1987

- May 13
- * First annual meeting of the Friends of the Gustafson Gallery was held. Founding Committee was disbanded
 - * Bylaws were written. Ratified on May 13, 1987.
 - * Fiscal year based on CSU's fiscal year. June 30 - July 1.
 - * Phil Risbek, CSU Art Professor donated his art work inspired by Erte designs to the Gallery.
 - * Exhibition of costumes from the collection was mounted in the Lincoln Center

1988

- April Mrs. Josephine Proebstin of Arizona and Jack Curfman, CSU Art Dept. were awarded an Honorary Membership at the Annual Meeting on the 19th.
- May
- * The Blackwell Collection. On the 14th at 7:30 pm in Ammons Hall a showing of Blackwell gowns owned by the Gallery.
 - * Antique Jewelry show held at the Square.
- September Between September and February 1989, a "Trunk Showing" of original garments was viewed by over 450 people

1989

- February Second Jewelry Show, 14th of February, Lincoln Center.
- March
- * The Preamble to the bylaws first revision was carried, 30 March.
 - * Honorary Membership was sent to Lum, Montez and Andra Jenkins who were instrumental in acquiring the Blackwell Collection
- May Polly Willman, Smithsonian Institute presented a slide show, First Lady Inaugural Gowns. Held jointly with the Larimer County Extension Homemakers.
- August
- * Gustafson Gallery exhibited 15 garments from the collection in the windows of the Foothills Mall shops for the West Fest.
 - * Richard Blackwell visits Colo. State. At special Open House was held for members to meet the designer.

1990

- March Terri Schindel, Textile Conservator, Rocky Mountain Regional Conservation Center gave a lecture on conservation of garments.
- April Friends of the Gustafson Gallery Board contribute \$100.00 to the Sally Haxton Memorial.
- June Mr. Don Knob, Institute of Museum Services evaluation enable the computer inventory to begin.
- October * Two performances of "***A Fashion Retrospective - 1890-1990***". Over \$4000.00 was raised and 396 tickets were sold. The fashion show was held in Ammons Hall.
* The Humidification and temperature control system was installed in the Gustafson Clothing Collection area, third floor Gifford Building

1991

- April * Lydia Doty awarded an Honorary Membership for her work with the "***A Fashion Retrospective***" show in October 1990.
* The newly refurbished Gustafson Gallery at Aylesworth Hall opened on the 21st.
* Physical inventory of the collection was begun.
- July/Aug A membership drive netted about 100 names which were compiled and stored on a floppy disk (WordPerfect 5.0)
- October Third Antique Jewelry and Linen Show was held at Lincoln Center.
- November Special reception showing of *The Grand Tour*" for the Ostertags and their special guests.

1992

- May * Bylaws amendments were approved
* Parnell Memorial bookshelves were dedicated at the Annual Meeting.
* Honorary Membership was awarded to Carolyn Ostertag, New Mexico for her wonderful gift of over 300 garments.
* "***Feathered Stars , and Turkey Tracks***" Quilt show. Presented by Joan Stephens from the Smithsonian Institute.
- June FGG Board provided refreshments for the International Exhibit of Textiles for the **ARS TEXTRINA 10th Annual Conference of Textiles**.
- October 4, Second large fundraiser. **ARTS FOR ADORNMENT SHOW**. 251 ticket sold. Mannequin displays at the Library, Peterson Street and a Hillestad display at the Foothills Mall.

October 30 **THE COLOR BLACK** exhibit opened. Approximately 54 people in attendance. About half were students.
