The Boulder County Fire Management Plan (FMP) will cover the entirety of Boulder County Parks and Open Space (BCPOS) property (approximately 94,000 acres). BCPOS properties vary in size from large, integrated tracts to small pockets or mining claims and exist in every life zone of Boulder County. Management objectives of BCPOS land include providing for recreation, agriculture, and resource preservation. Boulder County is located in the foothills of north central Colorado and encompasses 742 square miles of terrain including prairie, montane, sub-alpine, and alpine life zones. The eastern half of the county consists of mostly grassland and agricultural tracts; central county is a variable mix of sagebrush, Ponderosa Pine, mixed conifers, open meadows, and riparian vegetation. The western county line is formed by the Continental Divide. Boulder's County has some of the densest wildland/urban interface in the country and a long history of destructive wildfires recently earned the unfortunate distinction of hosting the most destructive wildfire in state history.

The FMP is being written to increase public and firefighter safety, increase forest health through responsible fire management, establish wildfire response plans, support fuels mitigation efforts and comply with the recommendations outlined in Colorado Senate Bill 09-020. From Colorado Senate Bill 09-020, the FMP will outline roles and responsibilities of emergency response agencies including "jurisdictional boundaries, fiscal and operational authority and responsibilities, a general description of their wildland fire response capabilities, and incident command structure; describe the procedures for cooperation and coordination between or among federal, state, county, and local emergency response authorities and specify reimbursement and billing procedures." In addition, the Boulder County FMP will include a vision statement, outline of purpose and needs, goals, objectives, and standards. The FMP will describe the relationship of the FMP to higher level planning documents, describe how the FMP will be implemented, and provide extensive property descriptions at both the area-wide and property level that will further support fuels mitigation efforts. The FMP will also include tactical and operational information for planning and implementing suppression efforts. Applicable documents will be referenced or reproduced in the appendix. This requested SFA grant will pay for County Sheriff Wildfire staff to write the FMP, which will compliment the County-wide CWPP being written. While the County CWPP addresses mitigation and pre-planning for a wildfire, this companion document supports the Boulder County CWPP and it's fuels mitigation efforts.

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
