheel-drive vehicles only. Permits and information may be obtained at the Colorado State Forest Service, CSU Foothills Campus, Bldng 1052, Fort Collins CO 80523, or call 491-8660 during business hours.

FUELWOOD SALE

This permit valid only on September _____, 1987.

LOCATION: Pingree Park, (section 17 T7N, R73W).

HOURS: Saturday, September 12, 7:30 a.m.--4:00 p.m.

Sunday, September 13, 7:30 a.m.--4:00 p.m.

All permittees must arrive by 12:00 a.m. to be allowed into the cutting area.

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

1. Limited to 3/4 ton truck or less capacity.
2. Remove only dead and downed material. There are 3 types present: blow down, previously cut trees, and slash.
3. Boundaries are posted with red flagging. No firewood to be removed outside the posted area.
4. Drive only on existing road and skid trails located in the fuelwood area.
5. Do not block any roadway with vehicles or wood.
6. All equipment, including chainsaws, must be equipped with approved spark arrestors and or muffler.
7. Campfires or any other open fire are not permitted.
8. Permittees are responsible for providing a fire extinguisher or filled water container of 5 gallon size, and at least one shovel.
9. Report any fire to the State Forest Service.
10. Please do not litter. Pack out all trash.
11. Permit is for one load on date indicated.
12. Permit fee is \$10. This fee is nonrefundable except in the case of adverse weather conditions (CSFS to make this determination).

Failure to comply with the above conditions may result in revocation of the permit, forfeiture of the wood, and/or legal action.

AGENT DESIGNATION: The State Board of Agriculture by and thru the State Forester is designated as sale administrator for the purposes of administering this public fuelwood sale and has power-of-attorney for these purposes.

LAW COMPLIANCE: The PERMITTEE/PURCHASER agrees to comply with all of the laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Colorado and it's sub-divisions.

HOLD HARMLESS: The PERMITTEE/PURCHASER shall indemnify and save harmless the LANDOWNER against all suites or actions of every kind and nature brought against the LANDOWNER for or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, firm, or corporation in connection with, or on account of, the performance of the work under this agreement or by any consequence of any negligence in connection with the same, or on account of any act or omission or commission of the PERMITTEE/PURCHASER or his sub-contractor, agents, servants, or employees, or for any cause arising out of the performance of the sub-contractors, agents, servants, or employees relating to this agreement.

BINDING ON HEIRS: The terms and conditions of this agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, or successors, and assigns of either party.

AGREEMENT: The PERMITTEE/PURCHASER agrees to the regulations and the hold harmless provision and in addition, agrees to repair any damages caused or pay for the cost of repairing any damage caused to the property or its improvements by the PERMITTEE/PURCHASER.

PERMIT MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES WHILE CUTTING AND HAULING.
PERMIT NOT VALID UNLESS SIGNED BY AUTHORIZED CSFS REPRESENTATIVE.

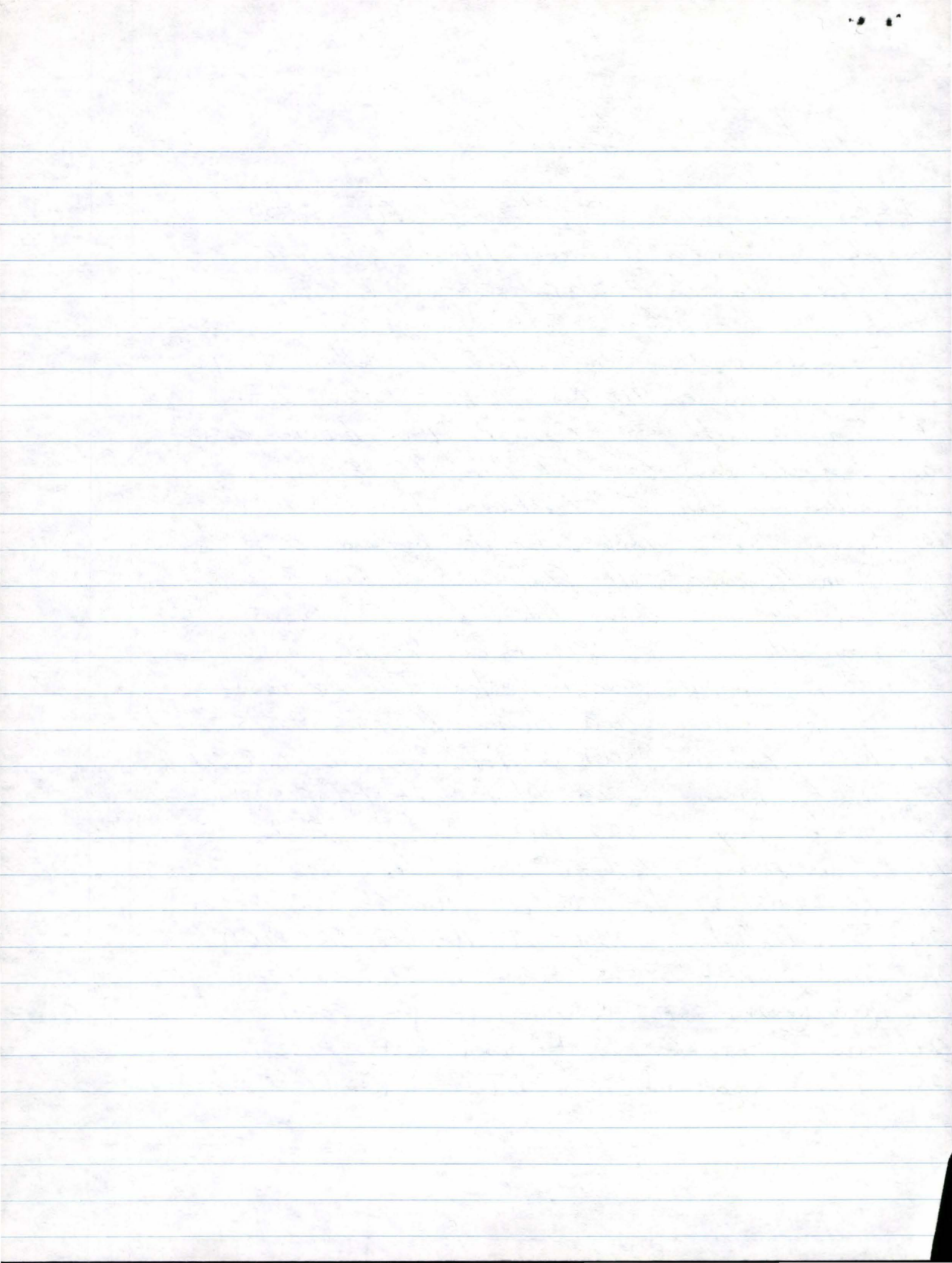
