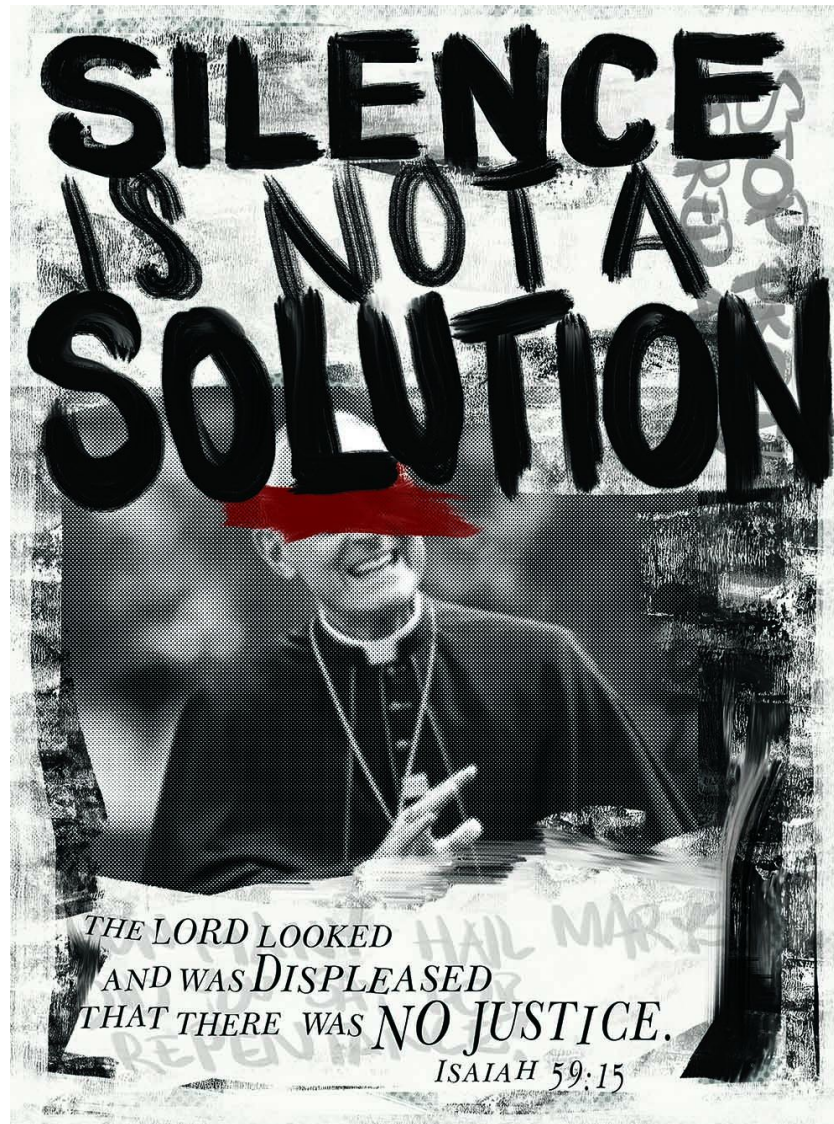


Figure 1: Silence Is Not A Solution Poster

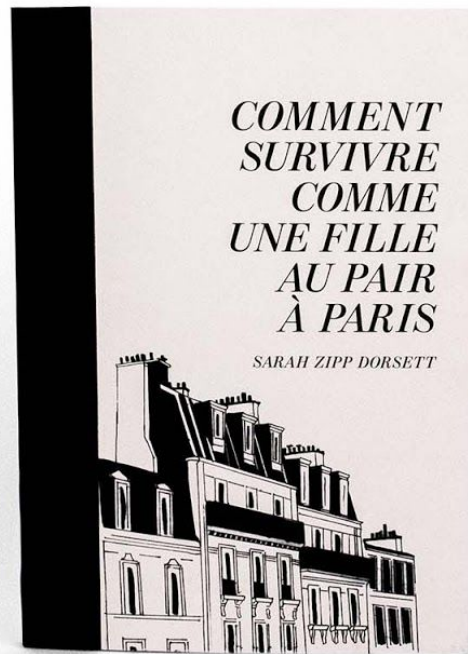


Figure 3: *Comment Survivre Comme Une Fille Au Pair à Paris* Cover

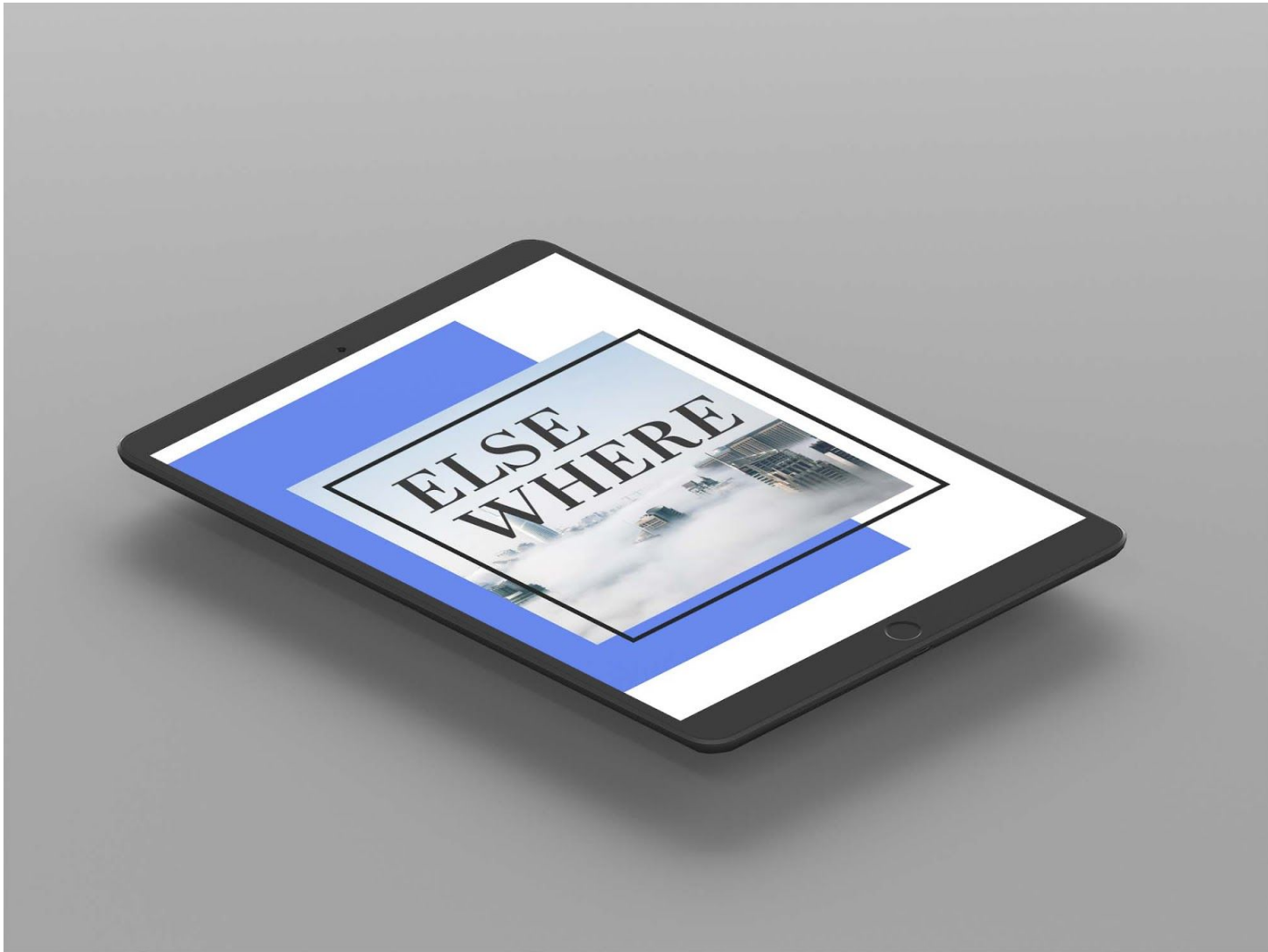


Figure 4: *Elsewhere* Travel App

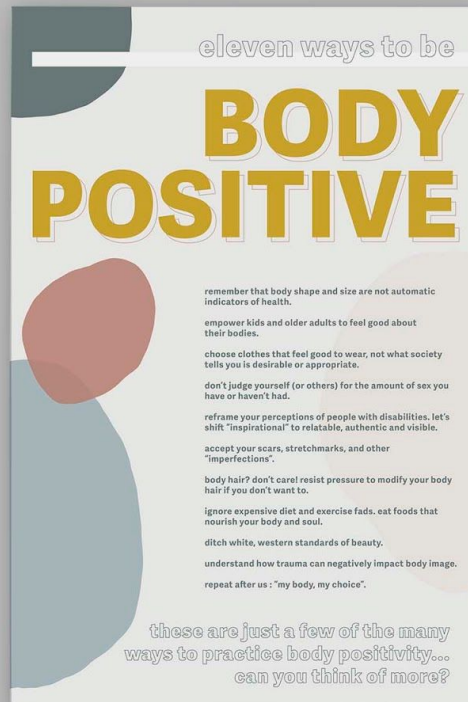


Figure 5: Body Positivity Poster

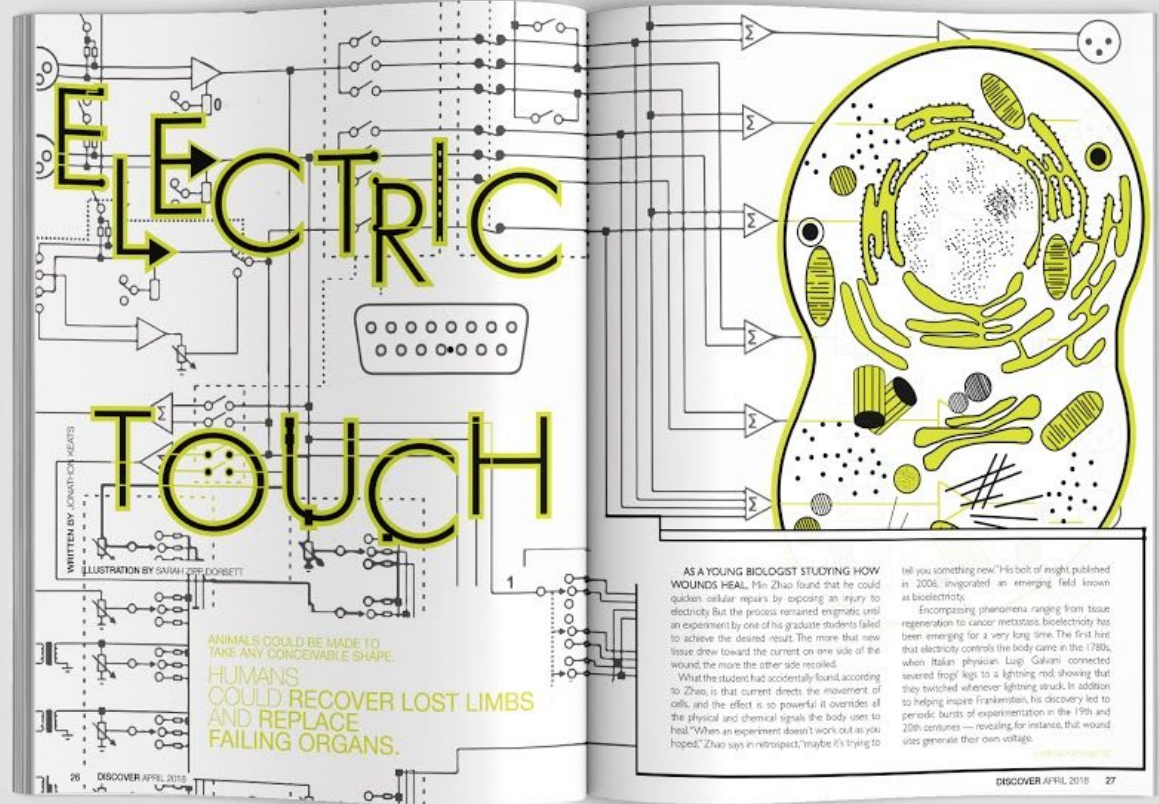


Figure 10: *Electric Touch* Article Spread
