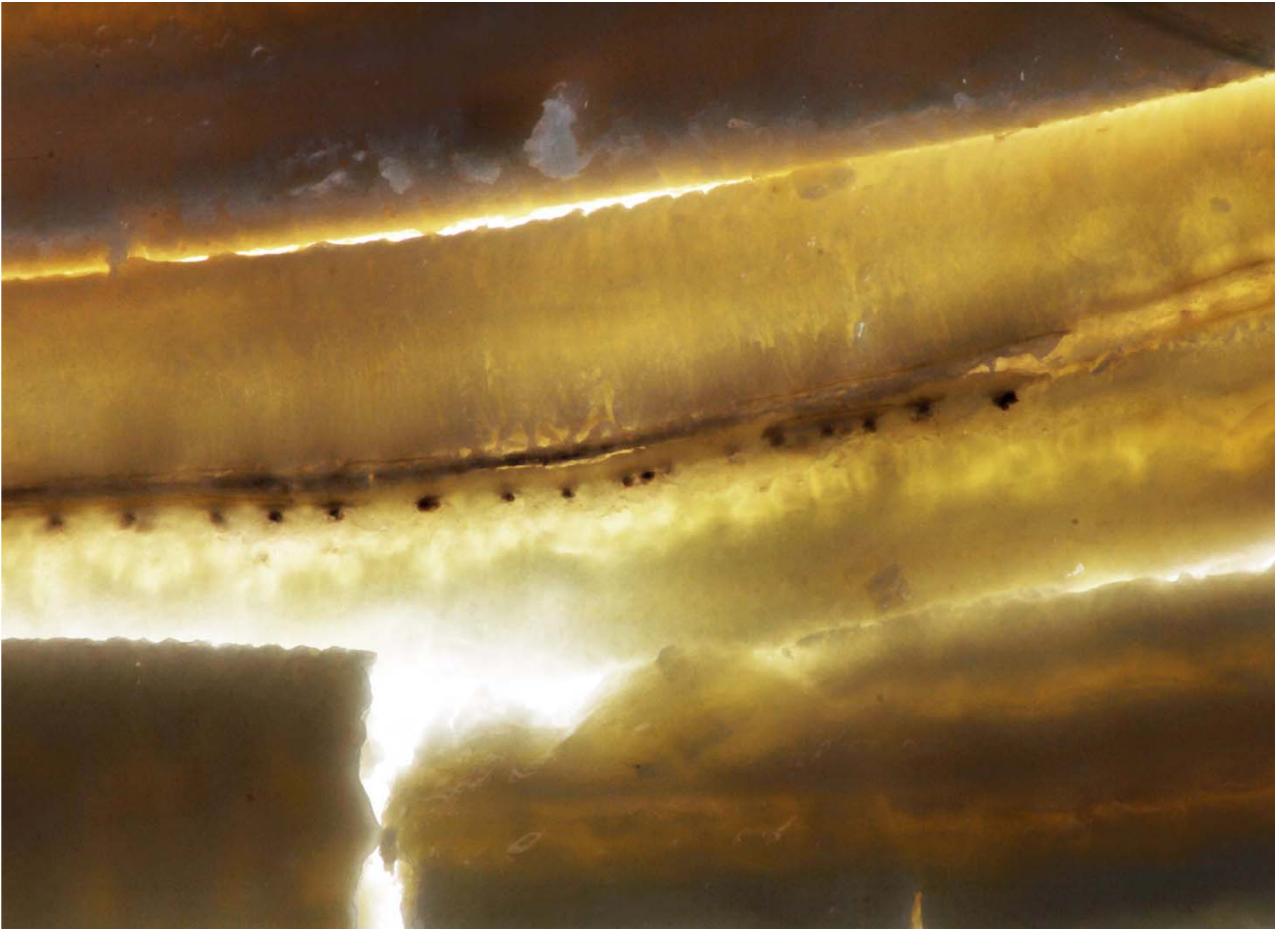


Figure 2: Banana.

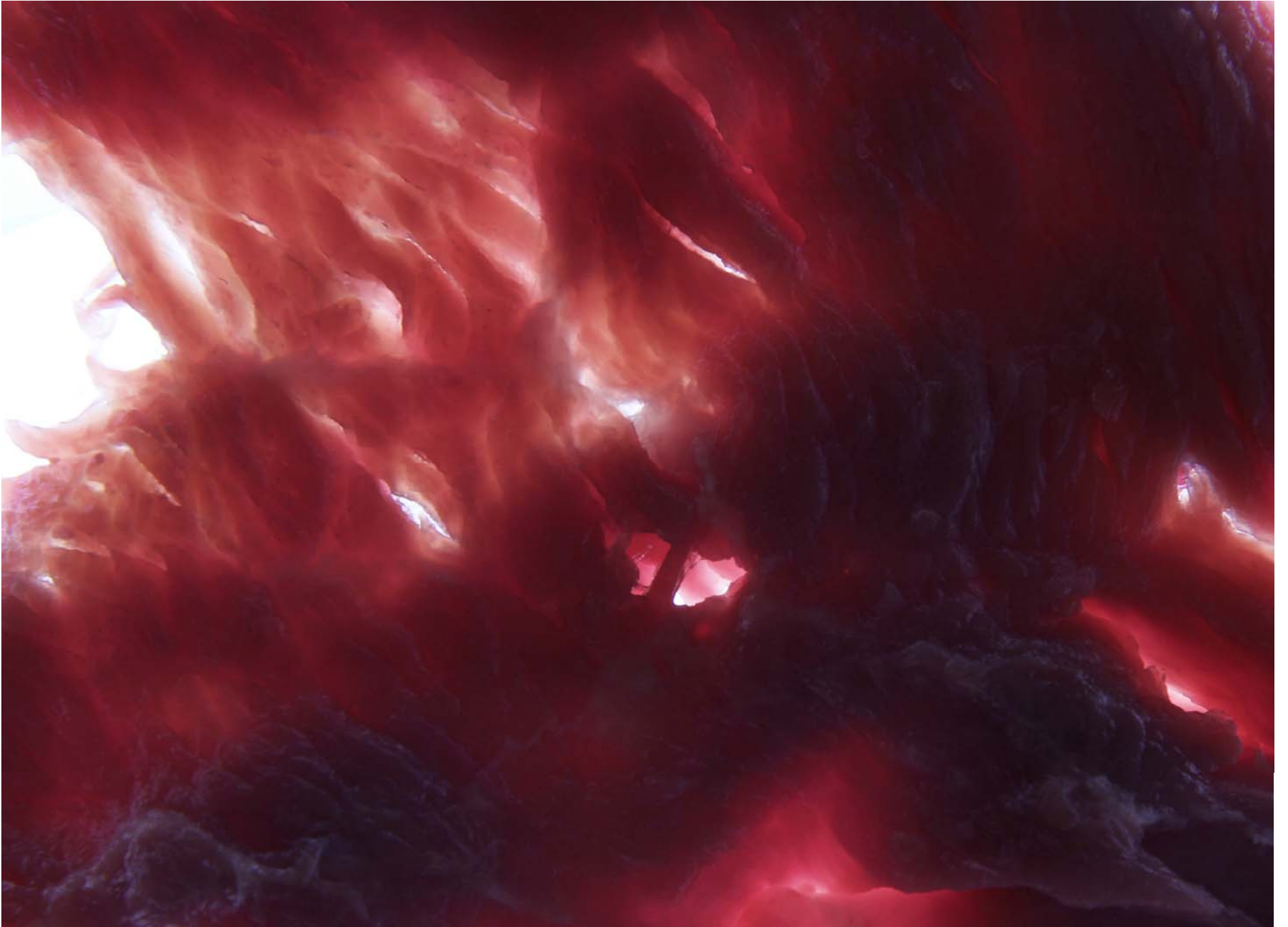


Figure 3: Beef.

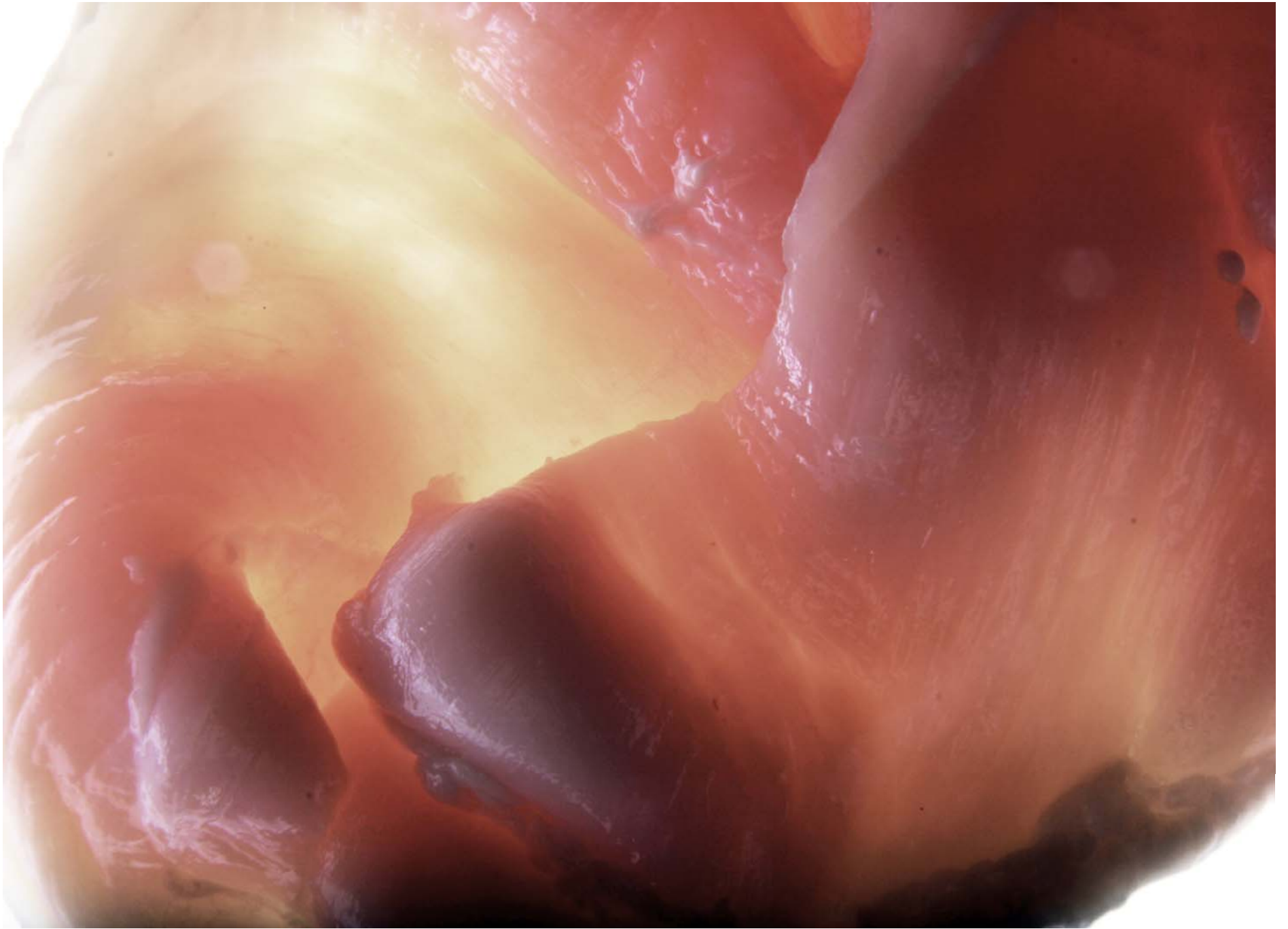


Figure 4: Chicken.

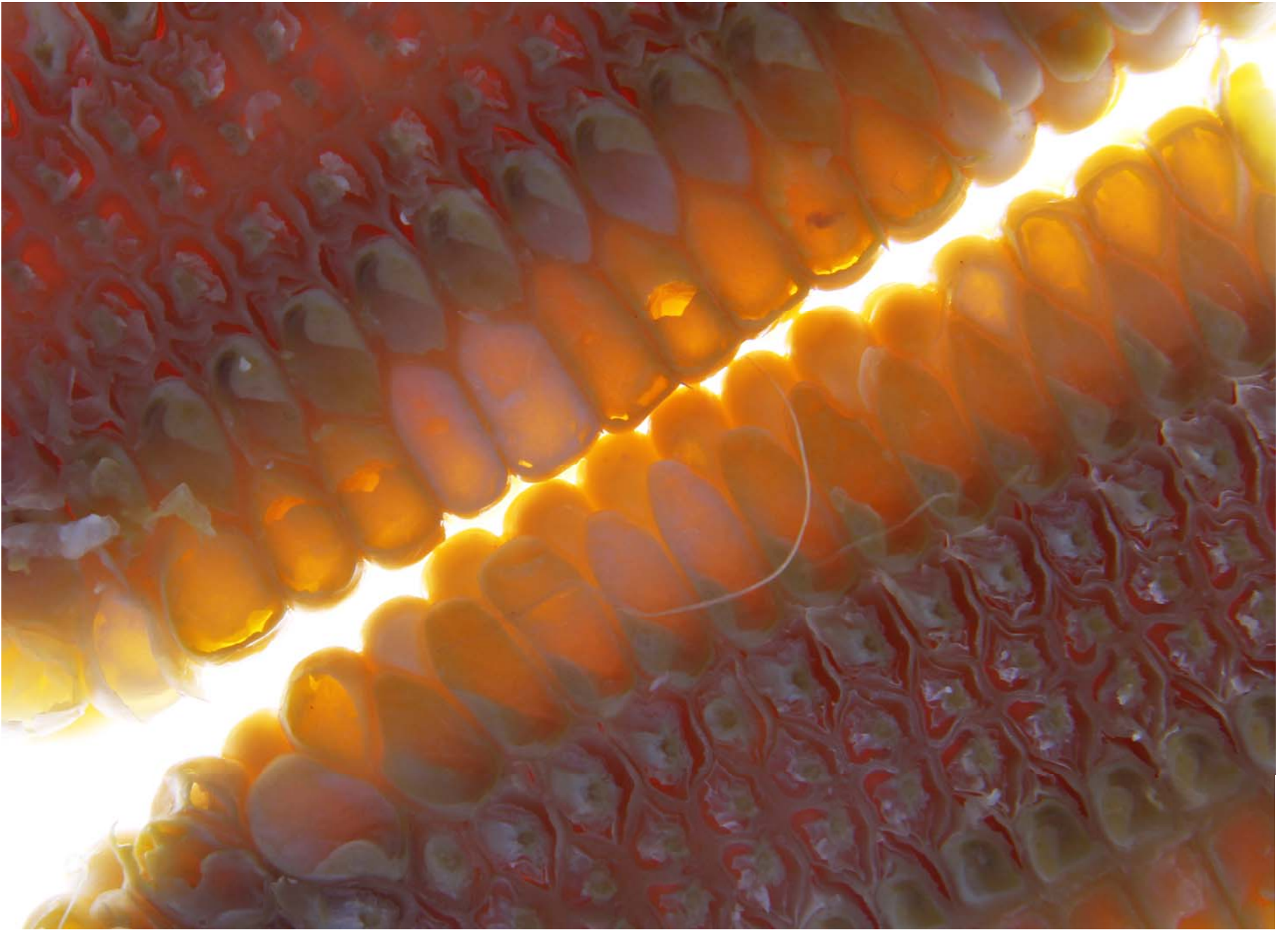


Figure 5: Corn.

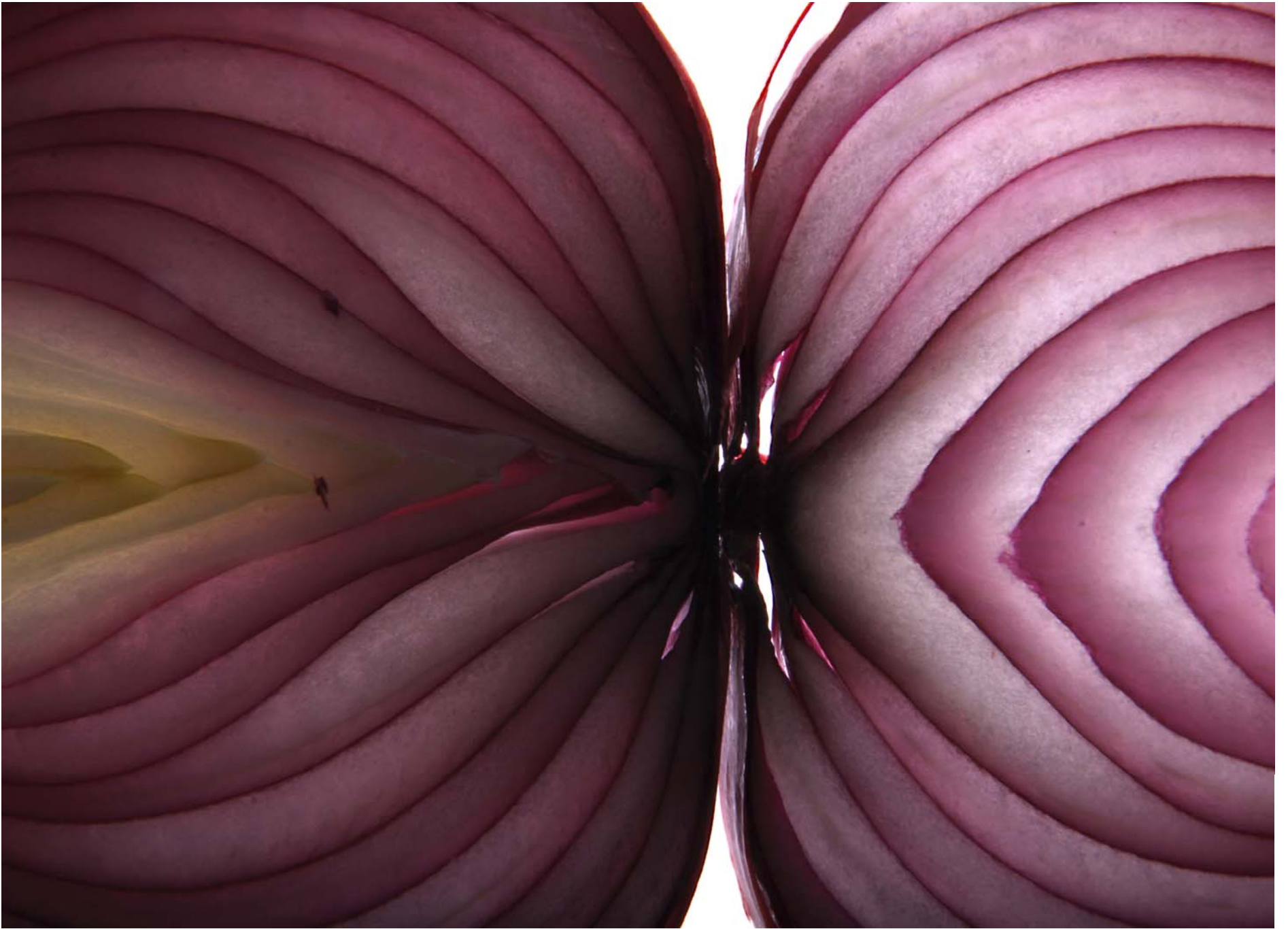


Figure 12: Onion.

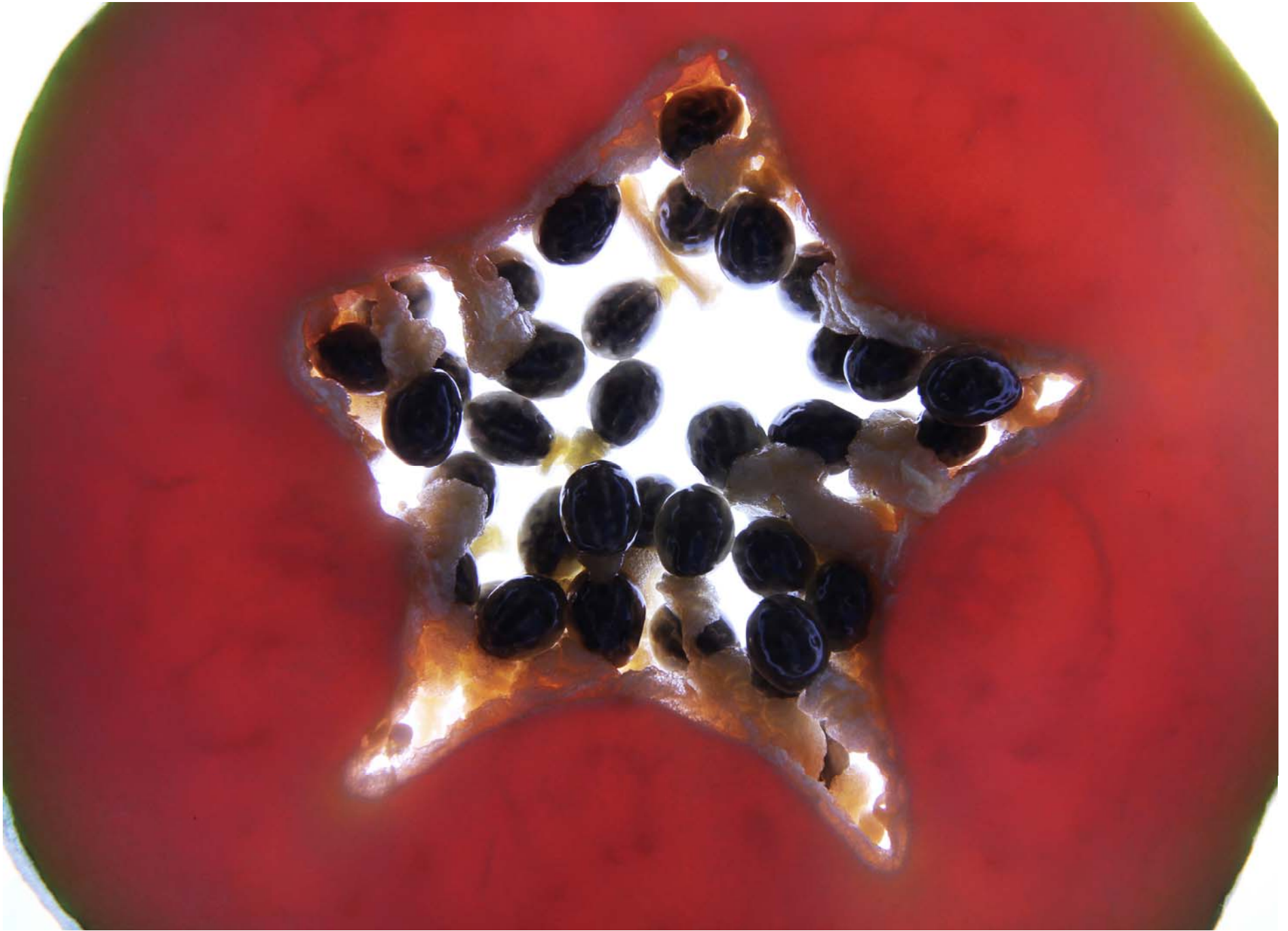


Figure 13: Papaya.

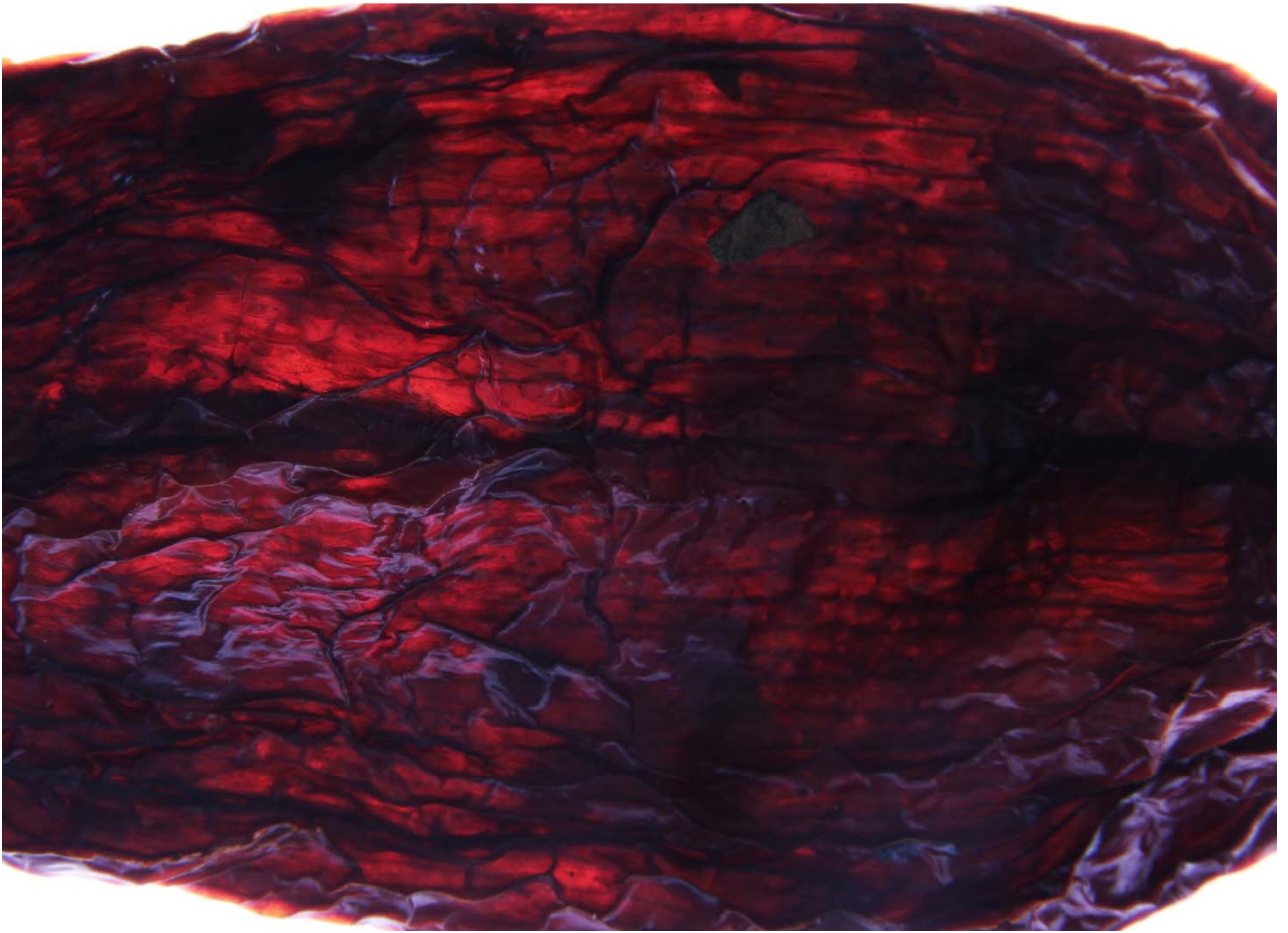


Figure 15: Pepper.

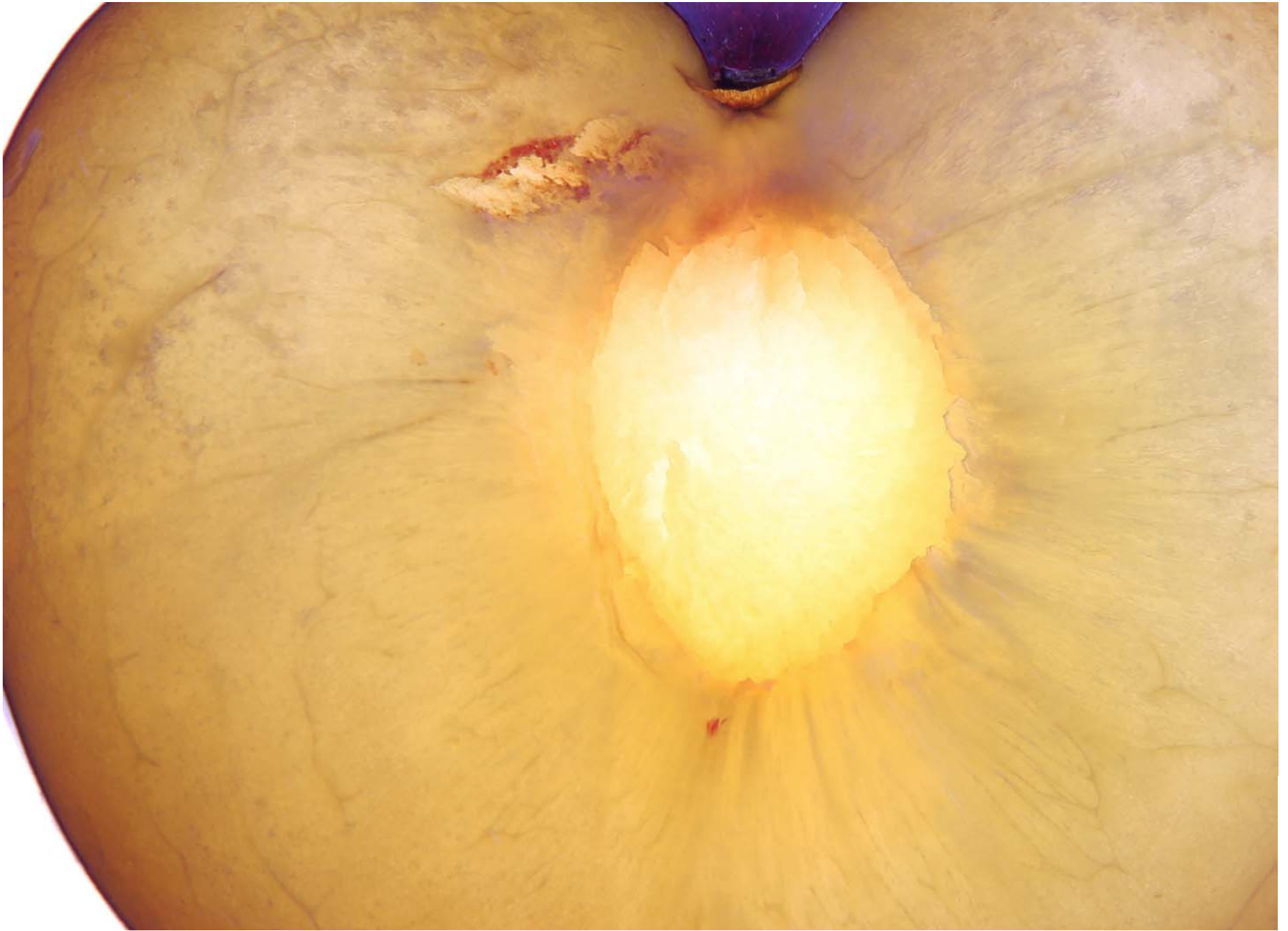


Figure 17: Plum.

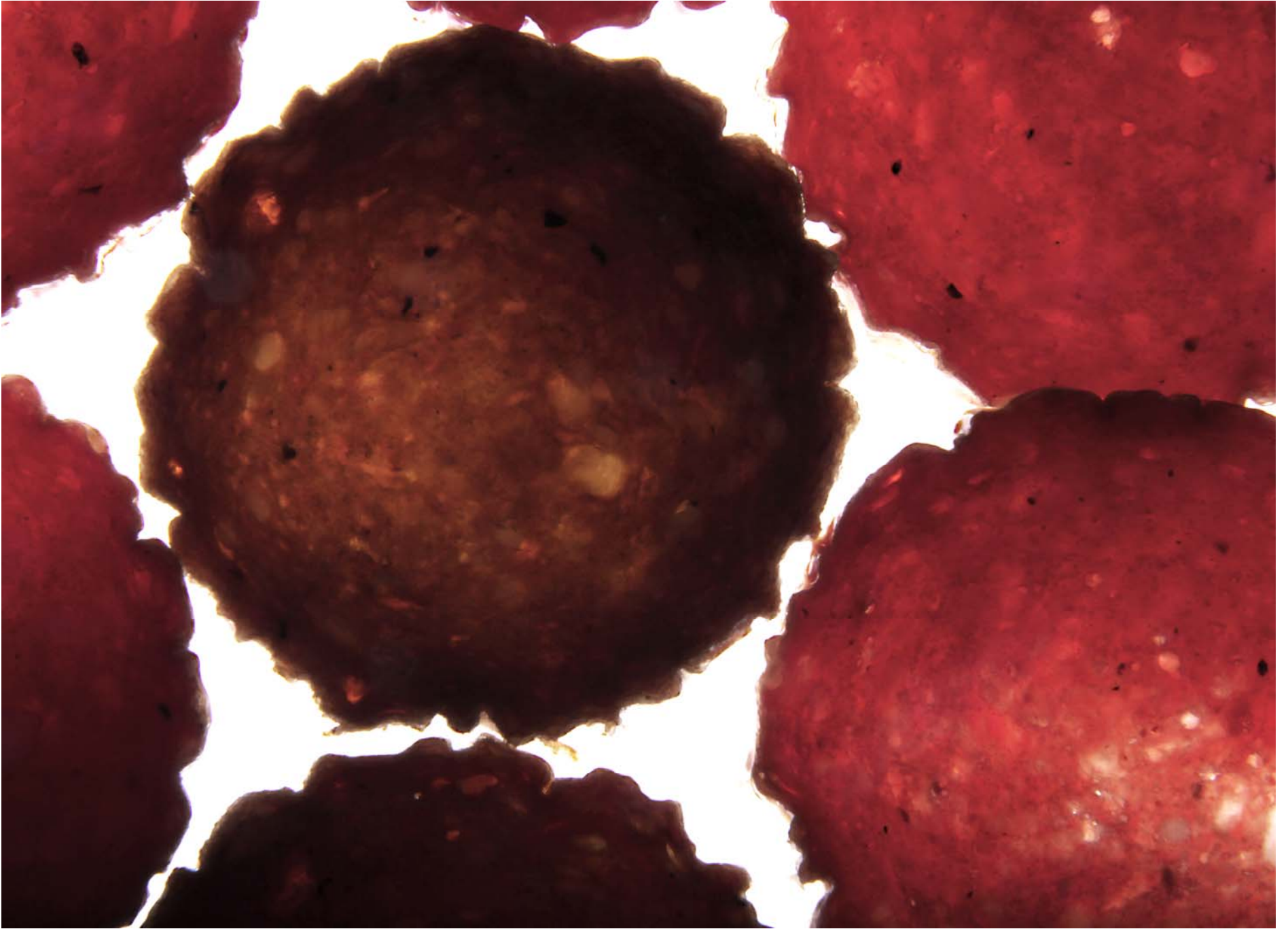


Figure 18: Sausage.

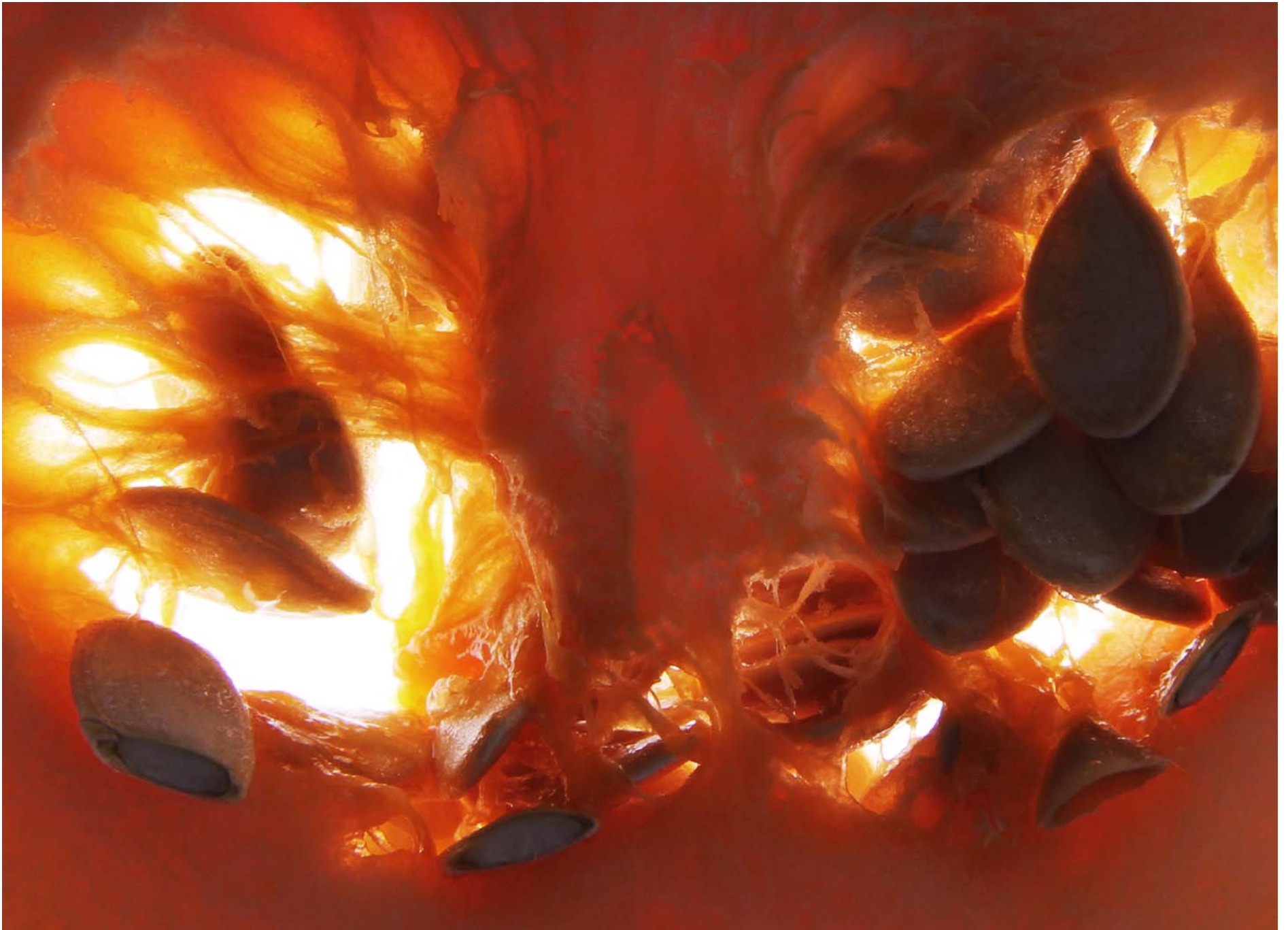


Figure 19: Squash.

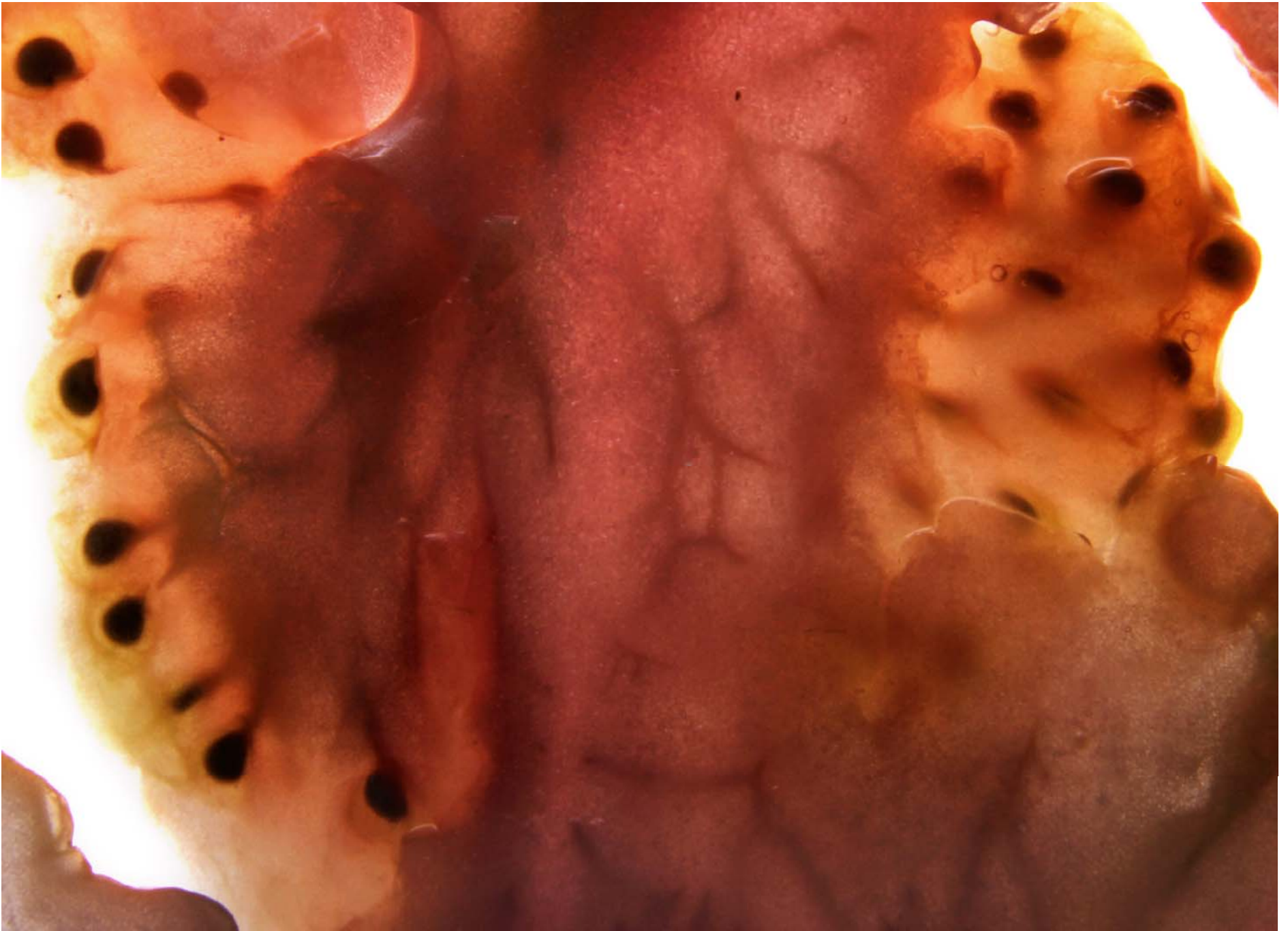


Figure 20: Tomato.

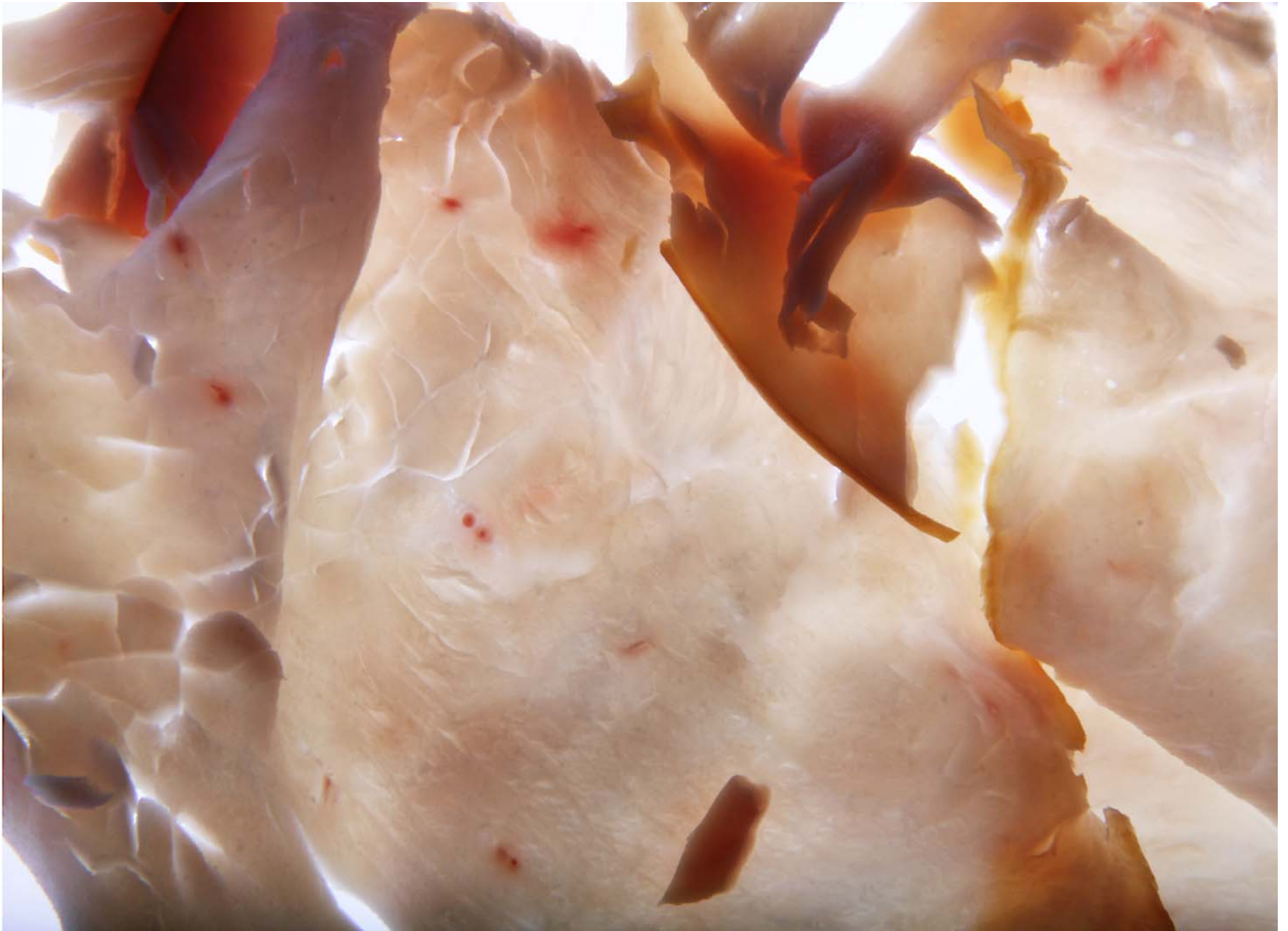


Figure 21: Turkey.

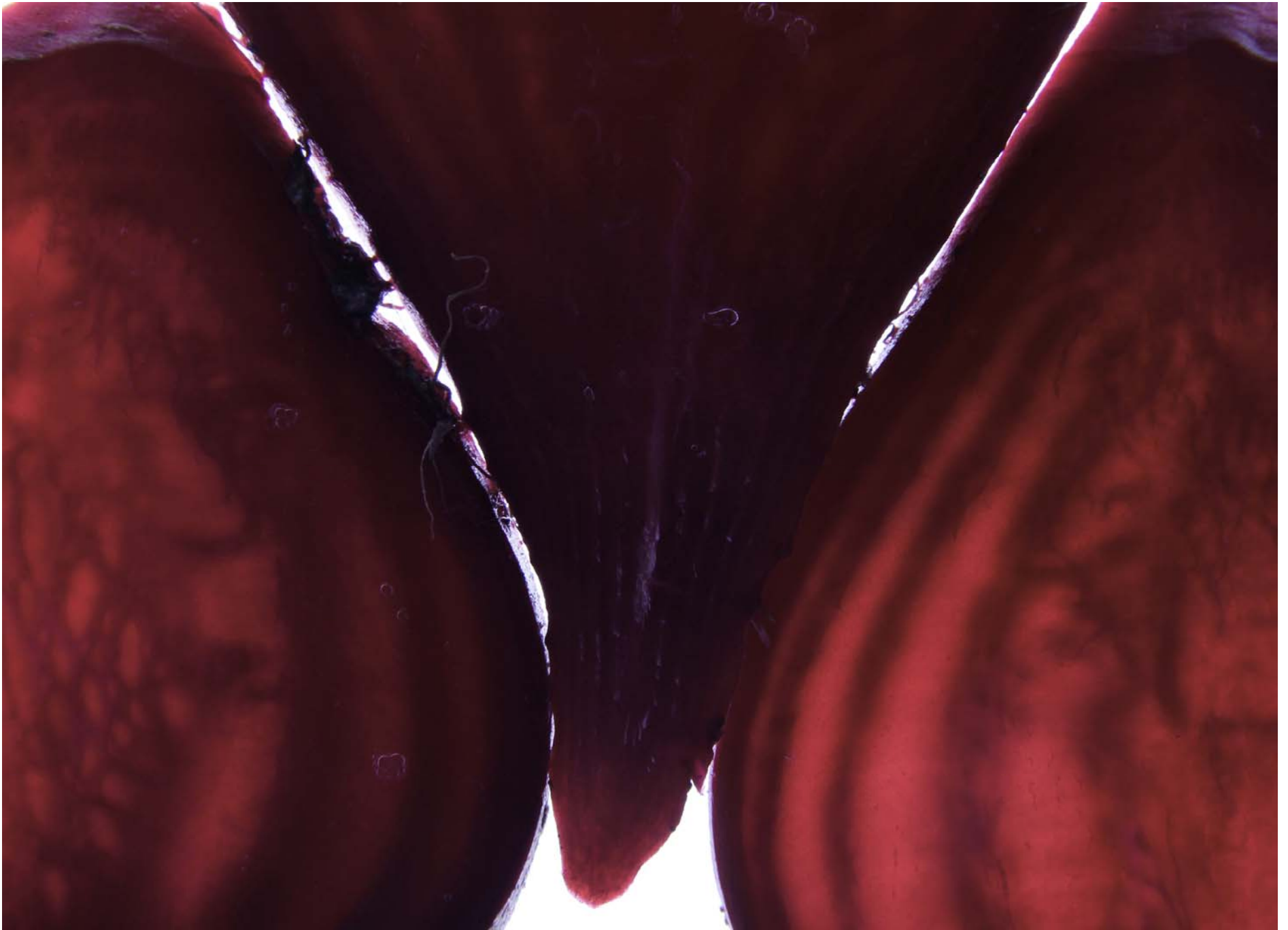


Figure 23: Beets.
