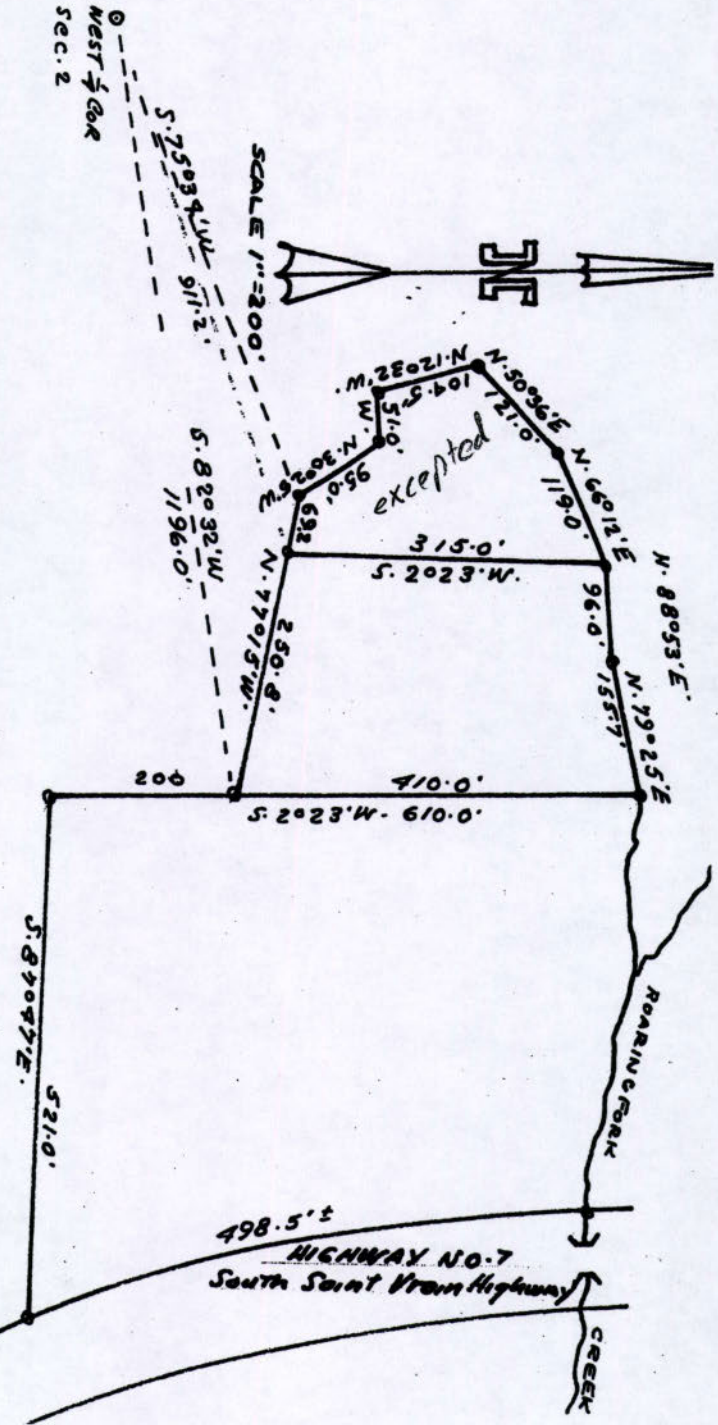

Forest Fuel Thinning – 2010

A Front Range Fuels Treatment grant has been awarded to the Rockwood Lane community. This grant is a cost share grant which means that each landowner who participates in the project will be reimbursed up to but not to exceed 50% of the total cost of the project work completed on his or her property. The project areas have been determined through a collaborative effort between the Colorado State Forest Service and several of the landowners in the Rockwood Lane community.

Project Objectives:

- To complete forest management practices by reducing fuel loading and altering the vertical and horizontal continuity of fuels throughout the community
- Create fuel breaks that will reduce tree densities and ladder fuels leading to a modified stand structure.
- Improve overall health of the remaining trees
- To create safer travel on all road and driveways
- Create wider access for emergency vehicles
- Increase fire safety throughout the community

Project Area Description:

The project area consists of 16 acres throughout the Rockwood Lane community. The forested area is a mix of several trees species which include lodgepole pine, ponderosa pine, limber pine, Douglas-fir, Engelmann spruce, sub-alpine fir and quaking aspen. Most of the areas targeted for treatment are located along roads and driveways. The remainder of the project areas are located along forest service boundaries, defensible space, and areas of dense timber located near structures.

Project Setup:

- The project will be set up by a CSFS representative.
- The boundaries of the units will be GPSed and marked with orange flagging.
- Trees to be removed will be marked with blue paint.
- Landowners are encouraged to make comments on the trees to be removed before the project is contracted out.
- A scope of work will be created for the project area by a CFSF representative.

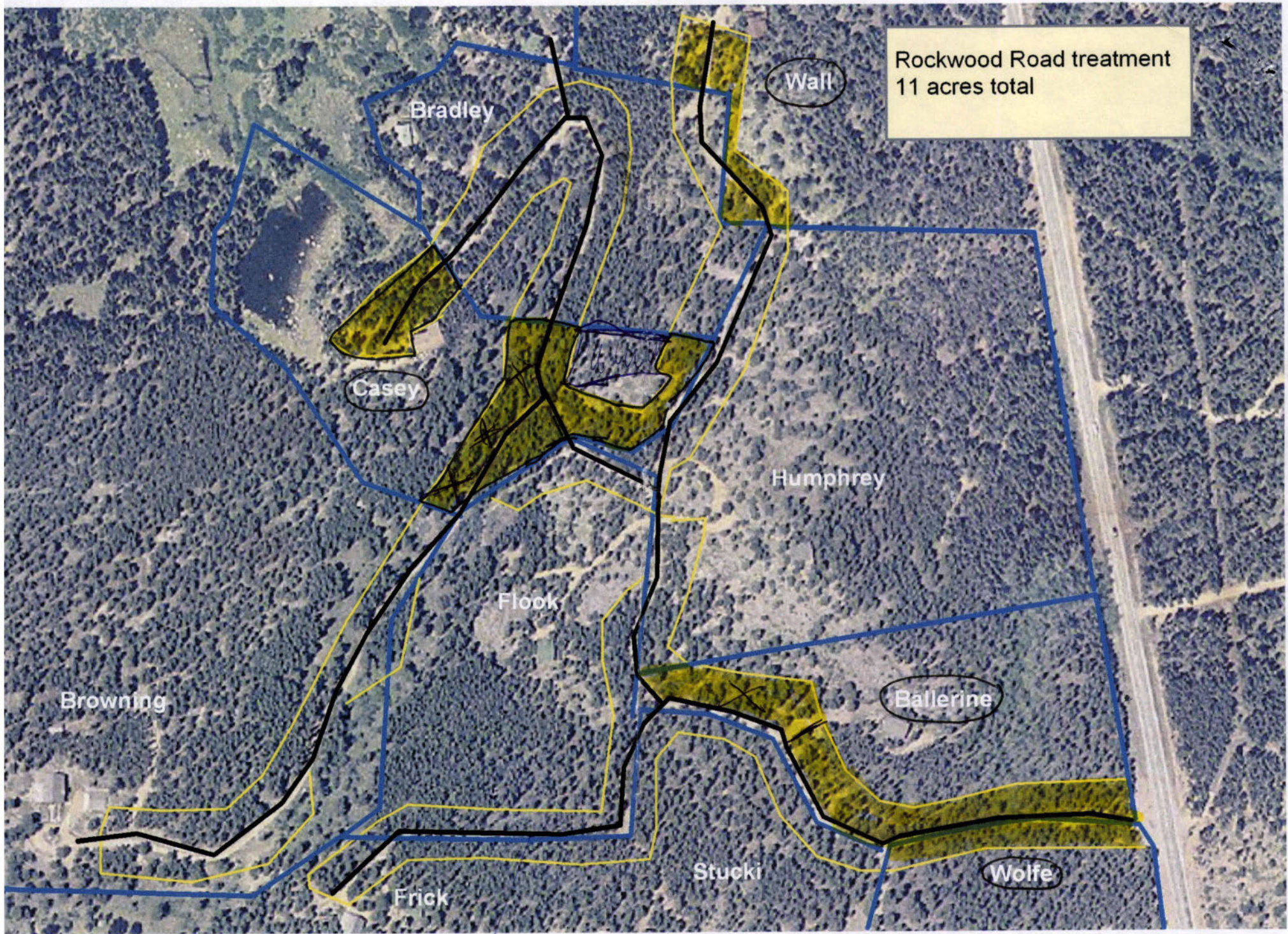
Schedule:

- All work must be completed by **September 30, 2010**. Extensions may be granted if warranted.
- No work will be started until a representative from CSFS has finalized the project area setup.
- Once a project area is completed it must be inspected by a CSFS representative in order to be reimbursed for payment.

The project work may be completed by a contractor or by the landowner. If the landowner chooses to complete the work he/she can still be reimbursed for their time. In this instance the landowner must keep track of his/her time and submit it for reimbursement when the work has been completed. If a contractor is hired a copy of the bill must be submitted for reimbursement. CSFS will invoice for services and supplies in project setup and administration.

Project Areas:

- Ballerine Property – Thinning along the main road into the subdivision. (Total acres proposed .5).
- Wolf Property – Thinning along the main road into the subdivision and along the driveway. (Total acres proposed .7).
- Stucci/Sabachi property – Thinning along the main road through the subdivision and defensible space around both cabins. (Total acres proposed 4.4).
- Humphrey/McCormick property – Thinning of a few trees but mainly limbing along main road that leads to the Wall property. (Total acres proposed .5).
- Wall property – Thinning along the main road to the residence and a dense stand of timber located below the Herman property. (Total acres proposed 1.3).
- Herman property – Thinning along the northern boundary of the property. (Total acres proposed 2).
- Bradley property – Thinning along the main road to the Wall property and the main road to the Casey property. (Total acres proposed 1).
- Casey property – Thinning along the main road through the community and along the driveway to the residence. (Total acres proposed 1.4).
- Browning property – Thinning along the western boundary of the property that borders Forest Service property. (Total acres proposed 3).
- Frick property – Thinning along the eastern boundary of the property that borders the Stucci property. (Total acres proposed .5).
- Flook property – Thinning along the southern corner that borders the Frick property and the entrance of the driveway to the residence. Another portion of the project is located to the south of the residence in a dense stand of lodgepole pine.

SCOPE OF WORK

CSFS 2009 : Rockwood Acres Subdivision (Rockwood)

Work to be completed: This grant will cover up to half of the cost of the Rockwood Acres Wildland Urban Interface Project. Approximately 16 acres of forest have been identified for treatment. In order to acquire full grant payment, 16 acres of fuels treatment must be done to CSFS standards.

Milestone dates: Implementation will begin upon approval of this Scope of Work. The project will run through the end of September 2010. Rockwood may submit up to two, "Attachment B: Grant Report/Reimbursement Request" to the local CSFS district for project payment.

Standards and Guidelines: Project work will meet the recommendations identified in the Allenspark CWPP, the CSFS Shaded fuel break guidelines, and those provided by a CSFS forester. The CSFS forester will assist with the initial project setup by flagging treatment boundaries and marking removal trees. The CSFS forester will also make requirements on the implementation details. Rockwood will contract the project, and ensure all implementation and reimbursement paperwork is completed within the grant cycle. A CSFS representative will inspect the reported acreage before reimbursement approval.

All grant funds will be used as a $\leq 50\%$ reimbursement for work done on this project. Rockwood will initially cover the cost of implementation by paying contractor(s). Rockwood will then submit documentation of the work for reimbursement. The limit for CSFS grant matching contribution is set at \$500 per acre. If the costs for treatment are above \$1,000 per acre, Rockwood will cover the excess costs for the project.

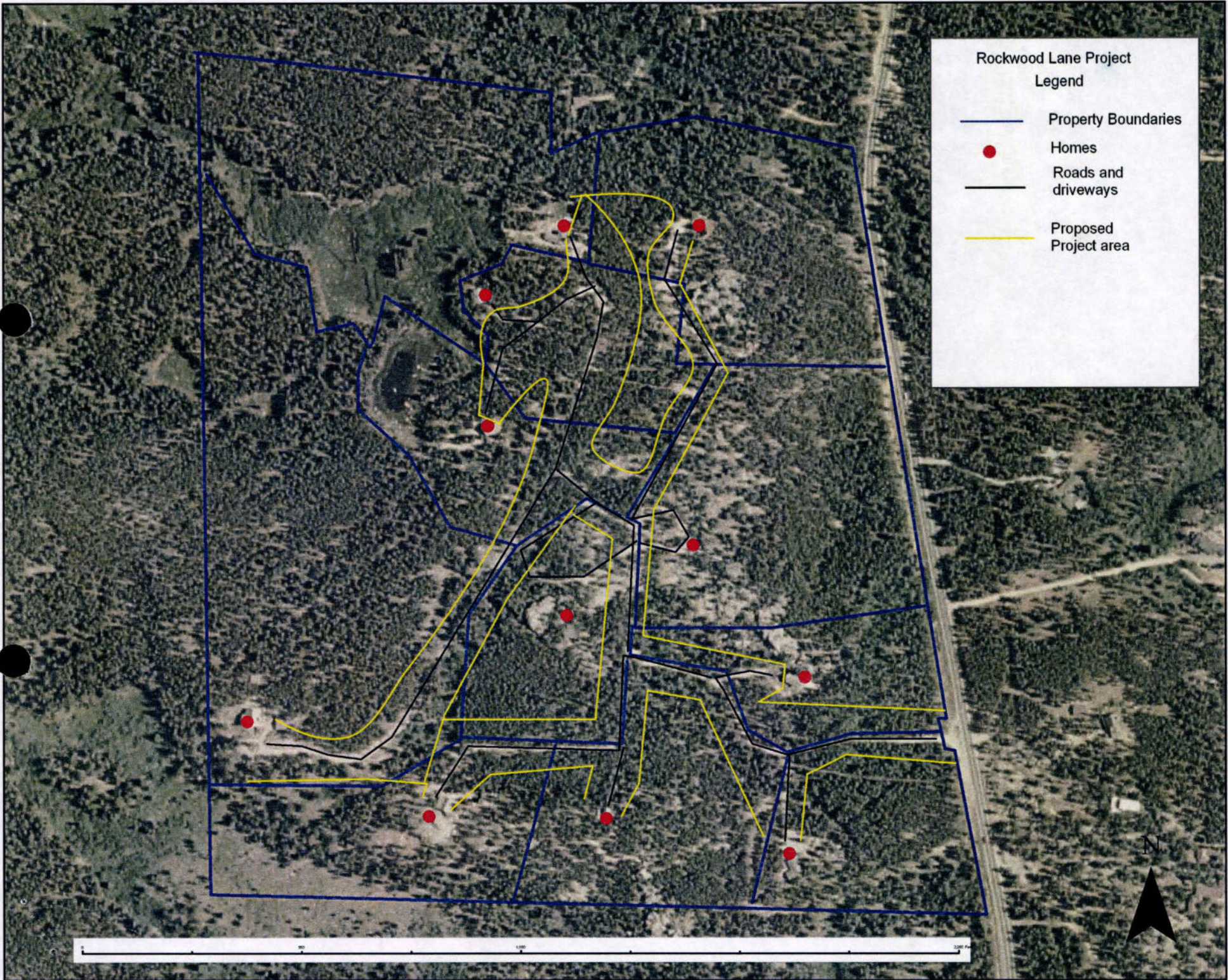

Fuels reduction activities will be conducted in mostly dense lodgepole pine stands, as well as mixed conifer stands and areas where thinning would promote aspen regeneration. A majority of these areas have suffered from bark beetle infestations as well as blown down events which increased the amount of dead and down on the forest floor as well as dead standing trees. All grant funds will be used to improve roadway and driveway safety. Shaded fuel breaks will be created in these areas with a width of no less than 50' and will be greater than 75' on slopes. The remainder of the grant money will focus on defensible space improvements which will follow Firewise and Colorado State Forest Service guidelines.
