





Figure 4: Chameleon Political Party Foreign Aide Poster.






Figure 5: Chameleon Political Party Game Packaging.




Figure 6: Fantasy Cookbook Poster.








Figure 7: IPad Radio Show App.




Figure 8: Cardiovascular Colloquium Poster.




Figure 9: Ivory Tours Packaging.




Figure 10: Fantasy Cook Book Cover.
