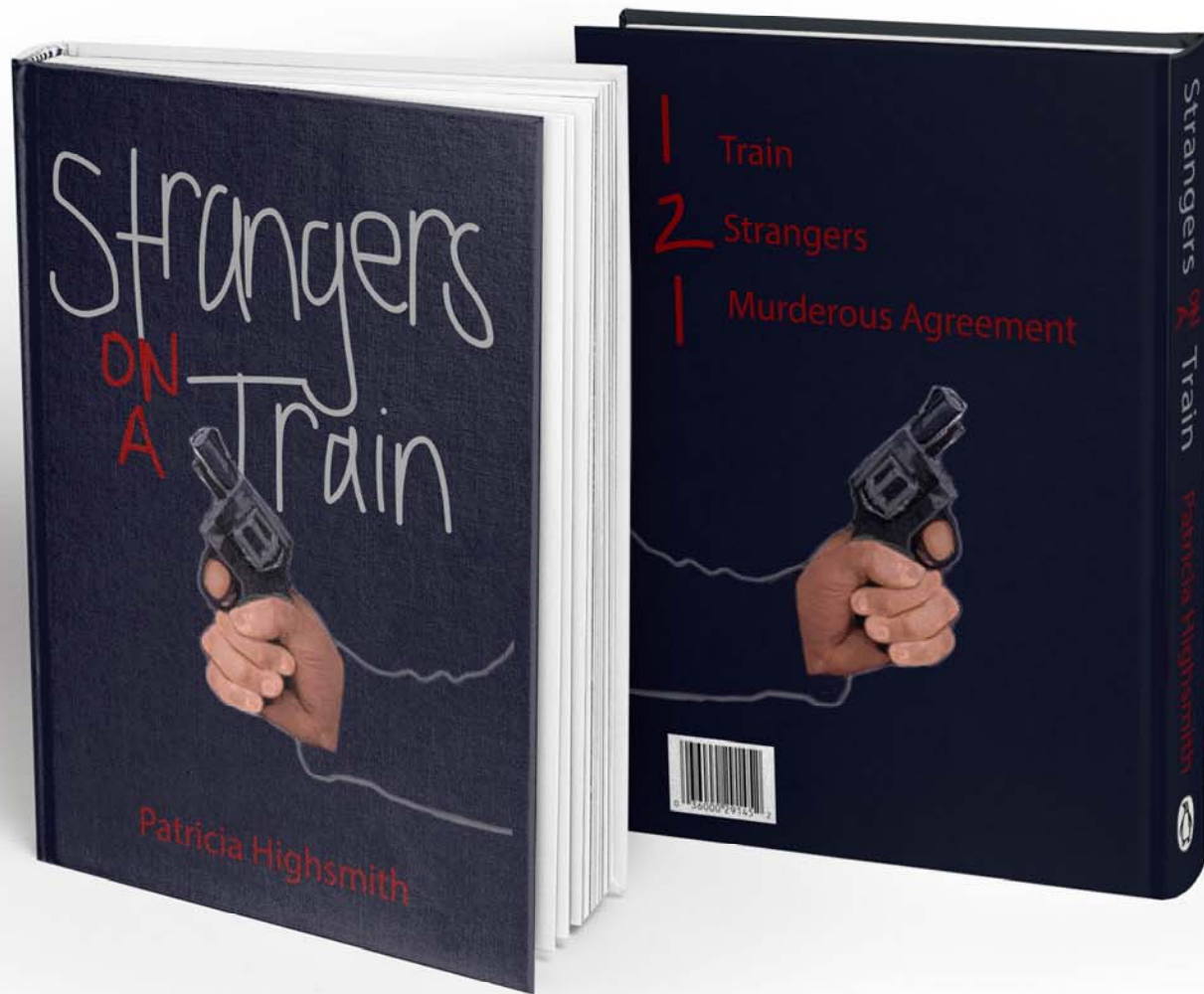


Figure 1: Book Cover: *Strangers on a Train*.

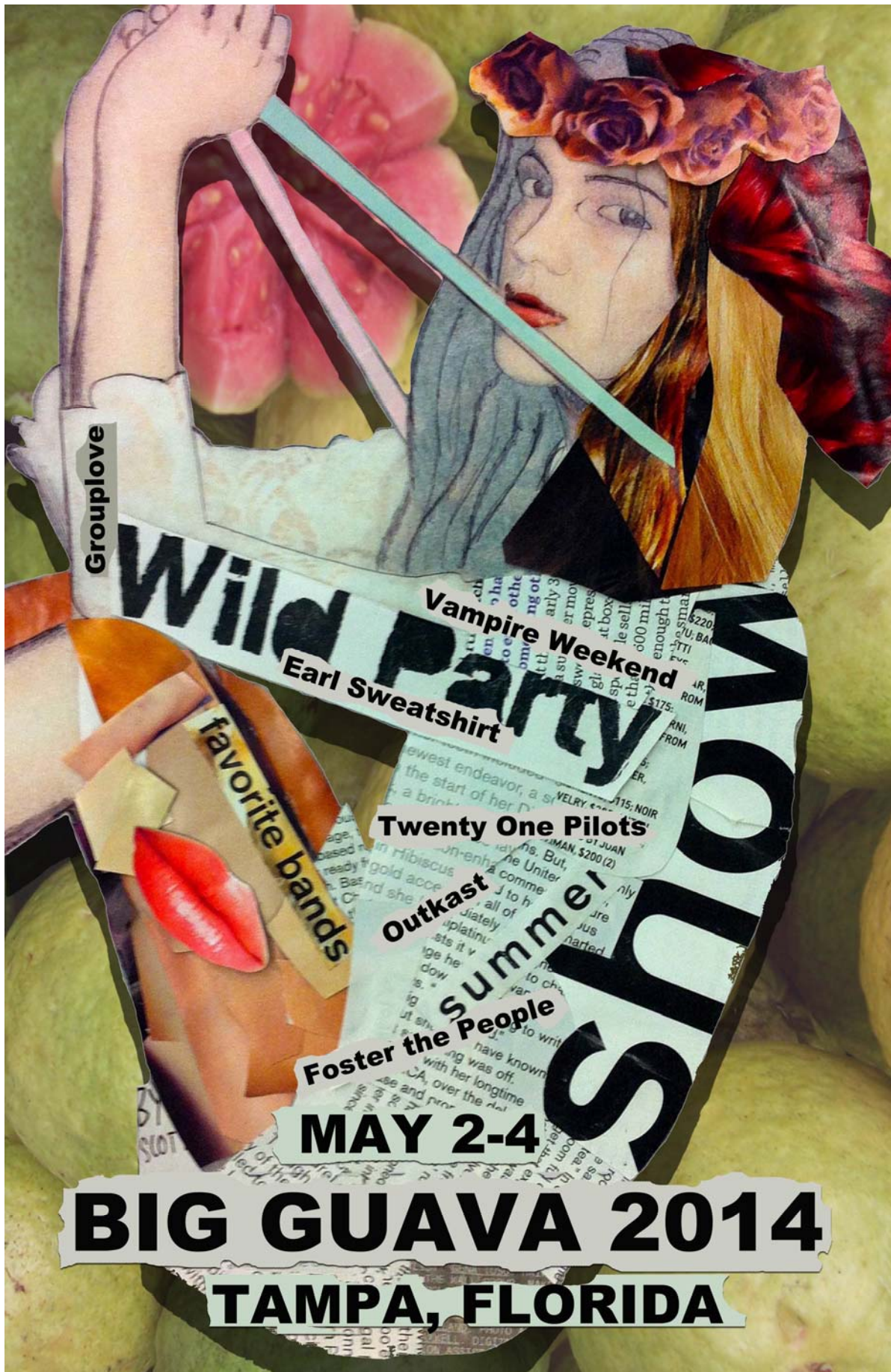


Figure 5: Festival Poster: *Big Guava*.

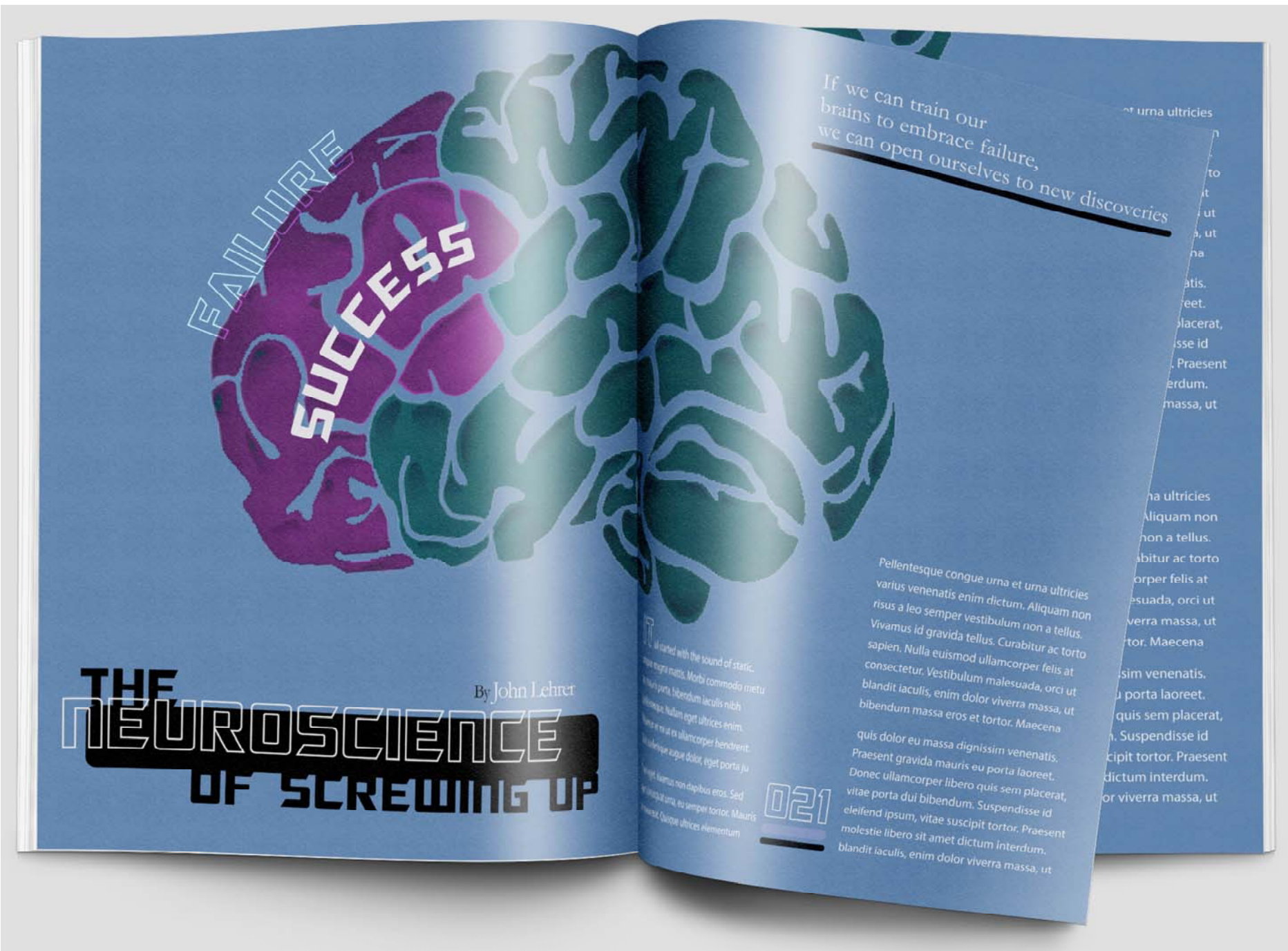


Figure 10: Wired Magazine: The Neuroscience of Screwing UP.
