	The project area is located due west of the town of Boulder, in the Boulder Heights area. The project area is best accessed off of Brook Road. The residence is located near the southeast corner of the lot. The southern 1/3 of the property is located on moderate slope, with easy access. Vegetation in this area consists of predominantly ponderosa pine and douglas fir, with a small mix of juniper throughout. The northern 2/3 of the property is located on steep north facing slopes, with access only from the southern 1/3. Vegetation in this area is highly composed of douglas fir, with pockets of ponderosa pine throughout. Tree density is much thicker in this area.

	Grant funding will be used to conduct hazardous fuels reduction across the entire property. Increasing the spacing of the overstory trees is a high priority, to reduce the risks associated with wildfire. The area where the property shifts from a southern aspect slope to a northern aspect, will look to do heavy fuels thinning, as to serve as a fire break. Thinning will continue downslope to the north, but feathering out efforts as work moves further to the north. Most bole wood will be contoured to the ground, stacked for firewood, or hauled off. Slash will either be chipped (where accessible), or lopped and scattered throughout, with a new depth not to exceed 18 inches. Trees left uncut will be limbed to a minimum of 6 feet, or 25% of the bottom limbs, whichever is of the lesser.


